TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves	s wrap up a six-game series against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGN	Λ
Park. This is the final meetin	g between these two clubs in the regular season.	

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves lost their third straight game 9-1. The Shuckers scored the first five runs of the game. The M-Braves lone run came on a Jalen Miller RBI double to left center in the fourth. In his ninth Double-A game, Wes Clarke blasted three home runs. RHP Justin Jarvis spun seven innings of one-run ball, tying his career's longest outing. RHP Kyle Wilcox and RHP Justin Yeager each tossed a shutout inning, both touching 98 mph on fastballs.

THE SLUGBAUER MAKING MISSISSIPPI HISTORY: 1B Drew Lugbauer has hit a club-record 45 career M-Braves home runs over two seasons, and 207 games. He hit 18 home runs in 2021, and leads the league with 27 in 2022. On Sept. 9 at Biloxi, he broke the franchise single season home run record, surpassing Ernesto Mejia (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single season franchise record (26). Lugbauer also set club record with seven RBI on Saturday, July 2 at

- Lugbauer hit a walk-off three-run homer on July 8 vs. Pensacola and a walk-off single June 3 vs. Montgomery. He is in league's top 10 in...home runs (27, 1st), RBI (79, 1st), XBH (51, 2nd), walks (74, 3rd), doubles (24, 9th), and total bases (200, 2nd).
- GIVE ME MO MORITZ: Andrew Moritz homered in back-to-back games on Tuesday and Wednesday, for his first two long balls of the season, logging four hits in each game. On the series, the outfielder is 9-for-18 with two homers, three doubles, five RBI and seven runs. Moritz became the first M-Brave to log back-to-back four hit games since Emerson Landoni had back-to-back five hits games, July 12-13 at Chattanooga in 2015.
- STRONG STARTING PITCHING: The M-Braves just lost a streak of eight games where the starting pitcher made it at least five innings (8/30-9/8), posting a 3.29 ERA (15 ER, 41.0 IP) over that span: Over that span: RHP Allan Winans (5.0 IP, 1 ER), LHP Dylan Dodd (11.0 IP, 3 ER), RHP Tanner Gordon (5.0 IP, 1 ER), RHP Alan Rangel (5.0 IP, 3 ER), RHP Nolan Kingham (5.0 IP, 5 ER), RHP Allan Winans (5.0 IP, 0 ER), RHP Tanner Gordon (5.0 IP, 2 ER).
- CALL HIM MR. MALLOY: Since his promotion on July 12, Justyn-Henry Malloy is hitting .292 with five home runs, 11 doubles, 29 RBI, 37 walks and .862 OPS in 47 games. He shot up the most recent prospect rankings, jumping up 14 spots to No. 13 in the Braves MLB Pipeline Top 30.
- The Georgia Tech product hit .301 in August with three home runs, eight doubles, 15 RBI, 20 walks, 20 runs, and .935 OPS.
- BIG BAD BUNNELL: Cade Bunnell is currently in his third stint with the M-Braves this season. In 37 games for Mississippi, he is batting .310 with seven home runs, nine doubles, two triples, 31 RBI, 29 walks, and 1.045 OPS. Bunnell was a 40th round pick in 2019 by Atlanta.
- Bunnell logged his first multi-homer game on August 25 at Birmingham, smashing a solo home run in the fourth, and three-run shot in the ninth.
- YOSEMITE SAM: INF/OF Cody Milligan has started 61 games in the leadoff spot. Since August 10, he is batting .344 with a .425 OBP, a home run, six doubles and eight RBI.
- MILLER TIME: INF Jalen Miller is at his best in clutch situations. With RISP, he is batting .328 with three home runs and 35 RBI., With RISP two outs, he's batting .333 with one homer, and 20 RBI. Overall, the Atlanta native is batting .238 with eight homers and 43 RBI this season.
- TAKE 'EM TO THE DELI: INF Riley Delgado keeps on hitting, ranking 7th in the Southern League with a .271 batting average. He holds a 13-game on-base streak. He had an eight-game hit streak from 7/23-8/4 and an 11-game hit streak from 5/13-25.
- LAST TIME AGAINST THE SHUCKERS: The M-Braves lost five of six games from August 2-7 but were only outscored by a combined 27-21. The M-Braves lone win came in game three when Darius Vines tossed six innings of one-run ball and the M-Braves posted five runs in the fifth en route to a 9-4 victory. In game four, Drew Lugbaur smacked his 40th career home run as an M-Brave, tucking a two-run homer inside the right-field foul pole. Jalen Miller hit .333 with two doubles and four RBI in the series. In game five, LHP Dylan Dodd logged his second quality start, going six innings and allowing two runs.
- M-BRAVES TO MLB IN 2022: OF Drew Waters (8/22), C Shea Langeliers (8/16), RHP Freddy Tarnok (8/16), INF Vaughn Grissom (8/10), INF Joey Meneses (WSH, 8/2), RHP William Woods (ATL, 4/27), RHP Bryce Elder (4/12), OF Michael Harris II (5/28 from MIS), and LHP Joey Wentz (DET, 5/11) as former M-Braves to make their MLB debut this season. In total, 160 have made their debuts, and 23 promoted directly from Mississippi since 2005.
- VALDÉS JOINS ELITE COMPANY: Catcher Javier Valdés became the first Mississippi Braves player to homer in his first two Double-A games on Tuesday and Wednesday. He was the first M-Brave to homer in his debut since Ronald Acuña Jr. homered on the first pitch he saw at the Double-A level on May 10, 2017 vs. Mobile.
- THE COMEBACK KIDS: The M-Braves have come back in the eighth inning or later 10 times this season after just two such comebacks last season. Against the Barons, the M-Braves scored four of the final five runs to win an 11-inning thriller on August 27. On August 29, Bunnell smashed a game-winning grand slam in the ninth. On September 2, the M-Braves scored four runs in the eighth in a 9-7 comeback win over the Smokies.

APRIL SHOWERS, MAY FLOWERS, JUNE THUNDERSTORMS, JULY SUNSHINE, AUGUST TORNA-DOS: After going 7-13 in April, the M-Braves turned it around with a league-best 16-10 record in May. In June, the club was 7-19, tying their club record for losses in June. The M-Braves went 16-8 in July. The 16 wins were 2nd in AA and T-5th in MiLB, and included a six-game sweep of Rocket City (first six-game sweep in club history). The M-Braves finished 10-15 in August, continuing the remarkable trend.
