HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs, who have lost 7 straight road games, conclude their 3-game series tonight @ Dodger Stadium.

- ♦ Arizona starters have given up 2 earned runs or fewer in 8 of their last 10 games (2.96 ERA; 17 ER in 51.2 IP).
- ☐ D-backs starters have posted a 1.90 ERA and a .181 opponent average in their last 4 road games.
- ◆ Christian Walker is hitting .341 (14-for-41)/1.090 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers and 12 RBI in his last 11 games. ☐ Has homered 4 times in his last 8 games after just once in his
- first 28.

ROSTER MOVE: Prior to tonight's game, the D-backs recalled RHP Travis Bergen (BER-gehn) from their Alternate Training Site and optioned RHP Joel Payamps to their Alternate Training Site.

♦ Bergen was acquired from the Blue Jays on Aug. 31 for LHP Robbie Ray and cash considerations.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY GONZO!: D-backs great Luis Gonzalez turns 53 today...Gonzo played 8 seasons with the D-backs (1999-2006) before signing with the Dodgers as a free agent on Dec. 8, 2006.

♦ In his lone season with Los Angeles (2007), Gonzalez hit .278 with 15 home runs and 68 RBI.

HOLLYWOOD'S WALK(ER) OF FAME: Christian Walker is hitting .387 (12-for-31)/.406 OBP/.903 SLG with 1 double, 5 home runs and 10 RBI in his last 10 games @ Dodger Stadium.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: The D-backs' 67 runs after the sixth inning are fifth most in the Majors behind the Padres (82), Giants (70), Dodgers (70) and Rockies (68).

ON DECK - SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS: Following tonight's game the D-backs will play a 4-game series @ Oracle Park.

- ◆ Arizona is 1-5 vs. San Francisco, losing all 3-games in its first trip to Oracle Park from Aug. 21-23.
- ♦ Madison Bumgarner spent 11 seasons with the Giants and was 119-92 with a 3.13 ERA...he will be making his first start against San Francisco on Saturday, nearly 11 years after making his debut on Sept. 8, 2009 vs. Padres.

NEXT STARTER: RHP TAYLOR CLARKE (1-0, 2.22)

- ♦ Is 0-0 with a 2.00 ERA (2 ER in 9.0 IP) in 2 starts this season.
- ♦ Did not factor in the decision in his last start on Aug. 30 vs. Giants (1 ER in 5.0 IP)...tied his career high with 7 strikeouts (second time).
- ♦ Has gone 1-2 with a 6.75 ERA (12 ER in 16.0 IP) in 4 career starts vs. Giants...received a no decision on Aug. 30 @ Chase Field (1 ER in 5.0 IP).

AT A GLANCE: Is in his second season with the D-backs...acquired on Dec. 5, 2018 from the Cardinals along with current teammates C Carson Kelly and INF Andy Young.

· Last season, limited to 12 starts (4-3, 2.94 ERA) due to right forearm tightness and was on the injured list from May 27-Sept. 21.

VS. DODGERS: In 2 career starts, is 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (10 ER in 8.1 IP)...his lone start at Dodger Stadium was on March 31, 2019, a no-decision (5 R-4 ER in 4.1 IP) in an 8-7 loss.

• Also has 2 relief appearances (in 2018).

IN HIS LAST 5 STARTS: Has issued 1 walk in each of his last 5 starts while recording 23 strikeouts (10.35 K/9.0 IP).

VS. RIGHTIES: In his last 3 starts, has held righties to a .259 average (7-for-27) with 1 walk and 9 strikeouts.

GETTING AHEAD IN THE COUNT: When getting ahead in the count (0-1, 0-2, 1-2), is holding opponents to a .143 average (6for-42) with 0 walks and 21 strikeouts.

WEAVER'S INS & OUTS: Is 1-2 with a 4.61 ERA (7 ER in 13.2 IP) in his last 3 starts, compared to 0-3 with an 11.85 ERA (18 ER in 13.2 IP) in his first 4.

• 9 of 25 runs allowed have come in Innings 1-3 with opponents hitting .282 (24-for-85) with 5 walks and 28 strike-

THE "HEATER": Is averaging 94.5 mph and 2,446 rpms on his 4-seam fastball, up from 93.8/2,308 in 2019 and 93.7/2,324 in 2018

THE CARSON KELLY CONNECTION: Roomed with teammate Carson Kelly in 2015 with Single-A Adv. Palm Beach.

- Kelly has caught Weaver 21 times in the Majors, including 13 of his 19 starts with the D-backs.
- In 27 career Minor League outings together, Weaver was 14-5 with a 1.58 ERA.
