In 1991, owners Miles Prentice & Bob Richmond and general manager Monty Hoppel introduced the West Texas Sports Banquet & Memorabilia Auction, an event designed to benefit the community through a celebration of sports.

The banquet has become a tradition and the centerpiece of the franchise's community commitment.

In addition to keynote speakers and special guests, the event includes silent & "live" auctions of sports (and other) memorabilia ... announcement of the RockHounds Fan of the Year ... and presentation of the Scott Seator Community Achievement Award, honoring an individual for contributions to our community through athletics.



Andre Dawson

Induction into the Baseball Hall of Fame is one of the most remarkable achievements in all of sports

Andre Dawson earned his place in Cooperstown by virtue of a 21-year career in which he was one of the game's most complete ... and best ... players.

"The Hawk" was an eight-time All-Star and Gold Glove winner.

He is one of only eight players in Major League history with 300 or more home runs and 300 or more stolen bases.

Of those eight players, he is one of just five with 400 or more home runs (he hit 438). The other four are Barry Bonds, Alex Rodriguez, Willie Mays & Carlos Beltran.

Andre spent his first 11 seasons (1976-86) with Montreal, but five of his eight All-Star selections came in six seasons with the Cubs. The first of those was 1987, his first in Chicago, when he was named the National League's Most Valuable Player.

His Hall of Fame teammate, Ryne Sandberg, said ...

"No player in baseball history worked harder ... or did it better ... than Andre Dawson. He's the best I've ever seen."



Larry Brown

The Cowboys drafted Larry Brown out of Texas Christian University in 1991. In his first five seasons with Dallas, the Cowboys reached the Super Bowl three times (1992, 93 and 95).

In the third of those games, Larry was named MVP of Super Bowl XXX after recording a pair of key interceptions in the second half as the Cowboys defeated the Pittsburgh Steelers, 27-17.

He played eight seasons in the NFL (1991-98), six of them with Dallas.

Among his pursuits since playing career ended, Larry has served as a cohost of the Cowboys Radio Network Pregame and Postgame Shows.
