Position Description

Concourse Worker

Summary

Concourse worker will assist in keeping concourse, restrooms, suite level and all traffic areas void of trash during games. Concourse crewmembers will replace overflow trashcans with new liners and dispose of full liners to the proper areas. Concourse crew will be the first to the scene of spills, droppings, etc. Concourse worker reports two (2) hour prior to game time and stays through post game cleanup.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following.

Wipe down flat surfaces and picnic tables before every game. Sweep up spills on concourse and in bathrooms. Restocking supplies in bathrooms. Empty trash and dispose in designated areas. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Other duties may be assigned.

Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Must be at least 16 years of age, must be able to stand for long periods of time, must maintain a neat appearance and have strong customer service skills.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is <u>frequently</u> required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel and talk or hear. The employee is <u>frequently</u> required to reach with hands and arms. The employee is <u>frequently</u> required to stand; walk; sit and stoop, kneel, crouch. The employee must <u>frequently</u> lift and /or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision and ability to adjust focus.

Work Environment

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to outside weather conditions, which may include heat, cold and various forms of precipitation. The employee is occasionally exposed to moving mechanical parts. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
