HERE'S THE STORY: Madison Bumgarner is making his second start since returning from the injured list (mid-back strain)... on Sept. 5 @ Giants, allowed 2 runs over 4.0 innings (3 H, 2 BB, 2 K)...in 35 career starts vs. Dodgers, is 15-14 with a 2.73 ERA (68 ER in 224.1 IP) and .233 opponent average.

- ◆ Eduardo Escobar has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games at a .289 clip (11-for-38)/.808 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 2 RBI and 1 walk.
- ◆ Josh VanMeter is starting at second base in his D-backs debut tonight...in 63 career starts for the Reds (2019-20), he had 12 doubles, 1 triple, 8 home runs, 20 RBI and 21

- ♦ Their .237 opponent average is fourth in the NL, behind the Dodgers (.204), Cardinals (.214) and Giants (.227).

ON DECK - MARINERS: The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 games vs. Mariners, dating back to June 18, 2012, outscoring them 61-44.

NEED FOR SPEED: Averaged 88.7 mph on his 4-seam fastball in his last start on Sept. 5, the highest of the season.

NOT SO FAMILIAR SURROUNDINGS: Will be making just his second start with the D-backs @ Chase Field.

2019 REVIEW: Went 9-9 with a 3.90 ERA, 1.13 WHIP and 203 strikeouts in a career-high-tying 34 starts for the Giants.
