# TAMPA BAY RAYS (43-42) at KANSAS CITY ROYALS (47-40)

Day Record16-18	nine of 12, 10 of 14, and 12 of their last 19 gamesfollowing the road trip, the Rays will conclude their pre-All-Star break schedule by hosting two of the AL's top three teams in the Yankees and Guardians from July 9-14according to Elias, they have the hardest remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning pct. of .535, with the next closest being Colorado (.515).

Braving a two-hour, 32-minuite rain delay last night, Tampa Bay earned the win to move above .500 for the first time since entering play on May 21 (25-24).

All nine Rays starters reached base safely, the ninth time Tampa Bay has accomplished the feat this season (last: June 24 vs. SEA), going 5-4.

The Rays have won four straight series openers, their longest such streak since claiming nine straight from July 25-Aug. 22, 2023.

Tampa Bay pitching has allowed one run or fewer in back-to-back games for the first time since Sept. 6-7, 2023...the Rays last allowed one run or fewer in three straight games from June 5-7, 2023 (also 3G).

The Rays have won back-to-back games by 4+ runs for the third time this season (May 6-7 & March 29-30)...they last did so in three straight games during a franchise-best nine-game run to open the 2023 season.

In four games against Kansas City this season, Tampa Bay is batting .158 (6-for-38) with runners in scoring position, including 1-for-10 (.100) last night.

Rays pitching has allowed 1+ HR in 10 straight road games, their longest streak since Aug. 23-Sept. 13, 2019...they last allowed 1+ HR in 11 straight road games from July 5-Aug. 1, 2017 (13G).

Tampa Bay did not issue a walk in last night's win, snapping a 22-game streak with 1+ BB...they Rays walked 1+ batter in a season-high 23 straight to open the season.

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Earlier today, Tampa Bay acquired **INF Gregory Barrios** from Milwaukee in exchange for **RHP Aaron Civale**...Barrios will report to Class-A Bowling Green...in a corresponding move, the Rays recalled **RHP Justin Sterner** from Triple-A Durham.

START YOUR ENGINES—Since posting a 10.13 ERA (16.0IP, 18ER) over four games from June 14-18, the Rays rotation has permitted 2 ER or fewer in eight straight and 11 of the last 12 games, posting a 2.38 ERA (64.1IP, 17ER) in that span, second lowest in the majors behind the Royals (2.29)...the eight-game streak is their longest since June 3-9, 2023 (8G)... their last longer streak was a 14-game run from Aug. 13-26, 2022.

RANDY'S RUN—Randy Arozarena has reached base safely in 15 straight games since June 14, batting .308/.422/.538 (16-for-52) with 3 2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI, 7 BB, 3 SB and 4 HBP...it marks his longest on-base streak since a career-high 20-game run from April 17–May 9, 2023...the 15-game run is the second-longest active streak in the AL behind BOS Connor Wong (17G) and tied for the fourth-longest active stretch in the majors.

Arozarena is one of three Rays this season to have a 15+ game on-base streak, joining Yandy Díaz (29G, May 26–June 28) and Isaac Paredes (18G, April 28–May 19).

**SENSATIONAL SIRI**—**Jose Siri** is batting slashing .295/.371/.623 (18-for-61) with five doubles, five home runs, 8 RBI, eight walks and 15 runs across 18 games since June 12... Siri was recently named the AL Defensive Player of the Month for June by Sports Info Solutions...per SIS, his 6 Defensive Runs Saved during the month led all MLB center fielders.

RED-HOT RAYS—Richie Palacios is batting .417 (10-for-24) with two doubles, 4 RBI, three walks and three steals over his last seven games...he has four multi-hit performances during that timeframe after tallying four in his previous 31 games.

Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 13 straight games, slashing .244/.370/.533 (11-for-45) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, 7 RBI and seven walks.

Brandon Lowe has homered in back-to-back games for the second time this season (also June 16-18)...he has 6 HR and 16 RBI in 18 games since June 4.

Colin Poche has made 12 straight scoreless appearances (11.2IP) since returning from the injured list on June 8...he has posted a .081 (3-for-37) opp. average and a 0.51 WHIP during that time...it is tied for the longest scoreless appearance streak of his career (also Aug. 30-Sept. 23, 2023).

RUNNING WILD—Tampa Bay was successful on all three stolen base attempts last night (Palacios, Siri, Walls)...entering yesterday's game, Kansas City had allowed the fewest stolen bases in MLB (31SB), with the next closest being Arizona (39SB)...it marked the first time the Royals allowed 3+SB in a game since Sept. 23, 2023 at Houston (also 3SB).

The Rays have collected an AL-best 84 SB, ranking fifth in MLB behind the Reds (123SB), Brewers (120SB), Nationals (111SB) and Phillies (85SB).

**ROAD TRIPPIN'**—The Rays are 13-7 over their last 20 road games after a 7-10 start...their .650 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) is tied with the Red Sox (also 13-7) for the best in the majors...the Rays have played 37 road games, tied with the Mets for the fewest in MLB.

Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in a career-high 20 straight road games since May 15, batting .306/.368/.459 (26-for-85) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 14 RBI, 9 BB and 10 SO...his current 20-game road on-base streak is tied with BAL Gunnar Henderson for the fourth-longest active run in the majors.

Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 23 of 24 road games since April 28, batting .322/.396/.489 (29-for-90) with 6 2B, 3 HR, 13 RBI and 10 BB during that stretch.

RETURN OF THE HOMER-The Rays have homered in 12 of their last 15 games since

June 15...their 24 HR during that stretch are third in the AL behind the Orioles (31HR) and Twins (25HR)...from June 1-15, Tampa Bay hit 8 HR (13G), fifth fewest in the majors.

During the 15-game stretch since June 15, Tampa Bay has five games with 3 HR...the Rays had two 3+ HR games in 70 contests to open the season (April 14 vs. SF & May 30 vs. OAK), tied with Miami for the fewest in the majors (thru June 14).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays own the majors' best record in one-run games (16-7/696) and games decided by two runs or fewer (29-12/707)...since April 29, they are 20-6 in such contests and 10-20 in games with a margin of 3+ runs...this includes a 12-4 record in one-run games over that timeframe...seven of their last 11 wins have come by two runs or fewer.

The Rays 22 comeback wins are tied for fourth most in MLB behind the Brewers (26) and Guardians/Mets (both 23)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in six of 11 and 12 of its last 18 victories.

KANSAS CITY CLASH—The Rays and Royals continue their six-game season series tonight at Kauffman Stadium...Kansas City took two of three from Tampa Bay during their May 24-26 trip to St. Petersburg...Yandy Díaz is batting .395 (15-for-38) with 4 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 3 BB, 8 R and 2 SO in 11 games vs. KC since July 24, 2022...in 11 career games at Kauffman Stadium, Randy Arozarena is batting .326 (14-for-43) with 2 2B, 1 3B and 4 RBI.

TONIGHT'S START—Pepiot will take the mound for his 15th start of the at Miami...has recorded 3.12 ERA (8.2IP, 3ER) in his last two starts... the Rays have won four of his five road starts...his 28.7 pct. strikeout rate ranks fifth in the AL/10th in the majors...was on the 15-day IL from May 6-22 (lower left leg contusion) after being struck by a 107.5 mph comebacker on May 5 vs. NYM.

LAST TIME OUT—Pepiot yielded only one hit, but took a no-decision in the Rays 5-2 loss to the Mariners on June 26 (ND, 5.1IP, H, ER, 2BB, 8SO)... did not allow a hit with 4 SO the first time through the lineup...departed after walking J.P. Crawford with one out in the 6th, who came around to score against the Rays bullpen...held Mariners hitters to a 1-for-17 (.059) clip...marked his second career start working 5.0+ IP while allowing one hit or fewer, joining Sept. 7, 2023 at MIA

**NEW FACES**—He will be making his first career appearance against the Royals, marking the 19th different club he has pitched against in his career... he has recorded a 3.10 ERA (20.1IP, 7ER) and .213 (16-or-75) opp. AVG in four career outings (2GS) against AL Central teams...this includes a 1.69 ERA (16.0IP, 3ER) in three games (1GS) since making his 2023 debut last August.

JUNE RECAP—In five June starts, Pepiot posted a 5.33 ERA (25.1IP, 15ER) and 1.34 WHIP while allowing a .253/.321/.485 (25-for-99) opponent slash line and .353 (6-for-17) average with RISP...the table below shows how those numbers compare to his performances in April and May:

FINISH HIM—Pepiot is holding opponents to a .126 (19-for-151) average in two-strike counts, fourth lowest in the AL (min. 150AN) behind NYY Luis Gil (.094), CWS Garrett Crochet (.111) and HOU Hunter Brown (.121)...this includes a 1-for-20 (.050) clip over his last two outings and .094 (6-for-64) in his last six in his last six.

**THAT'S RIGHT**—In his last start against Seattle, Pepiot held Mariners right-handed batters hitless (0-for-10) with 4 SO...RHH had slashed .310/.356/.524 (13-for-42) with 3 HR against him across his previous four outings...on the season, he ranks among AL leaders vs. RHH (min. 125BF) in opp. on-base pct. (5th, .243), opp. average (6th, .195) and opp. OPS (9th, .574).

WALK IT OUT—Pepiot has issued multiple walks in three straight outings, his longest streak since a career-high four-game run from Aug. 10–Sept. 4, 2022...only Taj Bradley (4GS, June 13–pres.) has a longer streak among Rays starters this season...limiting traffic on the basepaths has keyed the Rays success in Pepiot's starts—he has pitched to a 0.91 WHIP in Rays wins (7GS) compared to a 1.25 WHIP in losses (7GS).

THINK FAST—Pepiot has held opponents to a 15-for-126 (.119) clip on his four-seam fastball, recording 50 of his 83 strikeouts (60.2%) on the pitch... the .119 average is the lowest mark on any individual pitch in the majors (min. 90AB ending with pitch), outpacing STL Sonny Gray's sweeper (.133) and CLE Tanner Bibee's slider (.133)...opponents are 2-for-23 (.087) against Pepiot's four-seamer across his last three starts (0-for-11 in last 2GS).

He has produced a 34.7 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the highest mark on any MLB starter's fastball (min. 100 swings, starts only), ahead of PIT Paul Skenes four-seamer (32.5%).

Pepiot has struggled with his changeup in recent outings—opponents are 12-for-29 (.462) against the pitch in his five June starts compared to 13-for-73 (.178) vs. his other four pitches.

WHIFF YOU PLEASE—Pepiot's 30.3 pct. whiff rate ranks fifth in the AL behind DET Jack Flaherty (33.7%), CWS Garrett Crochet (33.3%), KC Cole Ragans (32.1%) and DET Tarik Skubal (32.0%) and ninth in the majors...he had a 32.7 pct. whiff rate prior to his May 6-22 IL stint (7GS) compared to 28.9 pct. since his return (6GS).

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.60 ERA (39.1IP, 7ER) and 0.81 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to a 7.79 ERA (32.1IP, 28ER) and 1.42 WHIP in all other frames...Pepiot has not allowed a run in the 2nd inning, limiting opponents to 3-for-43 (.070) with 16 SO.
