HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs being their 7-game road trip tonight @ Dodgers.

- ♦ Arizona starters have given up 2 runs or fewer in 6 of its last 8 games.
- ♦ Christian Walker is hitting .394 (13-for-33)/1.179 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 10 RBI in his last 9 games.

AND THEN THERE WERE 4: Arizona has 4 players remaining from its 2017 NLDS roster that played Los Angeles (Jake Lamb, David Peralta, Ketel Marte and Christian Walker)...Nick Ahmed did not play due to injury (fractured right hand).

SEPTEMBER SURGE?: The D-backs have won their last 5 September games (Sept. 24-29, 2019) and were 15-11 in the final month last season, the fifth-best NL September mark.

SHOWING UP LATE TO LA: Tonight marks the D-backs first visit to Dodger Stadium this season, the latest they have made their initial visit to Chavez Ravine since 2000 (June 12).

♦ Arizona did play 2 exhibition games @ Dodger Stadium on July 19-20.
