NEVER FORGET: Today, MLB will honor the memory of those lost on 9/11, as baseball came together to help our communities heal and rebuild after the terrorist attacks on this date in 2001.

Special caps, lineup cards and base jewels will be present and we will have a moment of silence during pregame ceremonies while flags will be flown at half-staff.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are hosting the Mariners for the first time since Aug. 25-26, 2018 and sixth time overall.

- ♦ Arizona is 6-3 in its last 9 games vs. Seattle, outscoring the Mariners, 61-44.
- ◆ Caleb Smith is the eighth different D-backs starter this season (fourth southpaw).
- Christian Walker's 18 RBI since Aug. 24 are tied for second most in the NI:
- □ NL RBI LEADERS SINCE AUG. 24: 25 Freddie Freeman/ATL; 18 - Christian Walker/ARI, Marcell Ozuna/ATL and Euginio Suarez/CIN; 17 - Adam Duvall/ATL.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the D-backs reinstated LHP **Caleb Smith** from the 45-day injured list.

◆ Following last night's game, the D-backs optioned RHP **Kevin Ginkel** to the Alternate Training Site.

THERE IS A LIGHT THAT NEVER GOES OUT: Following today's moves, Arizona boasts a league-high 3 Smiths on their roster (Caleb, Pavin and Riley).

- ♦ The D-backs had only 1 Smith don a uniform prior to 2010 Jason Smith in 2007 (2 G).
- At one point in 2020, the D-backs featured a pair of Kellys (Carson and Merrill) and Martes (Ketel and Starling).

ROTATION BUDDIES ONCE AGAIN: Caleb Smith, and tomorrow's starter, **Zac Gallen**, were both members of the 2019 Marlins' rotation before Arizona acquired the right-hander for INF Jazz Chisholm.

 Smith and Gallen started in back-to-back games for Miami 4 times last season (last: Smith on July 29 vs. D-backs and Gallen on July 30 vs. Twins).

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona is 14-6 in its last 20 games vs. AL opponents and is 19-10 (.655) since 2019.

♦ The D-backs' .655 interleague winning pct. is the second best in the Majors during that span behind the Rays (.656; 21-11) and ahead of the Braves and Mets (.647; 22-12).

TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

OUR NEWEST FANS: Each series, the D-backs will highlight a charitable cause or team initiative with cardboard cutouts in the Batter's Box:

- For this series, first responders and military members are featured behind home plate in honor of 9/11.
- ♦ Among those behind home plate is the late Phoenix Police Commander Greg Carnicle, a D-backs season ticket holder who was killed in the line of duty on March 29... Commander Carnicle is survived by his wife, Ann and children, Rachel, Veronica, CiCi and John.
- Also featured is Phoenix Police Chief Jeri Williams, Phoenix Police Officer Tanner Johnson (son of D-backs legend Randy Johnson), Phoenix Fire Chief Kara Kalkbrenner, military service members from the USO and first responders from American Medical Response

IN LEFT FIELD: At David Peralta's request, teddy bears have been placed in the bleachers to help remind him of his fans and his family.

♦ Smaller versions of these bears will be delivered to visit Phoenix Children's Hospital and Banner Cardon Children's Hospital courtesy of Peralta and the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation.

LOCASTRO A GO-GO: Tim Locastro has been successful in his first 25 career stolen base attempts, tied for the third-longest stolen base streak to start a career (since 1951 - when steals were tracked) [source: Sportradar].

- ♦ Had his Major League-record streak of 23 games allowing 3 or fewer earned runs to begin a career (all starts) end on Sept. 7 @ Giants (4 ER in 5.0 IP).
- ♦ Is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (6 ER in 26.0 IP) in 4 starts @ Chase Field this season.

VS. MARINERS: In his lone career start, on July 23, 2017 @ Mariners, did not figure in a 6-4 win...in 3.2 innings, allowed 4 runs (5 H, 1 BB, 2 K).
