**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**OCT. 5**

**2017** - The Astros begin their World Series run with an 8-2 victory over the Red Sox in Game 1 of the ALDS in Houston...**RHP Justin Verlander** (2ER/6IP) earns the win in his first postseason start as an Astro...**3B Alex Bregman** and **2B Jose Altuve** hit back-to-back homers off **LHP Chris Sale** in the 1st inning to get the offense started.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Astros and Phillies will conclude their regular season schedules today at Minute Maid Park with a pitching matchup of **LHP Framber Valdez** opposite **LHP Bailey Falter**...following today's game, the Astros will not play again until Oct. 11 when they open the ALDS opposite the winner of the Wild Card series between the Blue Jays or Mariners.

**THE #1 SEED:** The Astros have clinched homefield advantage throughout the American League postseason...Houston will end this regular season with the best record in their league for the third time in franchise history (1980 and 2019 were the other two times).

**PILING UP WINS:** The Astros 105 wins are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only the 2019 club's 107-win total...Houston has now reached 100 wins five times in their history.

**PITCHING IN:** Astros pitchers hold the Triple Crown in the AL, leading in wins, ERA (2.90) and K's (1,509)...they also lead the AL in opp. avg. (.212), WHIP (1.10) and opp. OPS (.614)...**In The Pen:** Astros relievers have posted an MLB-best 2.78 ERA.

**FINISHING KICK:** The Astros have won 16 of their last 22 games and 18 of their last 25...their 21-9 (.700) record since September 1 is tied for first in the Majors.

Additionally, the Astros are an AL-best 41-27 (.603) vs. opponents that are currently at .500 or better.

**CHASING 1000:** The Astros earned their 1,000th win in Minute Maid Park regular season history last night...they are now 1,000-803 all-time at the venue.

**MILESTONE WIN:** The Astros had a huge 10-0 win over the Phillies last night, in which the pitching staff carried a no-hitter into the 9th and the offense produced 17 hits...**RHP Justin Verlander** (0ER/5IP) was the headliner, as he solidified himself as the front-runner for the AL Cy Young Award by tossing 5.0 hitless innings, striking out 10...**2B Jose Altuve** (3x3) and **DH Yordan Alvarez** (3x5) both had three-hit games, while **RF Kyle Tucker** hit a three-run homer in the victory.

**LONG TIME, NO SEE:** The Astros are facing the Phillies for the first time since 2017, when the Astros took two of three in a series at Citizens Bank Park, from July 24-26, 2017...the current series marks the Phillies first visit to Minute Maid Park since the Astros joined the AL in 2013...Philadelphia's last series in Houston was Sept. 13-16, 2012 (Houston won three of four).

**POSTSEASON CREDENTIALS:** By popular demand, the Astros have extended the deadline to apply for postseason credentials **for the ALDS thru TONIGHT**...credentials are available to be applied for at [Credentials.mlb.com](http://Credentials.mlb.com)...if you intend to cover ALDS games in road cities, you must apply through the home team...take note, the Division Series application is different than the ALCS and World Series credential application...if you wish to cover the Astros throughout the postseason, you must apply twice, once for the ALDS and then again for the ALCS & WS.

**HURRICANE RELIEF EFFORTS:** The Astros Foundation, Crane Freight and the Cajun Navy are working together to bring much-needed supplies to southwest Florida following last week's category four Hurricane Ian with a supply drive at Minute Maid Park. Tomorrow, Oct. 6 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. outside Union Station at Minute Maid Park, the Astros Foundation will be collecting cases of water, nonperishable food items, toiletries and diapers. Every person that drops off supplies will receive an Astros rally towel or promo item to celebrate a great regular season and help to cheer the Astros on in the 2022 postseason.

**LIKE A FINE WINE:** 39-year-old Astros ace **RHP Justin Verlander** put a final stamp on his Cy Young candidacy last night with 5.0 hitless innings, in which he struck out 10...Verlander leads the AL in wins (18), ERA (1.75), Adjusted ERA+ (220), WHIP (0.83), opponents OPS (.497) and opponent average (.186).

**HALL OF FAME COMPANY:** **RHP Justin Verlander** finished his season with a 1.75 ERA, which is the lowest posted by an Astros starting pitcher in a full season in club history, besting **RHP Roger Clemens**, who worked to a 1.87 ERA in 2005...additionally, Verlander's ERA is the lowest posted by an AL pitcher in a full season since the Red Sox **RHP Pedro Martinez** had a 1.74 ERA in his Cy Young season of 2000.

**BREGMAN DAY:** Today is the day of **3B Alex Bregman**, who's homered in all four of his Major League games played on Oct. 5...all four of those games were Astros wins:

**ROOKIE BOMBS:** **SS Jeremy Peña** hit his 22nd homer of the season last night, becoming just the third rookie in franchise history to hit 22 longballs in a single season...others on that list: **Yordan Alvarez** (27 HR in 2019) and **Carlos Correa** (22 HR in 2015).

**ALTUVE'S ROUND NUMBERS:** **2B Jose Altuve** went 3x3 with two doubles last night to raise batting average to .300 and his OPS to .920...not counting this season, Altuve has hit .300 for a full season five times in his career (2014-18) and has posted an OPS over .900 three times (2016-17, 2019).

**LAST START - 9/30 VS TB:** went 5.1 innings, losing a 2-game win streak...was just his 3rd loss since 7/9.

**QUALITY START STREAK:** tossed 25 straight quality starts from 4/25 to 9/18, setting the MLB record for the most consecutive quality starts in a single-season...streak also was the longest streak in MLB this year and tied for the 2nd-longest streak in MLB history when including multiple seasons...also extended the Astros franchise record (previously held by **RHP Mike Scott** (20g) in 1986).

- his 26 quality starts overall this season are the most in the Majors.
- was 1st pitcher in MLB to record 23 consecutive quality starts since **RHP Jacob deGrom** made 26 consecutive quality starts from 5/18/18-4/3/19.

**ABOUT FRAMBER:** the first-time All-Star and the Astros 2022 Opening Day starter has been one of the best pitchers in baseball dating back to the start of the shortened 2020 season.

- among AL starters this season, he ranks 1st in quality starts (26), T-2nd in home runs per 9.0 ratio (0.50), 8th in opponent OPS (.608), 1st in GB% (67.6), T-11th in ERA (2.89), 4th in innings (196.1) and T-2nd in wins (16).

**CAREER DOMINANCE:** has been a groundball machine in his Major League career...owns a career 66.7% groundball percentage, which ranks as the highest percentage in the Majors since the start of the 2018 season by 9.8 percentage points (min. 400 IP)...since ground ball percentage started being tracked in 1987, Valdez career ground ball percentage is the highest ever posted by a starting pitcher...he edged out **RHP Brandon Webb** (65.1%) in that category.

- has held lefty hitters to a .207 average (78x377) and a .603 OPS in the Majors...has allowed just 5 homers to lefties in his career (377 ABs).

**THE RISING:** after bouncing between bullpen and rotation his first 2 seasons (2018-19), has ascended to the top of the Astros rotation over the last 3 years (2020-22)...has been one of the best pitchers in the AL in that span, going 32-15 with a 3.09 ERA in 63 games (62 starts).

- in that time span, ranks 4th in the AL in ERA (3.09), 10th in opponent avg. (.226), 1st in GB% (67.2%) and T-2nd in wins (32) (min. 300 IP).

**IN THE ASG, 7/19 AT DODGER STADIUM:** made his first career All-Star roster for the Midsummer Classic at Dodger Stadium after being selected to the roster by MLB...was the 3rd pitcher used by the AL squad and pitched a scoreless 3rd inning, earning the win after the AL scored their 3 runs in the top of the 4th...as expected, got all 3 of his outs in the 3rd inning on groundouts...induced those from **Juan Soto**, **Manny Machado** and **Freddie Freeman**.

- made the 39th appearance by an Astros pitcher in the All-Star Game in MLB history and became the first Astros pitcher to earn a win...was also the first Astros pitcher to pitch in the ASG since **Justin Verlander** tossed 1.0 inning in a start back in 2019.

- 1 of 5 Astros selected to the 2022 All-Star Game, joining **2B Jose Altuve**, **DH Yordan Alvarez**, **RF Kyle Tucker** and **RHP Justin Verlander**.

- on Saturday vs. TB notched his 376th career double, which moved him past **Lance Berkman** (375 doubles) for 3rd-place in Astros history.
- recorded his MLB-leading 12th leadoff homer of the season on Sept. 27 vs. ARI... his 12 leadoff homers tie the franchise record for a single season, also reached by **George Springer** in 2019...is just 1 homer shy of matching the MLB record for leadoff homers in a single season, which was set by the Yankees **Alfonso Soriano** (13 HR) in 2003.
- is up to 103 runs scored on the season, which ranks 2nd in the AL...has scored 100+ runs in a season 4 times in his career (2016-17, 2021-22).
- since 8/1: .343 (69x201), 20 2B, 9 HR, 20 RBI, 1.006 OPS in 55 games.
- in the AL, ranks 2nd in runs (103), 3rd in OPS (.921), 3rd in SLG (.533) and 4th in OBP (.387).**
- is 18-for-19 in SB attempts this year and has stolen 16 straight without being caught...are his most SB in a season since the 2017 season (32).
- has 34 career 4-hit games, which ties club record held by **2B Craig Biggio**.
- named to his 8th career All-Star Game this year, which is a franchise record, besting **2B Craig Biggio**, who was selected 7 times in his Hall of Fame career.
- named the 2022 Astros nominee for the **Roberto Clemente Award**...also earned the 2022 **MLBPAA Heart & Hustle Award**.
