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BOSTON RED SOX (16-13) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (14-15)

STATE OF THE SOX: The Red Sox are 6-3 in their last 9 games and 9-6 in their last 15...They've outscored opponents 79-52 over that 15-game span, which began on 4/13...That is the AL's 2nd-best run differential in that time (SEA: +30).

- 🔴 Boston won a 3-game series vs. CHC over the weekend to improve to 5-3-1 in series play, including 2-2-0 at home (3-1-1 on the road).

WHERE WE LEFT OFF: The Red Sox earned a 5-4 walk-off win in Sunday's series finale against the Cubs.

- 🔴 Tyler O'Neill hit a game-winning RBI single in the 9th inning, his 4th career walk-off RBI (previous: 8/7/22 vs. ATL; walk-off walk against Kenley Jansen).
- 🔴 Tanner Houck started and allowed 1 run in 6.2 innings, striking out 9 batters and walking none.
- 🔴 Kenley Jansen retired all 3 batters he faced in the 9th inning, including 1 SO, and earned the win.

AT THE HELM: Sunday was Alex Cora's 456th win as Red Sox manager, passing Jimmy Collins for 5th-most in club history.

- 🔴 He has led the Sox to a 456-383 (.544) record, the 4th-highest win percentage in franchise history (min. 500 games managed).

HOME COOKING: The Red Sox are currently on a 6-game homestand vs. CHC (2-1) and SF (3 games).

- 🔴 16 of the Red Sox' 22 games from 4/9-5/2 are at home.
- 🔴 The Sox are 5-8 at home, compared to 11-5 on the road.
- 🔴 BOS is 10-23 in its last 33 home games, starting 8/12/23.

SOX & GIANTS: The Red Sox and Giants are playing their 4th ever series at Fenway Park, their first since 2019.

- 🔴 The Sox are 13-9 all-time against the Giants, including 6-2 at Fenway Park...Boston swept SF in the clubs' first 2 series at the venue, in 2007 and 2016, but lost a 3-game series in 2019 (1-2).
- 🔴 In 2023, the Red Sox lost a 3-game series at Oracle Park from 7/28-30 (1-2).

NATIONAL AFFAIRS: The Red Sox own MLB's most Interleague wins and best all-time winning percentage in Interleague games (313-222; .585).

- 🔴 Boston is 5-1 vs. NL teams this season, winning both Interleague series (3-0 at PIT, 2-1 vs. CHC).
- 🔴 5 of the Sox' 7 series from 4/19-5/12 are against NL teams (at PIT, vs. CLE, vs. CHC, vs. SF, at MIN, at ATL, vs. WSH).

GETTING BUSY: Prior to being off yesterday, Boston played 19 games in 20 days from 4/9-28, with 4/22 being the club's only off day in the span.

- 🔴 Yesterday was the Red Sox' 1st of 3 days off in a span of 11 days from 4/29-5/9 (off days 4/29, 5/6, 5/9).

49: A patch with Tim Wakefield's number 49 will be worn by players on their jersey sleeve throughout the season...The navy patch is shaped like a heart, a nod to Wakefield's role as Honorary Chairman of the Red Sox Foundation.

- 🔴 Later this season, the commemorative patch will be available for purchase at the Red Sox Team Store on Jersey Street, with proceeds benefitting the Red Sox Foundation.

HALL OF FAME: The Red Sox Hall of Fame Class of 2024 will include Trot Nixon, Jonathan Papelbon, Dustin Pedroia, and Red Sox front office trailblazer Elaine Weddington Steward.

- 🔴 Billy Rohr's 1967 one-hitter against NYY will be inducted as a Memorable Red Sox Moment.
- 🔴 The induction ceremony at Fenway Park on 5/29 will also include a special presentation of the Fenway Honors Award to Tim and Stacy Wakefield for their charitable achievements.
- 🔴 Tickets are available at redsox.com/fenwayhonors... Proceeds from the event benefit the Red Sox Foundation.

ALL TOGETHER NOW: The Red Sox have an MLB-best 9 players with at least 10 RBI: Rafaela-17, Duran-13, Wong-13, O'Neill-12, Abreu-11, Yoshida-11, Casas-10, McGuire-10, Valdez-10.

- 🔴 Five Red Sox players own an .800+ OPS with at least 50 PA, 2nd-most in the AL and 3rd most in MLB (BAL and LAD-6 each).
- 🔴 The Sox have 3 players with 5+ HR (Casas, O'Neill, Wong), tied for 3rd-most in the AL (BAL and NYY-4 each).

O'NAILED IT: Tyler O'Neill has hit 9 HR, tied with Marcell Ozuna for 3rd in MLB (1st: 10 HR-Trout and Henderson).

- 🔴 Of the 313 players with at least 50 PA this season, O'Neill ranks 1st in SLG (.729) and OPS (1.176), and 4th in OBP (.447).
- 🔴 His 9 HR are tied with George Scott (1966) and Hanley Ramirez (2015) for most in a player's first 20 games with the Red Sox...His .729 SLG is 3rd-highest in any player's first 20 games with the club, behind Scott and John Kroner (1935).

RUN PREVENTION UNIT: Boston leads the Majors with a 2.68 ERA (78 ER/262.1 IP), the club's lowest mark through a season's first 29 games since 1920 (2.47).

- 🔴 BOS also leads MLB in FIP (3.32) and ranks 3rd in WHIP (1.12), and 4th in SO/BB (3.43).
- 🔴 Boston is tied with PHI for the MLB lead with 5 shutouts.
- 🔴 The Sox lead MLB in unearned runs (28) and errors (24).

START ME UP: Red Sox starting pitchers lead MLB with a 2.07 ERA (34 ER/147.2 IP)...They also rank 2nd in MLB in opponent AVG (.213) and 3rd in WHIP (1.04).

- 🔴 Boston's 2.07 starter ERA is the franchise's lowest through 29 games in the Live-Ball Era (since 1920), and the lowest by an AL team since the 1981 Oakland Athletics (2.06).
- 🔴 All 7 pitchers who have made multiple starts for the Red Sox own a starter ERA no higher than 3.04, including an MLB-best 6 with a mark of 2.00 or better (min. 2 starts; see box on right).

THE INCREDIBLE HOUCK: Tanner Houck on Sunday recorded his 5th quality start of the season, and his 4th with 6.0+ IP and 1 or 0 runs allowed.

- 🔴 Houck's 5 quality starts are tied for most in the Majors.
- 🔴 He is the 3rd Sox pitcher to ever record 9+ SO and 0 BB in consecutive outings at Fenway Park, joining Pedro Martinez (2002) and Roger Clemens (1988).
- 🔴 In his last 7 starts, beginning 10/1/23, Houck is 4-2 with a 1.39 ERA, 47 SO, and a .193 opponent AVG (see below).

- 🔴 The second project-coming to Netflix later this year-is an untitled documentary looking back at the extraordinary and historic 2004 Red Sox season.

- Earned his first win with the Red Sox on Wednesday at CLE, allowing 0 runs over a career-high 5.0 IP...Retired 15 of the 18 batters he faced (3 H, 3 SO).
- Recalled from Triple-A Worcester prior to 4/13 vs. LAA...Posted a 0.87 ERA (1 ER/10.1 IP) over 2 starts with Worcester (8 H, 3 BB, 9 SO).
- This season, has thrown 28.6% sweepers, 27.1% sinkers, 24.3% changeups, and 20.0% cutters...Each of his 42 cutters thrown have been to left-handed batters.
- Ranks in MLB's 80th percentile or better in offspeed run value (89th), BB % (89th), extension (88th), chase % (81st), and hard-hit % (81st).
- Has held opponents to a .244 AVG (11-for-45, 1 HR)...Left-handed hitters are hitting .231 (6-for-26, 0 XBH, 5 SO) compared to right-handed hitters .263 (5-for-19, 2 XBH, 2 SO).
- Pitched in 10 games (all in relief) across 8 stints with the Rays in 2023...Each of his 10 appearances lasted at least 2.0 innings.

48 CHASE ANDERSON - RHP 7 G / 1 GS / 14.2 IP / 5.52 ERA / 1.16 WHIP

- Was charged with the loss Thursday at CLE after allowing 5 runs over 1.2 IP in his first start as a Red Sox (3 H, 3 BB, 2 HR).
- Has thrown at least 2.0 innings in 5 of his 7 outings this season.
- Has a 3-4 record in 13 career starts vs. SF (4.98 ERA, 65.0 IP, 36 ER, 55 SO).
- Earned a 3.0-inning save in each of his first 2 outings...Was only the 3rd pitcher to record a save of 3.0+ innings in each of his first 2 appearances with a franchise, joining Mike Morgan (2000, ARI) and Lance McCullers (1985, SD).

83 BRENNAN BERNARDINO - LHP 8 G / 1 GS / 10.2 IP / 0.84 ERA / 0.94 WHIP

- Tossed a scoreless 4th inning Saturday vs. CHC (1.0 IP, H, BB, SO).
- Has retired 30 of his 40 batters faced (4 H, 6 BB) since being recalled from Triple-A Worcester on 4/9.
- Allowed 1 run over 1.1 IP in 2 games (1 start) vs. SF (1 H, BB, 3 SO).
- Stranded 26 of his 30 inherited runners last year (86.7%), including each of his final 20 (beginning 6/12)...Posted a 1.80 ERA on the road (5 ER/25.0 IP).

71 CAM BOOSER - LHP 5 G / 0 GS / 7.0 IP / 3.86 ERA / 1.29 WHIP

- Retired each of the 6 batters he faced in the 7th and 8th innings on Saturday vs. CHC (2.0 IP, 3 SO).
- Has struck out at least 1 batter in each of his 7 outings this season (8 SO/7.0 IP).
- Excluding players who previously played in Japan, was the 1st player to make their MLB debut with the Red Sox at age 31 or older since Tommy Fine (32) on 4/26/1947 vs. PHI.
- Has made 4 outings for Triple-A Worcester, posting a 2.70 ERA (2 ER/6.2 IP).

50 KUTTER CRAWFORD - RHP 6 G / 6 GS / 33.1 IP / 1.35 ERA / 1.11 WHIP

- Is scheduled to start on Wednesday vs. SF...Allowed 1 run over 5.2 IP in his lone start against the Giants on 7/28/23 (W, 3 H, BB, 7 SO).
- Suffered his first loss of the season after allowing 4 runs (3 ER) over 6.0 IP on Friday night vs. CHC (10 H, 4 SO)...Allowed a season high in hits (10).
- In his last 10 starts (beginning 9/12/23), has recorded a 1.79 ERA, 0.99 WHIP, and .189 opponent AVG (55.1 IP, 11 ER, 38 H, 1 HR, 17 BB, 6 SO).
- Has allowed 0 HR in his last 49.2 IP (beginning 9/18/23 at TEX; 2nd inn.)... Is the longest active streak in MLB, and the longest by a Red Sox since Chris Sale went 75.0 innings in 2018.
- Was the 4th BOS pitcher in the Live-Ball Era (1920-present) to post a sub-0.70 ERA in their first 5 starts of the season, joining Roger Clemens in 1991 (0.66), Dave Ferris in 1945 (0.60) and Lefty Grove in 1936 (0.21).

89 TANNER HOUCK - RHP 6 G / 6 GS / 39.1 IP / 1.60 ERA / 0.92 WHIP

- Sunday, held CHC scoreless through the first 6 innings, then allowed 1 run in the 7th inn. (6.2 IP, 4 H, 0 BB, 9 SO)...Retired each of his first 10 batters faced.
- In his last 7 starts (beginning 10/1/23), has allowed 7 ER in 45.1 IP (1.39 ERA), and held opponents to a .193 AVG (32-for-166, 47 SO, 8 BB).
- Has issued only 5 walks in his 6 starts this season (39.1 IP)...Ranks T-4th among qualified MLB pitchers in walk rate (3.2%).
- On 4/17 vs. CLE, tossed the Sox's first 9-inning shutout since Michael Wacha on 6/6/22 at LAA.
- Was the 1st Red Sox shutout at Fenway Park since Brian Johnson on 5/27/17 vs. SEA, and the 1st in under 100 pitches since Clay Buchholz on 8/31/14 at TB.

74 KENLEY JANSEN - RHP 10 G / 0 GS / 9.2 IP / 1.86 ERA / 1.24 WHIP

- Earned his 1st win of the season after tossing a perfect 9th inning on Sunday vs. CHC (1.0 IP, SO, 10 pitches).
- Has retired each of his last 9 batters faced (3,0 IP, 5 SO).
- Earned his 425th career save on 4/20 at PIT, passing John Franco to take sole possession of 5th most in MLB history (4th: Francisco Rodríguez-437).
- Ranks T-7th in the AL in saves (5).
- Owens a 3.60 ERA (30 ER/75.0 IP) with 37 SV in 79 career games vs. SF.

76 ZACK KELLY - RHP 2 Gt / 0 GS / 4.0 IP / 0.00 ERA / 0.25 WHIP

- Tossed scoreless 8th and 9th innings Friday vs. CHC (2.0 IP, H, SO).
- Has retired 12 of his 13 batters faced since being recalled from Triple-A Worcester prior to Wednesday's game.
- Owens a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP) with 8 SO in 10 career games at Fenway Park.
- Has allowed 0 runs and only 1 hit while striking out 10 batters in 6 games for Worcester this season (9.0 IP, H, 8 BB).

55 CHRIS MARTIN - RHP 11 G / 0 GS / 11.1 IP / 5.56 ERA / 1.50 WHIP

- Entered the game on Sunday vs. CHC in the 7th inning with 2 outs and runners on 1st and 3rd base, stranded both runners...Allowed 3 runs in the 8th inn.
- Is 2-1 with a 2.10 ERA (8 ER/34.1 IP) in 37 career games at Fenway Park.
- Has allowed 8 ER in his last 47 outings beginning 6/9/23 (1.60 ERA, 45.0 IP).
- In his last 77 games (beginning 9/4/22), has posted a 1.56 ERA (13 ER/75.0 IP).
- Owens a 3.07 ERA (5 ER/14.2 IP) with 14 SO in 14 games vs. SF.

63 JUSTIN SLATEN - RHP 9 G / 0 GS / 16.1 IP / 0.55 ERA / 0.49 WHIP

- Earned his 2nd career win on Saturday vs. CHC after retiring each of the 6 batters he faced in the 5th and 6th innings (2.0 IP, 2 SO).
- Has allowed 1 ER over 8.2 IP at Fenway Park this season (7G, 1.04 ERA, 3 H, 5 SO).
- Has made 8 consecutive outings of more than 1.0 IP.
- Allowed a walk-off RBI single to his 1st career batter faced (Julio Rodríguez), but has retired 47 of his 54 batters faced since (4 H, 2 BB, HBP).
- Has held opponents to a .115 AVG (6-for-52) with just 1 XBH while averaging 12.67 pitches per inning (204 pitches, 16.1 IP).
- Ranked a top Sox prospect by *Baseball America* (No. 28) and *MLB.com* (No. 29).

39 NAOYUKI UWASAWA - RHP 0 G / 0 GS / 0.0 IP / --- ERA / --- WHIP

- Recalled from Triple-A Worcester prior to Sunday's game vs. CHC.
- Acquired from TB in a minor league trade on 3/27/24.
- Had a 2-1 record with a 4.80 ERA (8 ER/15.0 IP) over 3 starts in Triple-A Worcester...Allowed 1 run over 5.0 IP in his last start vs. Durham (5 H, BB, 7 SO).
- Posted a 3.19 ERA (396 ER/1,118.1 IP) in 173 games over 9 seasons for the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters of Nippon Professional Baseball...Tossed 14 complete games...Recorded an ERA below 3.50 in eight of his nine seasons.

57 GREG WEISSERT - RHP 12 G / 0 GS / 10.2 IP / 1.69 ERA / 1.13 WHIP

- Tossed a scoreless 6th inning on Thursday at CLE (1.0 IP, H).
- Has allowed 1 or 0 hits in 11 of his 12 outings this season.
- Has stranded 5 of his 7 inherited runners this season.
- Has held opponents to a .231 AVG (LHH: .313, 5-for-16; RHH: .174, 4-for-23).

25 JOSH WINCKOWSKI - RHP 9 G / 2 GS / 18.0 IP / 3.50 ERA / 1.67 WHIP

- Is scheduled to make his 1st career start vs. SF on Thursday...Faced the Giants twice in 2023 (2.2 IP, 5 H, ER, 3 SO).
- Tossed 3.0 scoreless innings on Saturday vs. CHC (3 H, SO).
- Was his 2nd consecutive start, after his first 7 appearances were in relief.
- Has held RHH to a .229 AVG (8-for-35, 12 SO), compared to .368 for LHH (14-for-38, 7 SO).
- Ranks in the 80th percentile or better in ground ball rate (84th).
