HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 6-5 in their last 11 games.

- Arizona boasts a 1.85 ERA (7 ER in 34.0 IP) and a .192 opponent average in its last 4 games.
D-backs starters have posted a 1.77 ERA (4 ER in 20.1 IP), 6 walks and 20 strikeouts in their last 4 games.
Kole Calhoun is hitting .375 (12-for-32)/1.395 OPS with 2 doubles, 6 home runs and 15 RBI in his last 9 games.
David Peralta, over his last 11 games, is batting .356 (16-for-45).

THANKS, BUT NO THANKS: Today's D-backs starter, Alex Young, was selected by the Rangers in the 32nd round of the 2012 draft but did not sign.

- Young threw for Texas following the draft in the northern suburbs of Chicago and later met over pizza but honored his commitment to Texas Christian University.

HORNED FROG FEVER: The D-backs currently feature 2 players that attended Texas Christian University in Fort Worth, Texas: Stefan Crichton and Alex Young.

- Additionally, Kevin Cron, who is on the Taxi Squad this homestand, was a member of the Horned Frog baseball team, while Alek Thomas committed to play football and baseball with TCU before signing with the D-backs in 2018.

TOUR DE CHASE: Last night in the sixth inning, the D-backs hit for the cycle with the first 4 hitters of the frame for the first time in club history (David Peralta double, Nick Ahmed triple, Pavin Smith single and Carson Kelly home run) [source: Sportradar].

ROUNDRIPPER ROUNDUP: The D-backs have hit 12 home runs over their last 7 games.

- 8 of Arizona's last 15 home runs (66.7 pct.) have come with a runner on base compared to 2 in the previous 16 (12.5) and 10 out of their first 36 (27.8).

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona is 19-10 in its last 29 games vs. AL opponents and is 24-15 (.615) since 2019.

- The D-backs' .615 interleague winning pct. since 2019 is tied for fourth best in the Majors with the Mets (24-15) and Padres (24-15) behind the Rays (.639; 23-13), Dodgers (.629; 22-13) and Braves (.622; 23-14).

DOUBLEHEADER DELIGHT: On Friday, the D-backs and Rockies will participate in the third-ever doubleheader @ Chase Field (Arizona has swept the previous 2).

- The first twinbill occurred on Aug. 22, 2012 vs. Marlins due to a scheduling conflict (Won: 3-2 and 3-0).
Arizona won both games of a scheduled doubleheader vs. Texas on May 27, 2013 (Won: 5-3 and 5-4).

ON DECK - COLORADO ROCKIES: The D-backs are 2-4 vs. Rockies this season (0-3 @ Chase Field).

- Arizona is hitting .319 with 45 runs scored (7.5 per game) in its 6 games vs. Colorado.
Christian Walker is batting .542 (13-for-24) with 3 doubles, 3 home runs and 9 RBI vs. Rockies, while David Peralta has gone 11-for-27 (.407) with 2 doubles and 7 RBI.

NEXT STARTERS: RHP ZAC GALLEN & RHP TAYLOR CLARKE

TAYLOR CLARKE: Will be making his fifth start of the season and first since Sept. 9 vs. Dodgers.

- Has gone 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA (9 ER in 18.0 IP) as a starter.
Aiming for first win as a starter since July 30, 2019.

ZAC GALLEN: Has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 9 of his 11 starts.

- Won his last start on Sept. 2 @ Astros (3 R-1 ER/6.0 IP).
Is 0-0 with a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) in 3 career starts vs. Rockies.

VS. RANGERS: Second career start...got the nod on July 16, 2019 and allowed 1 run ----over 5.1 innings in a 9-2 win @ Rangers.

- In 5 Interleague appearances (3 starts), is 2-2 with a 5.89 ERA (12 ER in 18.1 IP) and .254 opponent average...his 3 starts were on July 16, 2019 @ Rangers, Aug. 20, 2020 @ A's and Sept. 17, 2020 @ Angels.

WHAT EVER YOU NEED: Is 7-9 with a 4.44 ERA (51 ER in 103.1 IP) in 21 starts and 2-0 with a 2.95 ERA (7 ER in 21.1 IP) in 10 relief appearances.

- 6 of his 9 wins have come on the road.

DAYS STARTS: In 7 day starts, is 2-3 with a 4.36 ERA (16 ER in 33.0 IP), .246 opponent average, 8 walks and 33 strikeouts (9.00 K/9.0 IP).

2 WALKS OR FEWER: Has allowed 2 walks or fewer in 16 of his 21 career starts...in those 16 games, is 7-6 with a 4.28 ERA and .257 opponent average.

AVOIDING THE HARD CONTACT: His 41.0 hard-hit percentage (95+ MPH) is fourth lowest on the team...in 2019, had a 35.6 hard-hit pct.

- WITH HIS CURVEBALL: Opponents are 7-for-39 (.179) on his curveball this season and 14-for-107(.131) for his career.
