HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 9-6 in their last 15 games @ Oracle Park.

- ♦ Arizona starters have given up 2 earned runs or fewer in 10 of their last 13 games (3.38 ERA; 24 ER in 64.0 IP). ☐ D-backs starters have posted a 3.00 ERA (12 ER in 36.0 IP) and a .211 opponent average in their last 7 road games.
- ♦ Alex Young is 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (2 ER in 10.1 IP) and .097 WHIP 2 starts @ Oracle Park.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, the D-backs recalled INF Wyatt Mathisen from their Alternate Training Site...he has no Major League experience.

◆ Following last night's game, Arizona optioned RHP Artie Lewicki to their Alternate Training Site.

BACK TO WHERE IT ALL BEGAN: Today's starter, Alex Young, his Major League debut on June 27, 2019 @ Oracle Park (1 ER in 5.0 IP).

- ♦ Young was the fourth D-backs pitcher (first starter) to make his Major League debut in San Francisco and only one to come away with a victory.
- ♦ Since 1998, Young is 1 of 4 visiting starting pitchers to win their Major League debut in San Francisco (also: Chris O'Grady/MIA in 2017, Odrisamer Despaigne/SD in 2014 and Sean O'Sullivan/LAA in 2009).

DID YOU KNOW? IRON HORSE EDITION: Today marks the 25th anniversary of Cal Ripken Jr. setting the Major League record with his 2,131st consecutive game played.

- ♦ D-backs bullpen coach Mike Fetters was the only member of the coaching staff to play with Ripken on the Orioles (1999).
- ♦ Ripken was 2-for-9 (.222) with 1 double, 4 walks and 1 strikeout lifetime vs. Fetters.

SPLASH-DOWN STATS: Last night, Daulton Varsho became the first visiting player to hit his first Major League home run directly into McCovey Cove ("splash down" home run).

♦ Varsho's home run was the 51st "splash down" home run by an opponent and first by a D-back since Ender Inciarte on Sept. 9, 2014 (off Yusmeiro Petit).

FIRST-INNING FUN: The D-backs have scored in the first inning in back-to-back games for the first time this season...the last time they scored in the first inning in 3 games in a row was Aug. 16-18, 2019 vs. Giants.

TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

IN THE SEATS: The Giants have provided visiting teams the opportunity to bring 4 "fans" to each game, so attending this weekend's games at Oracle Park are 4 legends - Hall of Famer Randy Johnson (who earned his 300th win with San Francisco on June 4, 2009); Luis Gonzalez (who hit .345 with 2 "splash hits" in this ballpark); Mark Grace (5 homers and 1 "splash hit"); and Buck O'Neil Award winner Roland Hemond. The fourth "racing legend" for the Dbacks, Matt Williams, is already represented in the stands as a member of the Giants.

LOCAL STREAMING NOW AVAILABLE: For the remainder of the season, fans can not only hear live D-backs games on the radio, but also on their favorite devices, as Grea Schulte, Tom Candiotti and Mike Ferrin will now be streamed on the Arizona Sports app and ArizonaSports.com...previously, this online option was only available via dbacks.com.

IT'S STRIKEOUT SEASON: D-backs pitchers rank third in the NL with 368 strikeouts...only the Reds (407) and Brewers (393) have more.

LOCASTRO A GO-GO: Tim Locastro has been successful in his first 23 career stolen base attempts, the fifth-longest stolen base streak to start a career (since 1951 - when steals were tracked) [source: Sportradar].
