TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game series against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. This is the final meeting between these two clubs in the regular season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves blasted four home runs, eight extra-base hits and 15 hits in 13-2 win over the Shuckers. Cody Milligan and Andrew Moritz each hit their first Double-A home runs and finished a triple shy of the cycle. Moritz went 4-for-5 with a home run, two doubles and two RBI. Milligan went 3-for-5 with a home run, a double, a walk and three RBI. Jalen Miller and Justin Dean each reached base four times. RHP Allan Winans covered five innings and allowed no earned runs in his first win with the M-Braves.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: M-Braves starting pitchers have made it at least five innings in 13 of the last 17 games. All starters have gone at least five innings in the past six games, posting a 3.19 ERA (11 ER, 31.0 IP): RHP Allan Winans (5.0 IP, 1 ER), LHP Dylan Dodd (6.0 IP, 1 ER), RHP Tanner Gordon (5.0 IP, 1 ER), RHP Alan Rangel (5.0 IP, 3 ER), RHP Nolan Kingham (5.0 IP, 5 ER), DIN BURN HIGH STRONG (5.0 IP, 5 ER), THE NOLAN HIGH STRONG (5.0 I RHP Allan Winans (5.0 IP, 0 ER).

CALL HIM MR. MALLOY: Since his promotion on July 12, Justyn-Henry Malloy is hitting .282 with five home runs, 11 doubles, 27 RBI, 30 walks and .846 OPS in 43 games. He shot up the most recent prospect rankings, jumping up 14 spots to No. 13 in the Braves MLB Pipeline Top 30.

The Georgia Tech product hit .301 in August with three home runs, eight doubles, 15 RBI, 20 walks, 20 runs, and .935 OPS

BIG BAD BUNNELL: Cade Bunnell is currently in his third stint with the M-Braves this season. In 33 games for Mississippi, he is batting .327 with seven home runs, eight doubles, two triples, 30 RBI, 27 walks, and 1.084 OPS. Bunnell was a 40th round pick in 2019 by Atlanta

Bunnell logged his first multi-homer game on August 25 at Birmingham, smashing a solo home run in the fourth, and three-run shot in the ninth.

THE SLUGBAUER MAKING MISSISSIPPI HISTORY: 1B Drew Lugbauer has hit a club-record 42 career M-Braves home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021, and is tied for the league lead with 24 in 2022. He is currently two home runs away from tying Ernesto Mejia's (2012) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single season franchise record (26). Lugbauer also set club record with seven RBI on Saturday, July 2 at Biloxi.

Lugbauer hit a walk-off three-run homer on Friday, July 8 vs PNS and a walk-off single on Friday, June 3 vs MTG. He is in league's top 10 in...home runs (24, T-1st), RBI (72, 2nd), XBH (48, 3rd), walks (72, 3rd), doubles (24, T-8th), and total bases (187, 6th).

YOSEMITE SAM: INF/OF Cody Milligan has started 57 games in the leadoff spot. He has hit in 17 of his last 19 games since August 10, batting .395 with a .465 OBP, a home run, six doubles

MILLER TIME: INF Jalen Miller is at his best in clutch situations. With RISP, he is batting .333 with three home runs and 34 RBI., With RISP two outs, he's batting .333 with one homer, and 20 RBI. Overall, the Atlanta native is batting .237 with eight homers and 42 RBI this season.

TAKE 'EM TO THE DELI: INF Riley Delgado keeps on hitting, ranking 6th in the Southern League with a .274 batting average. He had an eight-game hit streak from 7/23-8/4 and an 11-game hit streak from 5/13-25.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE SHUCKERS: The M-Braves lost five of six games from August 2-7 but were only outscored by a combined 27-21. The M-Braves lone win came in game three when Darius Vines tossed six innings of one-run ball and the M-Braves posted five runs in the fifth en route to a 9-4 victory. In game four, Drew Lugbaur smacked his 40th career home run as an M-Brave, tucking a two-run homer inside the right-field foul pole. Jalen Miller hit .333 with two doubles and four RBI in the series. In game five, LHP Dylan Dodd logged his second quality start, going six innings and allowing two runs.

M-BRAVES TO MLB IN 2022: OF Drew Waters (8/22), C Shea Langeliers (8/16), RHP Freddy Tar-nok (8/16), INF Vaughn Grissom (8/10), INF Joey Meneses (WSH, 8/2), RHP William Woods ., 4/27), RHP Bryce Elder (4/12), OF Michael Harris II (5/28 from MIS), and LHP Joey Wentz DET. 5/11) as former M-Braves to make their MLB debut this season. In total, 160 have made their debuts, and 23 promoted directly from Mississippi since 2005.

VALDÉS JOINS ELITE COMPANY: Catcher Javier Valdés became the first Mississippi Braves player to homer in his first two Double-A games on Tuesday and Wednesday. He was the first M-Brave to homer in his debut since Ronald Acuña Jr. homered on the first pitch he saw at the Double-A level on May 10, 2017 vs. Mobile.

THE GORDON MOBILE: In his last six starts, RHP Tanner Gordon has a 2.90 ERA over 31.0 innings The Indiana product went at least five innings in five of those six starts. He has eight walks to 29 strikeouts over that span. Gordon finished 3-0 with a 3.48 ERA in the month of August.

THE COMEBACK KIDS: The M-Braves have come back in the eighth inning or later 10 times this season after just two such comebacks last season. Against the Barons, the M-Braves scored four of the final five runs to win an 11-inning thriller on August 27. On August 29, Bunnell smashed a game-winning grand slam in the ninth. On September 2, the M-Braves scored four runs in the eighth in a 9-7 comeback win over the Smokies.

APRIL SHOWERS, MAY FLOWERS, JUNE THUNDERSTORMS, JULY SUNSHINE, AUGUST TORNA-DOS: After going 7-13 in April, the M-Braves turned it around with a league-best 16-10 record in May. In June, the club was 7-19, tying their club record for losses in June. The M-Braves went 16-8 in July. The 16 wins were 2nd in AA and T-5th in MiLB, and included a six-game sweep of Rocket City (first six-game sweep in club history). The M-Braves finished 10-15 in August, continuing the remarkable trend.

LAST TIME OUT

Dodd gave up just one earned run in six innings, striking out a season-high nine batters with no walks.
