BIRD WATCHING: The Cardinals continue their penultimate homestand of the season today (1-2 vs. BAL, 1-0 vs. PIT) with the middle game of a three-game divisional series against the Pittsburgh Pirates...the Cardinals leveled their homestand mark at 2-2 with a 4-1 win last night as Quinn Mathews recorded his 1st career MLB win in his 1st career outing at Busch Stadium...the Cardinals have games both today and tomorrow afternoon vs. the Pirates before heading out on a three-city trip (at LAD-3, at COL-3, at SF-3) that begins on Tuesday at Chavez Ravine against the defending World Series Champion Los Angeles Dodgers...including today's game, the Cardinals have 26 regular season games remaining with 11 at home & 15 on the road.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 16.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee; 3.0 games ahead of 4th place Pittsburgh and 4.5 games out of the final National League Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 4-6 in their last 10 games, 10-10 in last 20 and 15-15 in last 30...they are 35-38 vs. teams that are currently .500 or better and 33-30 vs. the sub .500 teams.

MAUTZ RECALLED/FERGUSON DFA'd: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals designated LHP **Caleb Ferguson** for assignment and recalled rookie LHP **Brycen Mautz** (#52) from Memphis (AAA)...Mautz, 25, made his MLB debut on May 25 in a start at MIL (3.0 IP)...the Cardinals 2025 MiLB Pitcher of the Year was 1-6, 3.78 ERA in 31 games/16 starts for Memphis, striking out 89 in 85.2 IP...since July 18, Matuz's last 15 appearances have all been in relief with his last outing (0.2 IP) coming on August 25 at Charlotte.

CAPTAIN CROOKS: With a two-run HR in his 1st career plate appearance against the Pittsburgh Pirates last night, catcher **Jimmy Crooks** became the 1st Cardinal to homer in his initial plate appearance against the Buccos since **Albert Pujols** did so in 2001 off Todd Ritchie (Elias)...Crooks, who backstopped Quinn Mathews 1st career MLB win, presented Quinn with the game ball following last night's win...Pujols would go on to hit 57 of his 703 career HR's against the Pirates, including 35 at PNC Park - his most amongst the ballparks he never called home.

LEAHY & LEGENDS: The Cardinals send **Kyle Leahy** to the mound today to make his 26th start of the season - his first year as a full-time starter... Kyle has allowed two-or-fewer runs in a career-high 11 straight starts since June 23 vs. ARI, tied for the 2nd-longest such streak by a Cardinals hurler since at least 1900, behind only **Adam Wainwright** (12 in 2009) and tied with **Bob Gibson** (11 in 1968)...Leahy has surrendered just 8 total runs in those 11 starts for a 1.28 ERA (56.1 IP).

POWER PLAY: The Cardinals homered for an 11th consecutive game last night, their longest long ball streak since a 12-gamer from August 23-Sept. 4, 2022...the Cardinals 142 HR's this season are just six shy of their 148 round-trippers in 2025.

CLOSE COMPANY: Teammates **Alec Burleson** and **Jordan Walker** are keeping close company in the MLB RBI chase with Burly checking in with 99 and Walker with 97 - both career highs, and ranking 2-3 in the majors behind the Reds **Sal Stewart** (102)...Burleson and Walker each have collected 149 hits, while Alec has an MLB leading 33 doubles and Walker (27 HR & 18 SB) is two stolen bases shy of becoming the Cardinals 1st 20/20 player since **Tommy Pham** in 2017 (23 HR/25 SB).

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Justin Bruihl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Asst. to President of Baseball Ops. **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made MLB debuts vs. Pittsburgh.

Caleb Ferguson pitched in 45 games for the Pirates in 2025 before traded to Seattle for RHP Jeter Martinez (July 30, 2025).

Peter Strzelecki pitched in 16 games (1 start) for Indianapolis (AAA-Pirates) in 2025.

Nathan Church (2018) & **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA.

Nick Yorke made his MLB debut at St.x Louis on Sept. 16, 2024.

Luke Weaver was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Hunter Dobbins and **Mason Montgomery** were teammates at Texas Tech from 2019-20.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Bill Sherdel** made his MLB debut with St. Louis on April 22, 1918 vs. Pittsburgh.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

Evan Sisk was selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and pitched in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-21 before St. Louis traded him along with **John Gant** to Minnesota in exchange for **J.A. Happ** and cash considerations on July 30, 2021.

NL RANKINGS: Swords (29, 5th), Winning percentage (.714, T-9th)

TODAY'S START:

- The 29-year old makes his 26th start of the season (27th career) and 124th career appearance. Leahy's first 97 Major League career appearances all came in relief (2023-25).
- Has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in a career-high 11 straight starts (June 23-present), tying Bob Gibson (11 in 1968) for 2nd-longest streak by a Cardinals hurler since at least 1900, behind Adam Wainwright (12 in 2009).**
- Surrendered 8 runs combined over his last 11 starts, the fewest by a Cardinal in any 11-start span since **Jack Flaherty** gave up 8 from Aug 13-Sept. 29, 2019.
- Leahy's 1.70 second half ERA (37.0 IP) ranks 2nd in MLB since the All-Star Break to **Reid Detmers** (1.55).
- Leahy (10) and **Andre Pallante** (12) are the two Cardinals with double-digit wins this season ... Enters today on a career-high 5-game winning streak (June 28-present), tying **Andre Pallante** (5/23[1]-6/22) for the longest on the team this year.
- Since June 23, leads MLB (min. 50.0 IP) with a 1.28 ERA (8 ER/56.1 IP) and his 10 starts yielding 2 runs or fewer in that span.**
- Enters tonight's game on 10.0 scoreless innings streak, T-10th longest active in the NL.**
- His 126.1 innings pitched are a single-season MLB career high, as are his 115 strikeouts. His career single-season high for IP as a professional is 144.2 in 2022 between Memphis (AAA) and Springfield (AA).
- Ranks in MLB's 97th percentile in arm extension (7.3 ft.), which is measured from how far off the mound he releases the ball on average.
- Led off his Aug. 12 start vs. PHI by striking out **Kyle Schwarber** (looking) for his 100th strikeout this season, marking his first MLB season with 100+ strikeouts.
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, August 23 at Philadelphia): ND, L 6-4; 4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 4 SO, 0 HR - 63 pitches.

- Fired 4.0 scoreless innings with two hits last Sunday at Citizen's Bank Park as the Cardinals were victims of a walk-off defeat to the Phillies.
- Lowered his second-half ERA to 1.70 (37.0 IP) 2nd-best in MLB since the All-Star Break to **Reid Detmers** (1.55).

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

DON'T WALK: Became one of three Cardinals to strike out 8-or-more batters with 0 walks in his 8/7 start vs. COL, along with **Dustin May** (9 SO, 0 BB) on 5/27 at MIL and **Matthew Liberatore** (9 SO, 0 BB) on 8/19 at CIN.

BEND, DON'T BREAK: Ranks 2nd among MLB starting pitchers in opponent batting average with 2 outs & RISP at .078 BA (4-51) trailing Angels **Jack Kochanowicz** (.077, 2-26).

CENTRAL FOCUS: Earned four wins against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT, May 4 vs. MIL, July 4 at Chicago, Aug. 18 at Cincinnati) to improve to 6-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

EN GARDE: Ranks 6th among NL pitchers with his 27 Opponent's Sword Swings (1st: Jesus Luzardo, 35). *A “sword” swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.*

AIR BENDER: Boasts average swing & miss distances of 5.8 inches on his sweeper, highest among St. Louis starters.

HELLO 4TH OF JULY: Hurlled 5.0 scoreless innings through the Wrigley Field fog as the Cardinals handed the Cubs a 3-0 shutout on Independence Day ... Leahy allowed three singles and struck out six on only 77 pitches ... Following a 49-minute pre-game rain delay, **JJ Wetherholt** homered on the first pitch of the game . The game was also halted for 15 minutes after the 6th inning due to heavy fog combined with smoke from nearby fireworks.

PARK PLACE: Has made 8 starts this year at a Park (Last: 8/23 at Citizen's Bank Park); each of his first six road games took place at Parks (Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park). His start at Target Field on June 12 ended the string.

NO DECISIONS: Has earned the decision in 14 of his 25 starts, but just 6 decisions in his last 16 starts, going 5-1 since 5/23(2) at CIN.

STRETCHING OUT: Worked at least 5.0 innings in 20 of his 25 starts on the year, including a career-high 6.1 innings on 6/23 vs. Arizona.

LEAHY VS. PITTSBURGH:

- Makes his 2nd career start and 9th career appearance against the Pirates today.
- His first seven appearances came in relief in 2025, hurling 8.2 innings while allowing just one unearned run for a 0.00 ERA.
- His 22 career strikeouts against the Buccos are his 2nd-most against any team behind the Reds (31).
- Lifetime 6-1 with a 3.44 ERA (83.2 IP) and 84 strikeouts in 40 games (nine starts) vs. the NL Central. This season, Leahy is 4-0 vs. the NL Central.

LAST APPEARANCE VS. PIRATES (April 28, 2026 at PNC Park): W, 11-7, 5.1 IP, 9 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO, 0 HR, 82 pitches

- Set single-game career highs in innings pitched (5.1) and hits allowed (9) in his late April start.
