HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 7-5 in their last 12 games.

- ◆ The D-backs are 4-0-2 in their last 6 doubleheaders.
- ◆ Arizona is hitting .319 with 45 runs scored (7.5 per game) in its 6 games vs. Colorado.
- ◆ **Zac Gallen** (GAME 1) is looking to win back-to-back starts for the first time in his career...**Taylor Clarke** (GAME 2) has allowed 1 earned run in 2 of his last 3 home starts.
- ◆ **Kole Calhoun** is hitting .361 (13-for-36)/1.298 OPS with 2 doubles, 6 home runs and 15 RBI in his last 10 games.
- ◆ **Nick Ahmed** has a 6-game hitting streak (.348; 8-for-23).

ROSTER MOVES: Earlier today, the D-backs reinstated RHP **Silvino Bracho** from the 45-day injured list (recovery from right elbow surgery) as the 29th player for the doubleheader and transferred RHP **Corbin Martin** to the 45-day injured list (recovery from right elbow surgery).

- ◆ Bracho, who underwent Tommy John surgery on March 13, 2019, will be making his first appearance with Arizona since Sept. 30, 2018 @ Padres.

EXTRA! EXTRA! Silvino Bracho is the fifth pitcher to serve as the extra player for the D-backs in a doubleheader: LHP Robbie Ray (May 6, 2015 @ Rockies), LHP Andrew Chafin (Aug. 13, 2014 @ Indians), RHP Zeke Spruill (May 25, 2014 @ Mets) and the late LHP Tyler Skaggs (May 27, 2013 vs. Rangers).

CARMINUCCI HONORED BY FCBL: D-backs independent league scout **Chris Carminucci** was recently announced as a member of the Futures Collegiate Baseball League's (FCBL) inaugural Hall of Fame class.

- ◆ Carminucci is noted as a "founding father" of the New England-focused league, playing an integral part of the startup and operation of both the Torrington Titans and Martha's Vineyard Sharks.

DOUBLEHEADER DELIGHT: Today, the D-backs and Rockies will participate in the third-ever doubleheader @ Chase Field (Arizona has swept the previous 2).

- ◆ The first twinbill occurred on Aug. 22, 2012 vs. Marlins due to a scheduling conflict (Won: 3-2 and 3-0).
- ◆ Arizona won both games of a scheduled doubleheader vs. Texas on May 27, 2013 (Won: 5-3 and 5-4).

...AND THAT'S EVERYONE: With today's doubleheader between the D-backs and Rockies, all Major League teams will have played a twinbill this season [source: Sportradar].

ANTONIOxANTONIO: The D-backs are the first team in baseball history to have an Antonio start both games of a doubleheader against them.

6TH INNING STATS: The D-backs have totaled 3 home runs, 10 runs and 11 hits in the sixth inning in the last 2 games.

MOUND MUSINGS: Arizona boasts a 2.09 ERA (10 ER in 43.0 IP) and a .196 opponent average in its last 5 games.

- ☐ D-backs starters have posted a 2.49 ERA (7 ER in 25.1 IP) during that span, while the bullpen owns a 1.53 mark (3 ER in 17.2 IP), including a current 9.0-inning scoreless streak.

ROUNDTRIPPER ROUNDUP: The D-backs have hit 15 home runs over their last 8 games.

- ◆ 9 of Arizona's last 18 home runs (50.0 pct.) have come with a runner on base compared to 2 in the previous 16 (12.5) and 10 out of their first 36 (27.8).

LOCASTRO A GO-GO: **Tim Locastro** has been successful in his first 26 career stolen base attempts, tied for the second-longest stolen base streak to start a career (since 1951 - when steals were tracked) [source: Sportradar].

- ☐ **HIGHEST SINGLE-SEASON AVG VS. ROCKIES:** **.588 - Hal Morris/CIN (1994)**; .577 - Hanley Ramirez/FLA (2009); .565 - Craig Wilson/PIT (2004); .560 - Derrek Lee/CHC (2005); .548 - Edgardo Alfonzo/NYM (2000); .548 - Martin Prado/ARI (2014); **.542 - Christian Walker/ARI (2020)** [min. 25 PA].

CALHOUN NEVER WANTS SEPTEMBER TO END: **Kole Calhoun**, who was named NL Player of the Week on Monday, has hit 7 home runs with 18 RBI in September, both among his monthly bests:

- ☐ **MOST HR IN A MONTH:** 10 - July 2018; **7 - Sept. 2020**, Aug. 2020 and Aug. 2015.
- ☐ **MOST RBI IN A MONTH:** 25 - July 2018; 22 - June 2017; 20 - July 2015; **18 - Sept. 2020** and Sept. 2013.

WYATT GONE WILD: On Wednesday, **Wyatt Mathisen** hit his first 2 Major League home runs vs. Rangers...notes on Mathisen's 2-homer day:

- ☐ Was the first NL position player to hit his first 2 career home runs in the same game from the No. 9 spot in the lineup [source: STATS LLC].
- ☐ Became the second D-back to hit their first 2 career home runs in a multi-homer effort (also: Conor Jackson on Aug. 6, 2005 vs. Rockies).
- ☐ Is the fourth player in team history to homer twice in a game, in which he started in the No. 9 spot in the lineup, joining Kelly Stinnett (July 19, 1999 @ Mariners), Micah Owings (Aug. 18, 2007 @ Braves) and Zack Greinke (April 2, 2019 @ Padres) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

NEXT STARTER: RHP LUKE WEAVER (1-8, 6.51)

- ◆ Has allowed 3 runs or fewer in 6 of his last 7 starts (4.32 ERA; 16 ER in 33.1 IP).
- ◆ Lost his last start on Sept. 19 @ Astros (3 ER in 5.1 IP).
- ◆ Is looking for his first win since Aug. 18 vs. A's.
- ◆ Has gone 1-1 with a 7.47 ERA (13 ER in 15.2 IP) in 5 career games (4 starts) vs. Rockies.
- ◆ Did not factor in the decision on Aug. 12 @ Coors Field (4 ER in 3.1 IP).

AT A GLANCE: Second season with the D-backs.
 • Acquired on July 31, 2019 from the Marlins for INF Jazz Chisholm.
 • Selected by the Cardinals' in the third round of the 2016 draft...traded to the Marlins as part of a deal that included Marcell Ozuna on Dec. 14, 2017.
 • Nicknamed "The Milkman" by a University of North Carolina broadcaster (up for debate why - because of his last name or because he "always delivered").

GALLEN LATELY: Has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 9 of his 11 starts.
 • Is looking to win back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.

LAST START: Ended a 2-game losing streak on Sept. 18 @ Astros, allowing 3 runs (1 earned) over 6.0 innings.
 • Was his first road win since July 24, 2019 @ White Sox (w/ Marlins).

QUITE A STREAK TO START: Set the Major League record with 23 games allowing 3 or fewer earned runs to begin a career (all starts), surpassing the 21-game stretch by Aaron Sele/ BOS, June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.

VS. ROCKIES: Is making his second start of the season.
 • Is 0-0 with a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) in 3 career starts.
 • Did not factor in the decision on Aug. 11 @ Coors Field (2 ER in 7.0 IP)...received a no decision in his lone start @ Chase Field on Aug. 19, 2019 (1 ER in 6.0 IP).

ON THE LEADERBOARD: Ranks among the NL leaders in quality starts (T-5th, 8), opponent average (6th, .207), innings (T-9th, 66.0) and ERA (10th, 3.00).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Opponents are hitting .103 (4-for-39) off his curveball (.203 in 2019).

RHP TAYLOR CLARKE ♦ #45 ♦ R/R ♦ 6-4/220 ♦ 27 (MAY 13, 1993)

AT A GLANCE: Is in his second season with the D-backs.
 • D-backs' third-round pick in the 2015 draft out of College of Charleston.

LAST OUTING: On Sept. 16 @ Angels, worked 5.0 innings in relief and got the win in a 9-6 victory.

LAST START: On Sept. 9 vs. Dodgers, allowed 4 runs in 6.0 innings.

VS. ROCKIES: Has 3 career games (2 starts) vs. Rockies.
 • His 2 starts were on May 30, 2019 @ Coors Field and Aug. 24, 2020 @ Chase Field.

VS. NL WEST: In his last 5 starts vs. NL West, has a 4.29 ERA (10 ER in 21.0 IP), .238 opponent average and 22 strikeouts (9.43 K/9.0 IP).

EMERGENCY START: On Aug. 24 vs. Rockies (1 ER in 4.0 IP), found out 40 minutes prior to first pitch he was starting in place of Merrill Kelly, who was scratched with right shoulder nerve impingement.

THE 4-SEAMER: Against his 4-seamer, opponents are hitting .197.

CH-CH-CHANGE: Opponents are hitting .100 (3-for-30) off his changeup this season after batting .186 (8-for-43) in 2019.
 • His .100 average is ninth lowest in the Majors (min. 50 pitches).

AS A STARTER: In his last 9 starts, including 5 allowing 2 runs or fewer, is 2-1 with a 4.08 ERA (18 ER in 39.2 IP), .232 opponent average, 1.21 WHIP, 13 walks and 39 strikeouts (8.85 K/9.0 IP).

LEFTIES & RIGHTIES: Left-handers are hitting .162 (11-for-68) with 2 homers in his last 15 games since Sept. 17, 2019.
 • In his last 10 games, righties are hitting .235 (20-for-85) with 23 strikeouts.
