LEADING OFF: Today, the Angels play the sixth (1-4) and final game on a homestand and the last (0-2) of three games in a series against the New York Yankees...Angels went 1-2 vs. Miami to open the homestand...Halos were 8-2 on last road trip against the Padres (1-2), Dodgers (3-0) and Athletics (4-0).

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: Today the Angels reinstated RHP Robert Stephenson from the injured list and selected the contract of INF Scott Kingery...Both players are looking to make their Angels debuts...Stephenson's first appearance will be his first Major League outing since Sept. 30, 2023 with Tampa Bay, and since signing a three-year contract with the Angels on Jan. 23, 2024...Kingery's first outing will mark his first MLB game since June 8, 2022 with Philadelphia... In corresponding moves, INF Tim Anderson and C Chuckie Robinson were designated for assignment and LHP Jake Eder was optioned to Triple-A Salt Lake following yesterday's game.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Taylor Ward was named A.L. Player of the Week for May 19-25...It is his second time receiving the honors (April 24-30, 2022)...Last week, he hit .407 (11/27) with four doubles, one triple, three HR, 12 RBI and a 1.382 OPS...He led the league in XBH (8), total bases (26), RBI, and OPS and established a franchise record with an XBH in 10 consecutive games.

WINS AND LOSSES: The Angels have lost four straight games following a season-high eight game win streak, which was snapped Saturday night vs. Miami...It was the Halos longest win streak since a 10-game streak from Sept. 4-13, 2014.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: Today is the Angels 26th consecutive game in the state of California...It is the longest streak in Halos history (previous: 23-game streaks in 2011 and 2021). (credit: ELIAS)...The Angels upcoming game on Friday night at Cleveland will be their first outside California since April 30 at Seattle.

POWER SURGE: Since May 6, Angels lead MLB with 35 HR, rank third with 316 total bases and are fourth with 107 runs scored.

HOMERIN' HALOS: Angels rank third in the Majors (second in A.L.) with 79 home runs on the year...Saturday night, LAA had 13-game streak with a homer snapped, which was the longest HR streak for the Halos since a franchise record 19-game streak from June 26 - July 21, 2023...Angels also had franchise record seven-game streak with 2+ HR snapped.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Today is the third (0-2) of seven games this season between the Angels and Yankees...Tonight, Halos are looking to avoid being swept by the Yankees for the first time since May 31 - June 2, 2022 at Yankee Stadium; Halos have not been swept by NYY at Angel Stadium since April 27-29, 2018...The teams will meet again in the Bronx for four games from June 16-19...Last year, the teams split the six-game season series 3-3, with each club winning two of three games on the road...Since 2021, the Angels are 8-6 against New York (A.L.) at Angel Stadium.

BIG POPPA: Zach Neto has hit safely in 26 of his last 31 games and is batting .304 (38/125) in that span with nine doubles, eight home runs, 17 RBI and eight stolen bases...He had a career-high seven game streak with a run scored snapped Friday night...Neto had a career-high 13 game hit streak from April 24 - May 8.

FOUR SCORE: This season, the Angels are 22-7 when scoring 4+ runs in a game, but are 3-22 when scoring three-or-fewer.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Zach Neto has hit four leadoff home runs this month (May 2 vs. DET, May 13 at SD, May 18 at LAD and last night vs. NYY)...He is the second player in Angels history with 4+ leadoff HR in a calendar month, along with Taylor Ward (4 HR - Sept. 2024)...The four leadoff homers this month also match the MLB record for May, joining Houston's Jose Altuve (May 2022).

A-WARD SEASON: Taylor Ward ranks third in the American League (T6th in MLB) with 15 home runs this season...Ward's 27 RBI in May are tied for second-most for the month of May in franchise history (Mo Vaughn - 28 RBI in May 1999)... Sunday, his career-high and Angels franchise record streak of 10 consecutive games with an extra-base hit was snapped... He also snapped a career-best streak of eight straight games with an RBI.

1K AT THE BIG A: Taylor Ward's next at-bat at Angel Stadium will be the 1,000th of his career at The Big A...He'll be the 43rd player all-time to take 1,000 AB at the ballpark and the third active player (Mike Trout & Shohei Ohtani).

HEATING UP: Nolan Schanuel is batting .347 (26/75) over his last 22 games...His average ranks sixth in the A.L. in that span (since May 3).

ON THE MOUND TODAY: LHP Yusei Kikuchi makes his 12th start of the season today and fifth at home...He has pitched to a 2.38 ERA (41.2 IP - 11 ER) over his last eight starts and has allowed two-or-fewer runs in seven of those eight outings... Kikuchi has posted a 1.23 ERA (22 IP - 3 ER) at Angel Stadium this year, compared with a 4.30 ERA (37.2 IP - 18 ER) on the road... He earned his first win of the season in his last start on Friday vs. Miami after tossing 5.2 shutout innings.

THE CLOSER: Kenley Jansen has converted all 11 save chances this year...Last Tuesday night, he became the fourth pitcher in MLB history to record 10+ saves in at least 14 consecutive seasons, joining Mariano Rivera (15 seasons; 1997-2011), John Franco (15 seasons; 1985-99) and Lee Smith (14 seasons; 1982-95).

BACKSTOP BLASTS: Logan O'Hoppe has 14 homers on the season are fourth-most in the A.L. and tied for eighth-most in MLB...His 12 HR as a catcher are second in MLB (Cal Raleigh - 18 HR).

WE BRING THE BROOM!: The Angels swept back-to-back series to conclude their last road trip, taking three straight against Dodgers at Dodger Stadium and sweeping the A's in a four-game series at Sutter Health Park...Marked first time LAA swept consecutive series since Sept. 27 - Oct. 2, 2022 vs. OAK/TEX and first time doing so on the road since April 9-14, 2018 at TEX/KC.

GUARDIANS ON DECK: Following the current series against the Yankees and an off day tomorrow, the Angels will open their next road trip with a three-game series against the Guardians at Progressive Field...Halos lead the season series 2-1 after LAA took two of three contests from April 4-6 in the opening three home games of the season...All-time series between Angels and Cleveland is tied 340-340.

GETTING BACK ON THE ROAD: The Angels will enter Friday's game in Cleveland with a seven-game road win streak, dating back to May 16 at LAD...The streak is the longest for the Halos since a franchise-record-tying 11-game road win streak from March 30 - April 24, 2018.

Has a 3.38 ERA (69.1 IP - 26 ER) with 72 strikeouts in 15 career games (13 starts) against NYY.

- TODAY'S GAME:** Making 12th start of the season and fifth at home...In seventh Major League season and first with Angels...Made seventh Opening Day roster.
- LAST TIME OUT:** Earned first win of the season in last time out on May 23 vs. Marlins; Pitched 5.2 scoreless innings on seven hits and four walks with four strikeouts.
- VS. YANKEES:** Making 16th career appearance against Yankees (14th start); Is 5-4 with a 3.38 ERA (69.1 IP - 26 ER) with 72 strikeouts against NYY in his career.
- AT ANGEL STADIUM:** Making fifth career home start as an Angel; Is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA (22.0 IP - 3 ER) in four starts at home this season...Made eight starts at The Big A in his career as a visitor and went 2-2 with a 8.12 ERA (37.2 IP - 34 ER) and 38 strikeouts.
- SIX STRONG:** Pitched at least six innings in first four starts this season, and in nine straight starts dating back to Aug. 31, 2024; Streak snapped with 5.1 innings pitched in no-decision vs. SF on Apr. 20...Has pitched a quality start in five of 11 outings in 2025.
- OPENING DAY 2025:** Made first career MLB Opening Day start on Mar. 27 at Chicago (A.L.)...Was named the Opening Day starter three times for the Seibu Lions in Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB) in Japan (2018, 2017, 2016)...Second Japanese-born pitcher to make an Opening Day start for the Angels (Shohei Ohtani - 2022 & 2023); Dodgers are the only other club to have had multiple Japanese-born pitchers as their Opening Day starter.
- HALOS FROM JAPAN:** Is the sixth Angel to be born in Japan, following Shigetoshi Hasegawa (1997-2001), Hideki Matsui (2010), Hisanori Takahashi (2011-2012), Shohei Ohtani (2018-2023) and Junichi Tazawa (2018).
- CAREER NOTES:** Selected by Seibu Lions in first round of 2009 Nippon Professional Baseball Draft...Signed as an international free agent by Seattle Mariners on Jan. 2, 2019...Signed by Toronto Blue Jays to three-year contract on Mar. 14, 2022...Named a 2021 A.L. All-Star...Traded by Blue Jays to Houston Astros for RHP Jake Bloss, OF Joey Loperfido and INF Will Wagner on July 29, 2024...Signed by Angels to three-year contract on Nov. 27, 2024...Opened a brand new baseball facility in Hanamaki, Iwate, Japan called KOH (King of the Hill) in November 2024.
