JUNE 8, 1934	A.	Ken Griffey Jr. hits his 600th home run
JUNE 9, 2008	В.	Johnny Vander Meer pitches the first of two consecutive no-hitters
JUNE 10, 1944	C.	Joe Nuxhall becomes the youngest player to appear in a Major League game when he pitches for the Reds
JUNE 11, 1938	D.	The Reds play the franchise's first Interleague game
JUNE 13, 1997	E.	The Reds become the first team in Major League history to travel from one city to another by airplane
