HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona has won 6 of its last 9 games and is 10-6 in last 16...8-3 in the last 11 games @ Oracle Park.

◆ **Zac Gallen** could tie an MLB record today for most starts allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in his first 20 big league starts, currently held by Aaron Sele/Red Sox from June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.

• Set the NL record earlier this month (19), passing the 18-gamer by Steve Rogers/MON (July 18, 1973-April 11, 1974) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

• Is just the second pitcher since 1913 with 0 decisions and an ERA at 2.40 or below in his first 5 starts of a season, joining Cal Eldred/MIL (2.05 in 1998)

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: **David Peralta** passed **Tony Womack** (2,521) last night for ninth place in franchise history in at-bats...his next triple will tie Womack (37) for second place on the D-backs list.

◆ This week, Peralta passed **Gerardo Parra** for eighth place in hits and **Mark Reynolds** for eighth place in RBI.

LEAN INTO ONE: **Tim Lincecum** is also climbing the charts, as his next hit by pitch will be his 23rd with the D-backs, tying **David Peralta** and **Connor Jackson** for eighth on the franchise charts.

◆ Lincecum has been hit 22 times in 271 plate appearances while Peralta has 23 in 2,768 and Jackson had 23 in 2,026.

CONNECT FOUR: **Christian Walker** tied career highs with 4 hits and 2 doubles last night...his last 4-hit game was on April 20, 2019 @ Cubs.

NOTHING EXTRA HERE: With new extra-inning rules having taken effect in 2020, only 4 teams have yet to experience them: the D-backs, Cardinals, Yankees and Red Sox.

A WELCOME MATT: Pitching coach **Matt Herge** served as bullpen coach for the Giants from 2018-19.

◆ Matt's son, Tyler, committed this week as a pitcher to Azusa Pacific University, alma mater of Stephen Vogt.

MAKE SURE YOU STAY TUNED UNTIL THE END: The D-backs lead the Majors with 55 runs after the sixth inning.

STAY SLICK: **Nick Ahmed** is hitting .419 (18-for-43) with 4 doubles, 2 home runs and 14 RBI in his last 12 games.

NOW THAT WAS A GOOD DAY: **Kevin Cron** made his big league

TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

IN THE SEATS: Right behind the dugout, the Giants have provided visiting teams the opportunity to bring 4 "fans" to each game, so attending this weekend's games at Oracle Park are 4 legends - Hall of Famer **Randy Johnson** (who earned his 300th win with San Francisco on June 4, 2009); **Luis Gonzalez** (who hit .345 with 2 "splash hits" in this ballpark); **Mark Grace** (5 homers and 1 "splash hit"); and Buck O'Neil Award winner **Roland Hemond**. The fourth "racing legend" for the D-backs, **Matt Williams**, is already represented in the stands as a member of the Giants.

debut at Oracle Park on May 24, 2019 in 18-2 victory over the Giants, the most runs ever scored by a visiting team in San Francisco (second-most runs for the D-backs in Oracle Park is 12 in 2001).

◆ Cron's first hit (a double) and RBI came the next day off Sam Dyson with his family in attendance, including Triple-A Reno manager, Chris Cron, his father.

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Arizona is batting .345 (40-for-116) with RISP in its last 11 games and leads the NL with a .310 average (70-for-226) overall.

SAVING GRACE: **Matt Grace** made his D-backs debut on Thursday, becoming the 79th left-handed pitcher to appear in a game in franchise history...he replaced Andrew Chafin on the roster, who has appeared in more games than any other D-backs southpaw (337).

GOING BATTY: The D-backs are hitting .287 over their last 16 games after batting .194 in their first 11.

NL RECORD SET, 1 SHY OF MLB RECORD: Has set the NL record for starting pitchers by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 20 career games (all starts, no relief appearances) [source: Elias Sports Bureau]...is 1 shy of the MLB record 21 by Aaron Sele/Red Sox (June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994).

VS. GIANTS: First career start.

VS. NL WEST: In 8 career starts (team is 6-2), is 1-1 with a 2.44 ERA (12 ER in 44.1 IP), .226 opp. average and 52 strikeouts.

SINCE BECOMING A D-BACK: In 13 starts since his D-backs debut on Aug. 7, 2019 (team is 9-4), is 2-3 with a 2.69 ERA (22 ER in 73.2 IP), .221 opp. average and 89 strikeouts (10.87 K/9.0 IP).
• In 5 road starts as a D-back, is averaging 11.42 K/9.0 IP (33 K/26.0 IP).

LIMITED FREE PASSES: Has issued 3 walks in his last 4 starts.

RACKING UP K'S: His 11.13 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ratio (80 K/64.2 IP) since Aug. 19, 2019 is 11th among NL pitchers (min. 10 GS)...teammate Robbie Ray is third at 12.59 K/9.0 IP (83 K in 59.1 IP).

SINCE JUNE 20, 2019: His 2.70 ERA since last June 20 is eighth in the Majors (min. 50.0 IP), just behind Justin Verlander/HOU (2.60) and Aaron Civale/CLE (2.55).

WITH RUNNERS ON BASE: For his career, has held opponents to a .191 average (30-for-157) with 20 walks and 56 strikeouts.
• **RISP IN 2020:** Has held opponents to 2 hits in 21 at-bats (.095) with 2 RBI, 2 walks and 8 strikeouts.
