# San Francisco Giants (44-46) at Cleveland Guardians (55-32)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants wrap their two-city, six-game road trip this afternoon here in Cleveland...the Giants are seeking a win today to take the series from Cleveland and secure a winning road trip...they've gone 3-2 thus far (2-1 in Atlanta and 1-1 in Cleveland).

- ▶ SF is 8-4 in their last 12 games dating to June 24, taking series from the Cubs (3-1), Dodgers (2-1) and Braves (2-1) before splitting the first two games here.
- ▶ Taking a series at Progressive Field will be tough as the Guardians have lost only one home series all season and that was their second home series of the year vs. the Yankees (April 13-14).
- ▶ The road has been a tough place for the Giants in 2024 as they are 19-27 (.413) outside of Oracle Park...SF is trying to win back-to-back road series for the first time since taking consecutive series in Pittsburgh and New York in late May.

**ARE WE GONNA STOP AT BUC-EES?:** Major League Baseball will reveal the rest of the All-Star squads for this year's Midsummer Classic in Texas tonight on ESPN's All-Star Selection show beginning at 5:30 p.m. ET.

**ON THE CUYAHOGA RIVER:** The Giants are visiting Cleveland for the first time since 2022 and are only playing just their third series in this ballpark since Interleague play expanded.

- ▶ SF has won both of its previous series at Jacobs/Progressive Field, going 2-1 here in 2008 and sweeping a three-game set here in April of 2022.
- ▶ Since losing their first-ever regular season series to the Cleveland franchise in 2005, the Giants have won each of the other six series the two teams have played since 2008... SF is 16-4 in that time.

**I'LL BE THERE FOR YOU:** The Giants bullpen covered 4.2 more innings yesterday after starter **LHP Kyle Harrison** lasted 3.1 frames in his first start back off the IL.

- ▶ The Giants' 376.1 bullpen innings this year are most in the Majors, now nine full innings more than the second-place Brewers (367.1ip).
- ▶ **RHP Tyler Rogers** lead the Majors in appearances (46) followed by teammate **RHP Ryan Walker's** 44 appearances, tied for second-most in MLB...**LHP Erik Miller** has made 41 appearances in his rookie campaign (tied for 14th-most in the Majors).

**DID WE LOSE THE SUNGLASSES?:** With yesterday's loss SF has lost six of their last seven day games dating to June 19.

- ▶ SF opened the year 15-7 in their first 22 day games but have since gone 6-11 in their last 17 day contests.
- ▶ The Giants own a .738 OPS in day games, ninth-best in MLB and fifth-best in the NL...on the flip side, SF has a .678 OPS in night games (22nd of 30 clubs).

**BIG MIKE: OF Michael Conforto** is slashing .323/.421/.677 over his last 13 games dating to June 22 with eight of his 10 hits in the span going for extra bases (six doubles, one triple, one homer).

- ▶ Conforto drove in another run in a losing effort yesterday...the Giants are now 14-9 in games he drives in a run this year and 44-16 in games where he's done so since 2023.

**THE BIRD MAN: RHP Hayden Birdsong** opened this road trip by earning his first MLB win and will look to close it on a high note today here in Cleveland.

- ▶ SF's #4 prospect (#98 in MLB.com's top-100) worked 5.0 innings of two-run ball in Atlanta Tuesday night and earned in the win in the Giants 5-3 win...both of the runs he allowed came on solo homers.
- ▶ Today's outing will be his third MLB start overall after debuting at home against the Cubs back on June 26.

**CAN HE REACH...THE ASG?: OF Heliot Ramos** went 1-for-5 yesterday but is still slashing .300/.372/.522 with 10 doubles, 12 homers, 40 RBI, 26 runs scored and an .894 OPS in 53 games since being recalled on May 8.

- ▶ His 12 homers are tied for the team lead with **IF Matt Chapman** while his 40 RBI are second-most behind Chapman's 42...his 2.3 fWAR is second on the team (Chapman, 2.4).
- ▶ Ramos' 23 multi-hit games since his recall on May 8 tied for second-most in MLB (SD's Luis Arraez has 24).
- ▶ His 40 RBI since May 8 are tied for most in the NL and tied for fourth-most in MLB in that time.

**PUBLIC CELEBRATION OF LIFE FOR WILLIE MAYS:** The San Francisco Giants and the family of **Willie Mays** will remember the tremendous talent, keen intellect, remarkable showmanship and boundless joy of the Giants Legend and Hall of Famer who passed away peacefully on June 18 at the age of 93...the public celebration of life is open to all fans and friends of Willie Mays - the "Say Hey Kid."

- ▶ The event will take place tomorrow, July 8 at Oracle Park beginning at 4 p.m...gates are scheduled to open at 3 p.m... for fans that wish to attend they must enter the ballpark through the Willie Mays Plaza gates on 3rd & King St.

**HOMEWARD BOUND:** Following this afternoon's game the Giants will fly back to SF and have an off day tomorrow before playing their final six games before the break against the Blue Jays (Tuesday-Thursday) and Twins (Friday-Sunday).

# HAYDEN BIRDSONG RHP #60

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Will make his third Major League start today after having his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26...Birdsong has spent parts of three seasons in the Giants system after being selected in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Illinois University (Charleston, IL).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his first career win on Tuesday at Atlanta after throwing 5.0 innings and holding Braves batters to two runs (both HRs) on four hits...Birdsong struck out five batters in the outing and walked two...three of the five runs Birdsong has allowed at the Major League level (9.2ip) have come via homers, each of those being solo shots.

**WITH THE SQUIRRELS:** Birdsong entered the season ranked as the Giants #6 prospect according to *Baseball America*...he began the year at Double-A Richmond and posted a 4-2 record with a 2.05 ERA (11er, 48.1ip) with 61 strikeouts in 11 starts for Double-A Richmond before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on June 11.

**WITH THE RIVER CATS:** Made two starts for Sacramento after the promotion and posted a 5.00 ERA (5er, 9.0) with 14 strikeouts...his last Triple-A start came on June 21 vs. Round Rock when he threw 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits with seven strikeouts.

**THE FUTURE IS NOW:** With the prospect graduation of **LHP Kyle Harrison**, Birdsong is currently the Giants' second-ranked pitching prospect, No. 4 overall, according to *MLB.com*...he also enters today's start as #98 on *MLB.com*'s Top-100 prospects...Birdsong was the last of six consecutive pitchers the Giants selected during the 2022 draft, which is a group that included **LHPs Reggie Crawford** and **Carson Whisenhunt**.

**EARLY ARRIVAL:** Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining **OF Wade Meckler** (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just three players from the first round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels and OF Jordan Beck with Colorado)...at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.

**LIKE, REAL EARLY:** According to Grant Brisbee of *The Athletic* Birdsong's 169.2 minor league innings were the fewest thrown by a Giant before their Major League debut since **RHP Tim Lincecum** debuted in 2007 with only 62.2 minor league innings under his belt
