



# ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS (14-20) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (16-19)

**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs are 8-4 in their last 12 home games, which began with a 7-game home winning streak from Aug. 5-18.

◆ **Starling Marte** has a 12-game home hitting streak, since Aug. 5, batting .391 (18-for-46)/.993 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4 RBI, 2 HBP and 5 walks.

• The franchise record for home hitting streaks is 21 games by Luis Gonzalez (1999) and Stephen Drew (2006).

**PITCHERS RACKING UP STRIKEOUTS:** D-backs pitchers' 317 strikeouts are third in the NL behind the Reds (346) and Brewers (327) while their 9.70 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ratio is fourth behind the Reds (11.43), Brewers (10.46) and Mets (9.94).

◆ D-backs pitchers' 89 strikeouts looking are second most in the NL to the Reds (95)...their 228 strikeouts swinging are fifth in the NL.

◆ D-backs pitchers' 342 0-2 counts are third in the NL behind the Dodgers (382) and Giants (355) and their 181 strikes thrown with a 0-2 count are second to the Dodgers (238).

**DOWN IN THE 'PEN:** D-backs relievers worked a season-high-tying 6.0 innings last night (also: Aug. 9 @ Padres), their 18th game of 6.0+ innings and 1 or fewer runs since 2017.

◆ **Kevin Ginkel** has held opponents scoreless 16 of 22 career home games (6 R-4 ER in 21.2 IP) with a 10.38 K/9.0 IP ratio (25 K in 21.2 IP).

◆ **Junior Guerra** has held opponents scoreless in 7 of 8 home games this season (2 ER in 8.1 IP) with .172 opponent average (5-for-29).

◆ **Archie Bradley** has held opponents scoreless in 3 of 4 home games this season and 19 of 24 home games (7 ER in 28.1 IP) with an 11.12 K/9.0 IP ratio (35 K in 28.1 IP) since June 26 last season.

**CRICHTON AT HOME, VS. LEFTIES:** Stefan Crichton's .204 opponent average at Chase Field is fourth best by a D-backs pitcher all-time (min. 25 G), behind David Hernandez (.175), Matt Mantei (.189) and Byung-Hyun Kim (.200).

◆ Has held opponents scoreless in 21 of 27 home games as a D-back (2.67 ERA, 9 ER in 30.1 IP).

◆ Has held lefties to a .164 average (9-for-55) the last 2 seasons...his 9 hits allowed are tied for sixth fewest while his .164 average is seventh lowest among NL relievers (min. 50 BF, 0 GS).

## RHP TAYLOR CLARKE ◆ #45 ◆ R/R ◆ 6-4/220 ◆ 27 (MAY 13, 1993)

**AT A GLANCE:** Is in his second season with the D-backs.

• Entered 2019 as the D-backs' No. 10 prospect by MLB.com and as having the Best Control by *Baseball America*.

• D-backs' third-round pick in the 2015 draft.

**LAST START:** Made emergency start on Aug. 24 vs. Rockies in place of Merrill Kelly (1 ER in 4.0 IP)...found out he was starting 40 minutes prior to first pitch.

• Kelly was scratched with right shoulder nerve impingement.

**VS. GIANTS:** Is 1-2 with a 9.00 ERA (11 ER in 11.0 IP) in 3 career starts.

• Recorded his first career win in his second ever start on May 25 @ Oracle Park (3 ER in 6.1 IP).

**CH-CH-CHANGE:** Opponents are hitting .056 (1-for-18) off his changeup this season after batting .186 in 2019.

**AS A STARTER:** Is 4-4 with a 5.66 ERA (43 ER in 68.1 IP) in 16 career starts.

**LIMITING LEFTIES:** Left-handers are 5-for-39 (.128) with no extra-base hits in his last 11 games dating back to Sept. 17, 2019.

**THE STATISTICAL HAT TRICK:** Is 1 of 2 pitchers since 1969 (when saves became official) to earn all 3 decisions in their first 3 career appearances (also: Sammy Stewart - win and loss in his only 2 games in 1978 and a save in his first game in 1979) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

**HECKUVA MLB DEBUT:** Made his Major League debut on April 20 @ Cubs, earning a 3.0-inning save (0 ER).

• Recorded a hit (single off Randy Rosario) to become the first pitcher in history to record a hit and a save in his debut [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

**KETEL DURING THE DAY:** Ketel Marte's .317 average for day games since 2018 is third in the Majors (min. 250 PA) to Anthony Rizzo (.332) and Lourdes Gurriel Jr. (.328) and ahead of Andrew Benintendi (.315) and Christian Yelich (.315).

**STARLING SHINING DURING THE DAY:** Starling Marte has hit safely in 8 of 9 day games at a .424 clip (14-for-33)/1.109 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI, 1 HBP and 2 walks.

**WALKER STREAKING:** Christian Walker has hit safely in 7 straight home games at a .385 clip (10-for-26)/1.189 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers and 10 RBI.

◆ Has set a career high with a RBI in 5 straight games (10 RBI total) [previous high was 4 from July 19-22, 2019].

◆ In the last week, since Aug. 24, his 10 RBI lead the Majors and his 3 home runs are tied for second.

◆ In his last 18 games, is hitting .348 (24-for-69) with 6 doubles, 4 homers and 13 RBI.

◆ In his last 16 games vs. righties, is hitting .377 (20-for-53) with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 1 HBP and 6 walks.

**BETTER LATE THAN NEVER:** The D-backs 63 runs from the seventh inning or later are third in the Majors behind the Dodgers (66) and Padres (66).

**DOUBLES:** The D-backs are tied for third in the Majors with 65 doubles, with the Red Sox and Astros, behind the Braves (70) and Rays (67).

### NEXT STARTER: LHP ALEX YOUNG (1-1, 4.70)

◆ In his last 5 starts vs. NL West, is 2-0 with a 3.60 ERA.

◆ Will make his third career start vs. Dodgers.

◆ In 3 starts this season, is 0-1 with a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP), .245 opponent average (13-for-53) and 14 strikeouts.
