HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 8-6 all-time @ Angel Stadium...the D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 games vs. Angels since June 15, 2015.

- ◆ Caleb Smith is making his third start of 2020 (1 with Marlins, 1 with D-backs).
- Made his D-backs debut on Sept. 11 vs. Mariners (ND)... in 3.0 innings, allowed 1 run on 1 hit (home run) with 1 walk and 3 strikeouts.
- ◆ David Peralta, in 12 games vs. AL West this season, is hitting .333 (14-for-42)/1.063 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 11 RBI and 5 walks.
- ♦ Kole Calhoun, in his last 7 games, is hitting .333 (8-for-24)/1.192 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI, 1 HBP and 3 walks.
- ♦ Last night was the 13th time since 2017 the D-backs have hit 5+ home runs in a game (12-1 in those contests).

CALHOUN GOES OFF IN HIS RETURN: Kole Calhoun set a career high with 5 RBI and matched his career best with 2 home runs (sixth time) in his first game against his former team and in his return to Angel Stadium...his 3 hits were 1 shy of tving his career high 4 hits (5 times).

♦ His first home run of the game was career homer No. 150.

CRICHTON DROPPING ZEROES ON THE ROAD: Stefan Crichton has 9 scoreless outings on the road this season (10.0 IP).

- ♦ Is 1 of 5 relievers (min. 9 GR) to not allow a run on the road this season along with Dylan Floro/LAD (9 G), Darren O'Day/ATL (9 G), Drew Pomeranz/SD (9 G) and Phillips Valdez/BOS (9 G).
- ♦ Since 2019, has held opponents scoreless in 17 of 19 road games (7 ER in 19.1 IP).

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona is 16-8 (.667) in its last 24 games vs. AL opponents and is 21-12 (.636) since 2019.

♦ The D-backs' .636 interleague winning pct. since 2019 is third in the Majors, behind the Rays (.667; 22-11) and Braves (.639: 23-13).

AT THE DISH: Nick Ahmed is hitting .333 (12-for-36)/.789 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 4 walks in his last 10 games.

- ◆ Christian Walker's 20 RBI since Aug. 24 are tied for fourth in the NL with Adam Duvall/ATL behind Freddie Freeman/ATL (29); Marcell Ozuna/ATL (25); and Eugenio Suarez/CIN (21).
- ◆ Josh VanMeter has reached base safely in his first 3 games as a D-back, hitting .273 (3-for-11)/.385 OBP/.455 SLG with 2 doubles, 1 RBI and 2 walks.

TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

ESCOBAR'S COMMUNITY IMPACT: Eduardo Escobar is the D-backs' 2020 Roberto Clemente Award nominee for his impact efforts with the local community.

- ♦ On Monday, prior to the team's departure, he did a socially-distanced congratulatory surprise for Summer Palacios from Madrid Neighborhood School, the 2020 D-backs Most Valuable Teachers Award "Teacher of the Year" winner, as recognized by the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation and Raytheon Missiles & Defense...to learn more about the program: dbacks.com/mvt.
- ♦ Yesterday, in conjunction with Hispanic Heritage Month, he did a virtual meet-and-greet with students at Valencia Newcomer School, visiting with 3 classrooms and giving the students an opportunity to practice their speaking

DEFENSE RULES: The D-backs lead the NL with a .986 fielding pct. ahead of the Cubs (.985), Reds (.985) and Brewers (.985), and are third in the NL with 44 double plays behind the Rockies (60) and Phillies (46).

THE PEN: The D-backs' bullpen, in its last 6 games, is 3-1 with 3 saves, a 2.81 ERA (8 ER in 25.2 IP) and .172 opp. average.

LOCASTRO BASEBALL'S FASTEST MAN: Tim Locastro leads the Majors with an average sprint speed of 30.8 ft/sec, ahead of Roman Quinn/PHI (30.4) and Trea Turner/WSH (30.1)...in 2019, Locastro also led the Majors in 2019 at 30.8 ft/sec.

♦ Locastro has been successful in his first 25 career stolen base attempts, tied for the third-longest stolen base streak to start a career (since 1951 - when steals were tracked)...he is tied with Quintin Berry/DET-BOS-BAL (2012-14) and Jacoby Ellsbury/BOS (2007-08) behind Tim Raines/MON (27, 1979-81) and Mitchell Page/OAK (26, 1977) [source: Sportradar].

2017 DRAFT: The D-backs have 2 signees from their 2017 draft class on the current roster: first-round pick Pavin Smith (seventh overall) and second-rounder Daulton Varsho.

NEXT STARTER: LHP ALEX YOUNG (2-3, 4.42)

- ♦ Will make his sixth start of the season (8 relief outings).
- ♦ Will be his first time facing the Angels...will be his third career Interleague start (1-1, 3.86 ERA).

CAREER RECAP: In 2019, was 10-11 with a 4.52 ERA (77 ER in 153.1 IP), .223 opponent average and 168 strikeouts in 28 starts for the Marlins...his .223 opponent average ranked 11th in the NL (min. 150.0 IP).
