**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs are 9-6 all-time @ Angel Stadium...the D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 games vs. Angels since June 15, 2015.

- ◆ **David Peralta** has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games at a .361 clip (13-for-36)/1.017 OPS with 1 double, 3 home runs, 7 RBI and 1 walk.
  - In 13 games vs. AL West this season, is hitting .370 (17-for-46)/1.162 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 13 RBI and 5 walks.
- ◆ **Kole Calhoun**, in his last 8 games, is hitting .345 (10-for-29)/1.228 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 home runs, 11 RBI, 1 HBP and 3 walks.
- ◆ **Nick Ahmed** is hitting .350 (14-for-40)/.809 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 RBI and 4 walks in his last 11 games.
- ◆ **Christian Walker's** 20 RBI since Aug. 24 are tied for fourth in the NL with Adam Duvall/ATL behind Freddie Freeman/ATL (29); Marcell Ozuna/ATL (25); and Eugenio Suarez/CIN (21).

**CALHOUN GOES OFF IN HIS RETURN:** **Kole Calhoun** is hitting .500 (5-for-10)/1.900 OPS with 3 home runs and 7 RBI this series.

- ◆ On Tuesday, set a career high with 5 RBI and matched his career best with 2 home runs (sixth time) in his first game against his former team and in his return to Angel Stadium...his 3 hits were 1 shy of tying his career high 4 hits (5 times)...his first home run of the game was career homer No. 150.
- ◆ With 12 home runs in 158 at-bats this season, his 13.17 at-bats/home run ratio is the best of his career, ahead of his 16.73 ratio last season, when he had a career-high 33 home runs in 552 at-bats.

**CRICHTON DROPPING ZEROES ON THE ROAD:** **Stefan Crichton** has 10 scoreless outings on the road this season (11.0 IP).

- ◆ Is 1 of 5 relievers (min. 9 GR) to not allow a run on the road this season along with Dylan Floro/LAD (9 G), Darren O'Day/ATL (9 G), Drew Pomeranz/SD (9 G) and Phillips Valdez/BOS (9 G).
- ◆ Since 2019, has held opponents scoreless in 18 of 20 road games (3.10 ERA, 7 ER in 20.1 IP) with a .241 opponent average and 23 strikeouts (10.18 K/9.0 IP).

**DEFENSE RULES:** The D-backs' .986 fielding pct. is tied for the NL lead with the Reds ahead of the Cubs (.985), Brewers (.985) and Braves (.985) and are third in the NL with 46 double plays behind the Rockies (62) and Phillies (49).

**AT A GLANCE:** Is in his second season with the D-backs...D-backs' second-round pick in the 2015 draft out of TCU.

**LAST OUTING - AUG. 11:** Came on in relief of Caleb Smith (3.0 IP) and worked 5.1 innings in a 4-3 win vs. Mariners...allowed 2 runs on 2 hits and 2 walks with 1 strikeout.

**LAST START - AUG. 6:** Worked 5.1 innings, allowing 3 runs on 7 hits in a 4-2 loss @ Giants...held the Giants to 1 run thru the fifth inning.

**VS. ANGELS:** First career appearance.

- In 4 Interleague appearances (2 starts), is 2-1 with a 3.45 ERA (6 ER in 15.2 IP) and .167 opponent average...in his 2 starts, is 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (4 ER in 9.1 IP) and .206 opponent average...his 2 starts were on July 16, 2019 @ Rangers and Aug. 20, 2020 @ A's.

**WHAT EVER YOU NEED:** Is 7-8 with a 4.02 ERA (45 ER in 100.2 IP) in 20 starts and 2-0 with a 2.95 ERA (7 ER in 21.1 IP) in 10 relief appearances.

- 6 of his 9 wins have come on the road.

**DAYS STARTS:** In 6 day starts, is 2-2 with a 2.97 ERA (10 ER in 30.1 IP), .202 opponent average, 7 walks and 31 strikeouts (9.20 K/9.0 IP).

**2 WALKS OR FEWER:** Has allowed 2 walks or fewer in 15 of his 20 career starts...in those 15 games, is 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA and .242 opponent average.

**AVOIDING THE HARD CONTACT:** His 40.8 hard-hit percentage (95+ MPH) is fourth lowest on the team...in 2019, had a 35.6 hard-hit pct.

**WITH HIS CURVEBALL:** Opponents are 6-for-36 (.167) on his curveball this season and 13-for-104 (.125) for his career.

- His .125 opponent average on his curveball is eighth in the Majors since 2019 (min. 200 pitches, 50 PA).

- ◆ The D-backs' .647 interleague winning pct. since 2019 is tied for the best in the Majors with the Rays (.647; 22-12) and ahead of the Padres (.629, 22-13), Braves (.622; 23-14) and Mets (.622, 23-14).

**THE PEN:** The D-backs' bullpen, in its last 7 games, is 4-1 and 4-for-4 in save opportunities with a 3.31 ERA (12 ER in 32.2 IP) and .200 opponent average.

**ON-DECK - HOUSTON ASTROS:** The D-backs took 2 of 3 vs. Astros from Aug. 4-6.

- ◆ Last played in Houston in 2018, dropping 2 of 3 from Sept. 14-16.
- ◆ The D-backs are 3-3 in their last 6 games @ Astros.
- ◆ **David Peralta**, in 17 career games vs. Astros, is hitting .361 (22-for-61)/.412 OBP/.541 SLG with 1 triple, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 6 walks.

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (1-2, 3.15)

- ◆ Set the Major League record with 23 games allowing 3 or fewer earned runs to begin a career (all starts), surpassing the 21-game stretch by Aaron Sele/BOS, June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.
