HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs, who have lost 8 straight road games, begin their 4-game series tonight @ Giants.

- ♦ Arizona starters have given up 2 earned runs or fewer in 9 of their last 11 games (3.00 ERA; 19 ER in 57.0 IP).
 - D-backs starters have posted a 2.17 ERA and a .184 opponent average in their last 5 road games.
- ◆ Christian Walker is hitting .333 (15-for-45)/1.039 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers and 12 RBI in his last 12 games.
 □ Has homered 4 times in his last 9 games after just once in his first 28
- ◆ Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 7 of his last 9 plate appearances vs. Tyler Anderson (3 doubles, 2 singles, 1 home run and 1 HBP).

BUMGARNER BACK IN THE BAY: Madison Bumgarner, who is scheduled to start tomorrow, spent 11 seasons with the Giants and went 119-92 with a 3.13 ERA.

- ♦ His start tomorrow is nearly 11 years after making his debut on Sept. 8, 2009 vs. Padres.
- ♦ Bumgarner ranks among San Francisco's (since 1958) all-time leaders in strikeouts (2nd, 1,794), ERA (3rd, 3.13), wins (3rd, 119), starts (3rd, 286) and innings (4th, 1846.0).
- ♦ In 140 starts @ Oracle Park, he is 60-40 with a 2.72 ERA (278 ER in 918.2 IP)...is 5-0 with a 2.22 ERA (18 ER in 73.0 IP) and a 0.78 WHIP in his last 11 starts @ Oracle Park.

CLARKE IS CLICKING ON ALL CYLINDERS: Taylor Clarke has gone 1-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER in 13.0 IP), .114 opponent average and 1.00 WHIP in his last 4 games (2 starts).

 Among all pitchers with 20.0 IP, Clarke ranks second this season with a .134 opponent average, trailing only Tejay Antone/CIN (.118):

DID YOU KNOW - SEPT. 4 EDITION: The last time the D-backs and Giants played on Sept. 4 was in 2012 @ Oracle Park...Arizona defeated San Francisco, 8-6, in 11 innings.

♦ Bruce Bochy utilized 10 relievers that day in the 4-hour, 19-minute game - which at the time was the most relievers used by Bochy while managing the Giants.

TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

IN THE SEATS: The Giants have provided visiting teams the opportunity to bring 4 "fans" to each game, so attending this weekend's games at Oracle Park are 4 legends - Hall of Famer Randy Johnson (who earned his 300th win with San Francisco on June 4, 2009); Luis Gonzalez (who hit .345 with 2 "splash hits" in this ballpark); Mark Grace (5 homers and 1 "splash hit"); and Buck O'Neil Award winner Roland Hemond. The fourth "racing legend" for the D-backs, Matt Williams, is already represented in the stands as a member of the Giants.

LOCAL STREAMING NOW AVAILABLE: For the remainder of the season, fans can not only hear live D-backs games on the radio, but also on their favorite devices, as Greg Schulte, Tom Candiotti and Mike Ferrin will now be streamed on the Arizona Sports app and ArizonaSports.com...previously, this online option was only available via dbacks.com.

IT'S STRIKEOUT SEASON: D-backs pitchers rank third in the NL with 353 strikeouts...only the Reds (381) and Brewers (369) have more.

LOCASTRO A GO-GO: Tim Locastro has been successful in his first 23 career stolen base attempts, the fifth-longest stolen base streak to start a career (since 1951 - when steals were tracked) [source: Sportradar].

AT A GLANCE: Is in his second season with the D-backs.

- Entered 2019 as the D-backs' No. 10 prospect by MLB.com and as having the Best Control by *Baseball America*.
- D-backs' third-round pick in the 2015 draft.

LAST START: Held the Giants to 1 run on 1 hit and 1 walk with a career-high-tying 7 strikeouts over 5.0 frames in a 4-1 loss on Aug. 30.

VS. GIANTS: Is 1-2 with a 6.75 ERA (12 ER in 16.0 IP) in 4 career starts...recorded his first career win in his second ever start on May 25, 2019 @ Oracle Park (3 ER in 6.1 IP).

EMERGENCY START: Made emergency start on Aug. 24 vs. Rockies (1 ER in 4.0 IP) in place of Merrill Kelly...found out he was starting 40 minutes prior to first pitch...Kelly was scratched with right shoulder nerve impingement.

THE 4-SEAMER: Against his 4-seamer, opponents are hitting .088, the sixth-lowest average among pitchers (min. 100 pitches) behind Josh Hader (.000), Jake Diekman (.050), Aaron Nola (.067), Walker Buehler (.083) and Drew Pomeranz (.083).

CH-CH-CHANGE: Opponents are hitting .095 (2-for-21) off his changeup this season after batting .186 (8-for-43) in 2019.

AS A STARTER: In his last 7 starts, including 4 allowing 1 run or fewer, is 2-1 with a 3.23 ERA (11 ER in 30.2 IP), .205 opponent average, 1.01 WHIP, 8 walks and 32 strikeouts (9.39 K/9.0 IP).

• Is 4-4 with a 5.40 ERA (44 ER in 73.1 IP) in 17 career starts.
