Two Outs

The Dodgers scored four of their eight runs with two outs last night, and for the season, the Braves have allowed 264 such runs.

That total is the most in the National League by far, 23 more than the next closest team, the Colorado Rockies.

Only Baltimore (321) and Seattle (270) have allowed more two-out runs this season.

LOOKING FOR 30/30: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. enters tonight's game with a National League-most 29 stolen bases this season, leaving him one shy of the fifth 30 home run/30 stolen base season in Braves franchise history.

Acuña Jr. is also looking to become the second player in baseball history to have at least 30 home runs and 30 stolen bases in a season prior to his 22nd birthday...The only player to do so was Mike Trout, who had 30 home runs and 49 stolen bases as a 20-year-old in 2012.

Only three Braves have gone 30/30 at any age, with OF Ron Gant doing it last in 1990 and 1991.

OF Hank Aaron was the first to do so, accomplishing the feat in 1963, while OF Dale Murphy also did it in 1983.

30/30 BY TEAM GAME: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. stands one stolen base away from a 30/30 season, and today is team game No. 125...The quickest a Braves player has ever recorded a 30/30 season is team game No. 149, set by Ron Gant in 1991...The quickest major leaguer to accomplish the feat in the modern era was Cincinnati's Eric Davis, who needed just 105 team games and 90 personal games in 1987.

Gant needed 154 games for his first 30/30 season in 1990...Hank Aaron used 160 team games for the first 30/30 season in Braves history, while Dale Murphy accomplished the feat in 153 team games during the 1983 season.

FOLTYNEWICZ STARTS: RHP Mike Foltynewicz has won both of his starts since returning from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 5, with the Braves scoring 17 runs in those two games.

Over Foltynewicz's last five starts at the major league level, the Braves are 5-0 and have scored 52 total runs (10.4 per game).

They beat Pittsburgh, 7-5, on June 11, Philadelphia, 15-1, on June 16, Washington, 13-9, on June 22, Minnesota, 12-7, on August 6, and Miami, 5-4, on August 11.

In Foltynewicz's first eight starts of the season, the Braves scored 24 total runs, including just 15 while the righty was on the mound...Atlanta went 1-7 in these games.

4.5 UP: The Braves enter play today with a 4.5-game lead in the National League East, the club's smallest division lead since after play on July 29, when they were also 4.5 ahead of second-place Washington.

The last time the Braves' division lead was less than 4.5 games was after play on June 19, when they were 4.0 games up.

After play on this date last season, the Braves had a half game lead over second-place Philadelphia.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Dodgers continue a three-game series tonight with the fifth of six matchups between the teams this season...The Dodgers swept the first series between the teams this season, May 6-8, outscoring the Braves, 23-7.

The Braves have dropped 27 of their last 37 regular season games with the Dodgers since the beginning of the 2014 season...They also dropped three of four to the Dodgers in the 2018 NLDS last season.

Over these last six years, the Braves have won one series against the Dodgers in 11 tries...They took two of three at Dodger Stadium, July 20-22, 2015.

The Braves last won a home series from the Dodgers in 2013, when they swept three games, May 17-19.

RH Mike Foltynewicz is set for his fourth career start against the Dodgers and his second this season...The righty went 6.0 innings and allowed five runs, earned, in a 9-4 loss on May 8 at Dodger Stadium...He also faced the Dodgers twice in the postseason last year, allowing five runs, earned, over 6.0 combined innings.

LH Hyun-Jin Ryu is 1-1 with a 1.98 ERA (6 ER/27.1 IP) in four career starts against the Braves...He tossed a four-hit shutout on May 7 of this season at Dodger Stadium to beat the Braves, 9-0...Since the beginning of July, Ryu has allowed two earned run total in 39.2 innings (0.45 ERA).

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today recalled OF Adam Duvall from Triple-A Gwinnett and placed OF Ender Inciarte on the 10-day injured list with a right hamstring strain.

Duvall returns to the club after he was optioned to the Stripers yesterday.

In 19 games with the Braves this season, Duvall is hitting .250 with five home runs and 10 RBI...He has five hits over his last 43 at-bats (.116) spanning 13 games.

VS. LHP: The Braves are set to face their 29th left-handed starter tonight in Hyun-Jin Ryu, and Atlanta is 18-10 in these games so far this season.

The 28 games against lefties is tied for the fifth fewest in the league...Only St. Louis (24), Detroit (25), San Diego (26), and Chicago-NL (27) have faced fewer lefty starters.

2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .402 (47-for-117) against lefties this season, the best mark in the National League among qualifiers...Only Baltimore's Hanser Alberto at .404 (65-for-161) has a better average in all of baseball.

Albies has nine hits in his last 13 at-bats against lefties (.692), three of which have been home runs...Overall, he is slugging .701 against lefties with nine home runs and 16 extra-base hits.

- Is 1-0 with 3.91 ERA (11 ER/25.1 IP) in 34 games with Atlanta...Twenty-eight of his 34 appearances have been scoreless, including 15 of his last 18.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 1.93 ERA (5 ER/23.1 IP) against all other teams.
- Nineteen of his 34 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .159 (7-for-44) average with 14 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-51 (.255).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignemnt by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

Shane Greene • RHP • 6-4 • 200 • 30 yrs • #19

Saves/Opp: 0/2 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 7/2 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/4

- Is 0-1 with an 11.81 ERA (7 ER/5.1 IP) in seven games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.49 ERA (12 ER/43.1 IP) in 45 games on the season...He has converted 22 of 27 save opportunities.
- Retired all three batters he faced, 8/14 vs. NYM, for his first clean inning with Atlanta...Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and also allowed all four of his inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...Prior to joining the Braves ranked fourth in the American League with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball to San Diego's Kirby Yates among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 27 yrs • #77

Saves/Opp: 18/25 **Holds:** 4 **1st Batter/Retired:** 54/35 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/9

- Is 6-2 with a 3.54 ERA (22 ER/56.0 IP) in 54 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for second most in the majors.
- Per Statcast, has an expected batting average of just .210 and an average exit velocity of 87.1 mph...Opponents are officially batting .271 (60-for-221).
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miama...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Left-handers have just 15 hits in 82 at-bats (.183) against him...Righties are hitting .324 (45-for-139).
- Has fanned 74 batters in 56.0 innings for a career-best 11.89 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Recorded his second consecutive two-inning save, 5/15 vs. STL, to become the first Braves closer with back-to-back two-inning saves since Hall of Famer John Smoltz in 2002

Chris Martin • RHP • 6-8 • 225 • 33 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 7/6 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 1/1

- Is 1-3 with a 3.92 ERA (19 ER/43.2 IP) in 45 games on the season, including a 9.53 ERA (6 ER/5.2 IP) in seven games with Atlanta.
- Earned his first hold with the Braves, 8/11 at MIA...Fanned two in a scoreless inning.
- Acquired from Texas on 7/30 in exchange for LHP Kolby Allard...Made his Braves debut on 8/2 vs. CIN with a perfect eighth inning.
- Went 0-2 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP) in 38 games out of the bullpen for Texas this season with 43 strikeouts and just four walks.
- Before joining Atlanta, had a rate of 0.95 BB/9 which ranked fifth best among qualifying relievers in the majors.
- Was in his second season with the Rangers, joining Texas as a free agent in December of 2017.

- Is 4-2 with a 4.18 ERA (24 ER/51.2 IP) in 50 games this season between Atlanta and San Francisco...In seven games with the Braves, has a 10.13 ERA (6 ER/5.1 IP), but a 0.78 FIP.
- Converted his first save chance with the Braves, 8/13 vs. NYM...Was his 184th career save.
- Allowed four runs in 0.1 inning, 8/10 at MIA...The outing stopped an 11-game scoreless streak that dated to 7/14.
- Acquired from San Francisco in exchange for RHP's Dan Winkler and Tristan Beck on 7/31...Was 4-2 with a 3.50 ERA (18 ER/46.1 IP) in 43 appearances out of the San Francisco pen.
- Prior to joining Atlanta, owned a 27-26 career record with a 2.82 ERA (176 ER/562.1 IP) and 183 saves in 560 games, all in relief...His 183 saves ranked seventh most among all active pitchers...Among qualified active relievers, his 85.1 (183-for-215) career save percentage was fifth best in the majors.

Sean Newcomb • LHP • 6-5 • 255 • 26 yrs • #15

- Is 5-3 with a 3.54 ERA (21 ER/53.1 IP) in 39 games this year, including four starts...Has 12 holds and just two blown saves.
- Has pitched to a 13.50 ERA (10 ER/6.2 IP) in his last eight appearances, allowing five walks and four homers...Has been scored on in five of the eight outings.
- Went a career-high 11 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run, 5/29-6/29...Has nine relief appearances of more than 1.1 inning, including five of more than 2.0 frames.
- Opened the year in the starting rotation, before moving to the bullpen on 5/4...Has a 3.52 ERA (15 ER/38.1 IP) in 35 games in relief...Has issued just 10 walks and struck out 41 hitters since joining the bullpen.
- Recorded his first career save, 5/20 at SE...Became the first Braves pitcher to start multiple games and earn a save in the same season since Matt Wisler in 2016.

Anthony Swarzak • RHP • 6-4 • 215 • 33 yrs • #38

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 16 **1st Batter/Retired:** 31/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/6

- Is 0-1 with a 2.79 ERA (9 ER/29.0 IP) in 31 appearances with the Braves, and 2-3 with a 3.59 ERA (17 ER/42.2 IP) over 46 games on the season...Atlanta acquired him from the Seattle Mariners, 5/20, in exchange for LHP Jesse Biddle and RHP Arodys Vizcaino.
- Since returning from the injured list on 7/12, is 0-1 with a 6.17 ERA (8 ER/11.2 IP) in 14 games...In 17 games with Atlanta prior to the stint, had a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP).
- Twenty-six of his 31 outings since joining the Braves have been scoreless.
- Had a 17.0-inning scoreless streak that dated to 5/31, and was the longest scoreless stretch in the majors at the time...Was also the longest scoreless streak of his career.
- Opponents are batting just .228 (37-for-162) against him, with lefties hitting .224 (13-for-58) and righties batting .231 (24-for-104)...Thirteen of the 37 hits he's allowed have gone for extra bases (1 2B, 1 3B, 11 HR).

Josh Tomlin • RHP • 6-1 • 190 • 34 yrs • #32

Saves/Opp: 2/4 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 40/28 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 23/3

- Is 1-1 with a 4.29 ERA (31 ER/65.0 IP) in 40 games this season...Recorded his first career save, 6/9 at MIA.
- Pitched a career-most 5.0 innings of relief, 8/15 vs. NYM...Threw 67 pitches.
- Has walked seven batters in 65.0 innings on the season for a 0.97 BB/9.0 IP mark, the best in the majors (min. 50 IP).
- His 65.0 innings pitched are most among National League relievers...Has gone at least 2.0 innings in 19 of his appearances.
