HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 home games, since Aug. 5.

- ◆ Zac Gallen is tied for the Major League record with 21 games allowing 3 or fewer earned runs to begin a career (all starts, not relief appearances) [also: Aaron Sele/Red Sox, June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994].
- In 8 home starts at Chase Field, is 2-1 with a 2.27 ERA, .187 opponent average and 56 strikeouts...team is 7-1.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP Joel Payamps and INF Andy Young from the Alternate Training Site and designated LHP Matt Grace for assignment...following last night's game, the D-backs optioned INF Kevin Cron to the Alternate Training Site.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: The D-backs scored a combined 6 runs in the eighth (2 R) and ninth innings (4 R) last night and lead the Majors with 63 runs from the seventh inning or later, ahead of the A's (60), Dodgers (59) and Orioles (58).

♦ From the seventh inning on, the D-backs are hitting .272 (97-for-256)/.356 OBP/.410 SLG with 21 doubles, 2 triples, 8 homers, 60 RBI and 42 walks.

1-RUN GAMES: The D-backs' 10 1-run games are tied for third in the NL (also: Braves and Cubs).

- ♦ The D-backs' 6 1-run wins are tied for second in the NL (also: Cubs, Rockies, Brewers) behind the Braves (7) and tied for fourth in the Majors (also: Cubs, Rockies, Brewers, A's) behind the Rays (8), Braves (7) and Blue Jays (7).
- ♦ 6 of the D-backs last 7 home games and 7 of the last 9 home games have been decided by 1 run.

TIMMY-LO'S PLUNKS AND SWIPES: Tim Locastro's next hit-bypitch will be his 23rd with the D-backs, tying David Peralta and Conor Jackson for eighth.

- ♦ Locastro has been hit 22 times in 273 plate appearances while Peralta has 23 in 2,790 and Jackson had 23 in 2,026.
- ♦ Has been successful in his first 23 career stolen base attempts, the fifth-longest stolen base streak to start a career (since 1951 - when steals were tracked) [source: Sportradarl:

OUR NEWEST FANS: Each series, the D-backs will highlight a charitable cause or team initiative with cardboard cutouts in the Batter's Box.

♦ Featured this series are many Arizona-based teachers, including past Most Valuable Teacher honorees as well as teachers from Valencia School, the school for refugees the organization helped renovate several years ago.

PERALTA CLIMBING THE CHARTS: David Peralta had 2 hits last night to bring his total to 739 hits, tying Justin Upton for seventh on the franchise list...his next triple will tie Tony Womack (37) for second place.

C-WALK AT THE DISH: Christian Walker, in his last 16 games, is hitting .355 (22-for-62) with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI, 1 HBP and 7 walks.

STARLING SHINING DURING THE DAY: Starling Marte has hit safely in 8 of 9 day games at a .424 clip (14-for-33)/1.109 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI, 1 HBP and 2 walks.

DEFENSE RULES: The D-backs lead the NL with a .990 fielding pct., ahead of the Cubs (.986), Reds (.985) and Rockies (.985), and are second in the Majors to the Twins (.993).

KETEL AT HOME: Ketel Marte's .338 home average since 2019 is fifth in the Majors [leader is Charlie Blackmon/COL (.390)], and his .322 home average since 2018 is tied for eighth in the Majors [leader is Charlie Blackmon/COL (.363)].

LOTS OF RUNS VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs' 2.189 runs all-time vs. Rockies are the second most by a team vs. a single opponent since 1998, behind the Yankees' 2,219 runs vs. Orioles and ahead of the Red Sox' 2,104 runs vs. Orioles, Dodgers' 2,102 runs vs. Rockies and A's' 2,101 runs vs. Rangers.

ON DECK - GIANTS: The D-backs host the Giants for their lone trip to Chase Field this season...the D-backs lost a 3-gamer in San Francisco last weekend (Aug. 21-23).

NEXT STARTER: RHP LUKE WEAVER (1-4, 7.77)

- ♦ In his last start, tossed 5.2 innings with 2 runs on 5 hits and 1 walk with 5 strikeouts.
