**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (2-0, 1 to play), White Sox (3 to play) and Yankees (3 to play) today at Tropicana Field...the Rays have won back-to-back games for the first time since winning three straight from April 9-12...they have lost two of four, five of eight, eight of 12 and 12 of their last 20 games since an 8-6 start...the Rays are a season-high-tying 6.5 GB in the AL East standings for the third straight day.

After plating a season-high 10 runs in the series opener on Friday, the Rays used a pair of 8th-inning, bases-loaded walks to claim a 3-1 win over the Mets last night...

**Austin Shenton** drew the decisive free pass in a nine-pitch plate appearance, becoming the fourth pinch hitter in Rays history with a go-ahead, bases-loaded walk in the 8th inning or later, joining **Ji-Man Choi** (Aug. 9, 2019 at SEA), **Reid Brignac** (April 24, 2010 vs. TOR) and **Eric Hinske** (June 24, 2008 at FLA).

The win ensured a series victory, snapping a five-series winless skid (0-4-1) and marking Tampa Bay's first series win since April 12-14 vs. SF.

The Rays improved to 7-4 against NL clubs compared to 9-14 vs. AL opponents...the .636 Interleague winning pct. ranks seventh in the majors.

Each of the Rays last seven wins have come by two runs or fewer, their longest such streak since an eight-game run from June 3-14, 2015...their 12 total such wins are second most in the majors behind the Yankees (13), and their .667 (12-6) winning pct. in such contests ranks third behind the Phillies (10-2/833) and Orioles (11-5/688).

Today's game marks the first time this season the Rays have the opportunity to sweep an opponent entering the final game of a series...they went 10-6 in those contests in 2023, winning five straight to open the season.

Rays starter **RHP Ryan Pepiot** is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, 2ER), 0.72 WHIP and .136 (8-for-59) opp. average over his last three outings...on the season, he ranks among AL leaders in WHIP (3rd, 0.87) and opp. average (5th, .168).

### WHAT'S AT STAKE

Secure their first series sweep since a two-game set from Sept. 26-27 at BOS, and their first in a series of 3+ games since Aug. 22-24, 2023 vs. COL.

Sweep the Mets for the second time, joining May 14-16, 2021 at Tropicana Field.

Win their third straight game, matching their longest winning streak of the season (April 9-12).

Snap a season-high-tying three-game losing streak in day games (also March 31-April 5), claiming their first daytime win since April 20 at NYY (2-0).

**CASH MONEY**—Last night's victory was the 755th of **Kevin Cash's** career, surpassing his predecessor, **Joe Maddon** (754), as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader...in the midst of his 10th season at the helm, Cash is the longest-tenured skipper in the majors with his current club, ahead of **LAD Dave Roberts** and **SEA Scott Servais**, both of whom are in their eighth seasons...in 2023, Cash was named an AL Manager of the Year finalist by the BBWAA for the fifth time in six years, receiving 13 second-place and 13 third-place votes.

Cash's 755 career wins are sixth most among active managers, trailing **TEX Bruce Bochy** (2,111), **SF Bob Melvin** (1,532), **COL Bud Black** (1,133), **DET A.J. Hinch** (809) and **Roberts** (775)...his .543 career winning pct. ranks fifth.

**IT TAKES GRIT**—Three of the Rays last four wins have been of the come-from-behind variety after coming back in only five of their first 14 wins...their eight comeback wins are tied for sixth most among AL clubs...the Rays have not scored first in any of their last four games, but are 4-2 in their last six games in which their opponent landed the opening blow...they began the season 3-10 in such games...their seven wins when the opposition scores first are tied with the Rangers for fourth most in the AL, trailing the Yankees (10), Twins (9) and Orioles (8).

**SLOW AND STEADY**—Over their last five games, 31 of the Rays 36 hits (86.1%) have been singles...on the season, 73.9 pct. of their hits have been singles, the highest mark in the majors...they sit among the bottom five in the majors in slugging pct. (25th, .355) and extra-base hits (29th, 72), but rank highly in infield hits (2nd, 45), singles (T3rd, 204).

The Rays 27 HR are their fewest through 34 games since 2005 (24HR)...they had an MLB-leading 69 HR at this point last season...they have recorded seven wins without the benefit of a homer, tied with three other teams for second most in the majors behind the Cardinals (8).

The Rays 35 SB pace the AL and rank fifth in the majors...the Mets (45) and Rays (36) have allowed more stolen bases than any other clubs.

**RELIEF RENAISSANCE**—The Rays bullpen has pitched to a 1.23 ERA (7.1IP, 1ER) this series after producing an 8.68 ERA (9.1IP, 9ER) last series in Milwaukee...the Rays 'pen ranks 10th in the AL/15th in the majors with a 3.57 ERA (63.0IP, 25ER) in their last 17 games since April 16...their 6.92 ERA (67.2IP, 52ER) over their first 17 games through April 15 was the worst in MLB.

**RHP Kevin Kelly** has recorded five scoreless appearances (6.0IP) since being recalled from Triple-A Durham on April 22...Kelly has retired each of his last 17 BF since plunking **DET Mark Canha** on April 22.

**LHP Garrett Cleavinger** has not allowed an ER in his last 10 outings, yielding only three hits in that span (3-for-27/111).

**RHP Jason Adam** owns a 0.71 ERA (12.2IP, 1ER) in his last 12 appearances...**RHP Phil Maton** has turned in a 1.35 ERA (6.2IP, 1ER) in his previous eight.

**RAYS OF SUNSHINE**—**Isaac Paredes** extended his home on-base streak to 15 games after reaching safely three times last night (2 1B, BB)...it marks the third-longest active streak in the AL, trailing **LAA Mike Trout** (21G) and **LAA Luis Rengifo** (19G)...the last Ray with a longer streak was **Yandy Diaz** (21G) from May 2-June 25, 2023...Paredes has recorded multiple hits in four of five, six of nine and nine of his last 14 games...his nine multi-hit efforts since April 17 are tied for second most in the majors behind **PHI Alec Bohm** (9).

**Richie Palacios** is has reached safely in 15 of 26 PA (.577 OBP) during a six-game on-base streak...he has gone 9-for-20 (.450) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 3 RBI and 6 BB during the run...on the season, his 16.5 pct. walk rate ranks second in the AL (min. 75PA) behind **DET Riley Greene** (16.9%).

**Yandy Diaz** has recorded back-to-back multi-hit games following an 0-for-15 skid.

**MEET THE METS**—The Rays and Mets conclude their 12th all-time series today, including the sixth at Tropicana Field...last night's win secured a series victory for the Rays, who improved to 7-4-0 in series play against the Mets (4-2-0 at home), winning five of the last six sets since 2015...they have won a club-record seven consecutive home games over the Mets dating back to Aug. 8, 2015, their longest home winning streak over a single opponent since winning seven straight over the Marlins from Sept. 6, 2020-July 25, 2023...the Rays have won seven of nine, 10 of 13 and 12 of the last 16 matchups with the Mets.

### CONNECTIONS

The Mets are one of nine franchises to have held Spring Training in St. Petersburg...their spring operations were based in St. Pete from their inaugural 1962 season through 1987...Huggins-Stengel Field in Crescent Lake Park, where their spring practices were held, was named after Hall of Famers **Miller Huggins** and **Casey Stengel**...the latter managed the Mets from 1962-65.

Rays INF/OF **Amed Rosario** was signed by the Mets in 2012 and was named their top prospect by *Baseball America* in 2016...he appeared in 403 games with New York before being dealt to Cleveland ahead of the 2021 season in a deal involving INF **Francisco Lindor**.

Rays RHP **Erasmus Ramirez** posted a 0.63 ERA over six relief appearances for the Mets in 2020.

Mets INF **Pete Alonso** is a Tampa native and attended nearby Plant High School prior to his collegiate career at the University of Florida.

Mets INF **Joey Wendle** spent four seasons with the Rays from 2018-21...highlights of his tenure include a World Series appearance in 2020 and his lone career All-Star selection in 2021...Wendle was originally acquired by the Rays from the Athletics in Dec. 2017 in exchange for a player to be named later, who turned out to be current Rangers **C. Jonah Heim**.

Mets reliever **LHP Jake Diekmann** appeared in 50 games with the Rays last season.

Mets **C Omar Narváez** originally signed with the Rays in 2009 and was in the club's farm system until the White Sox selected him the minor league phase of the 2013 Rule 5 Draft.

### PEP IN HIS STEP

Today, RHP **Ryan Pepiot** looks to become the seventh Ray (10th instance) to toss 6.0+ IP and allow one run or fewer in four straight starts, including the first since **Shane McClellan**'s club-record-tying five-start streak from June 20-July 13, 2022.

**TODAY'S START**—Pepiot will make his seventh start of the year and his fifth at home...has a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, 2ER) in his last three starts...has gone 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0IP, 2ER) in his last two starts at Tropicana Field after going 0-2 with an 8.44 ERA (10.2IP, 10ER) in his first two home starts.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Earned his third win of the season on April 29 at Milwaukee...threw 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering two hits with zero walks and seven strikeouts.

- ✦ Pepiot allowed a 1st-inning single to **William Contreras**, but went on to retire 14 straight batters...he conceded a leadoff double to **Joey Ortiz** in the 6th inning, but struck out **Jackson Chourio** and retired both **Sal Frelick** and **Contreras** to complete the outing.
- ✦ He has thrown 6.0 innings in three straight starts.

**BITE AT THE APPLE**—Pepiot will be making his first career start against New York...has made three career appearances vs. the NL East, all coming against Miami...is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) and 15 strikeouts in those outings.

**LOCKED IN**—Pepiot has thrown 6.0 innings in each of his last three starts while allowing three hits or fewer in each outing...he is the sixth pitcher in franchise history to have at least three straight starts working 6.0+ innings while allowing three hits or fewer, joining **Chris Archer**, **Tyler Glasnow**, **Jeremy Hellickson**, **Shane McClellan** and **Rich Hill**...McClellan owns the franchise record with four straight such starts from July 2-26, 2022.

- ✦ He is one of four pitchers this season to accomplish the feat, joining **SD Dylan Cease**, **SEA Bryce Miller** and **MIN Bailey Ober**...he would become the first pitcher this year to do so in four straight starts.

**AN ARTIST AT WORK**—Pepiot's 32.7 pct. whiff rate ranks fifth in the majors, trailing **DET Jack Flaherty** (37.8%), **PIT Jared Jones** (37.0%), **MIL Freddy Peralta** (34.6%) and **NYM José Butto** (33.2%)...32 of his 38 SO have been swinging strikeouts.

- ✦ The 38 SO are tied with **Tyler Glasnow** for third most through a pitcher's first six games with the Rays, trailing **Taj Bradley** (42SO) and **Charlie Morton** (39SO)...Bradley and Morton each struck out a franchise-best 48 batters in their first seven outings with the club.

**HEAT CHECK**—Pepiot's four-seam fastball has been one of the most effective pitches in the majors...opponents are just 4-for-54 (.074) with 23 SO against the four-seamer...the .074 AVG is the lowest mark on any individual pitch with a minimum of 40 at-bats ending in the offering...the next closest pitches are **LAD Ryan Yarbrough's** curveball (.098, 4-for-41) and **TEX Cody Bradford's** four-seam fastball (.100, 4-for-40).

- ✦ Pepiot has produced a 41.0 pct. whiff rate on his four-seamer, the second-highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball (min. 50 pitches swung at), trailing only **OAK Mason Miller's** four-seamer (48.6%).
- ✦ He has produced a 39.2 pct. whiff rate on fastballs in the strike zone, the highest mark in the majors (min. 50 FB in the zone swung at), ahead of **BAL Craig Kimbrel** (38.2%).

**HUNG OUT TO DRY**—The Rays have been outscored, 27-13 (-14), in Pepiot's starts...they have provided him with only 2.34 runs of support per 9.0 IP, sixth lowest among AL pitchers (min. 25.0IP) behind **DET Reese Olson** (1.08), **CWS Chris Flexen** (1.82), teammate **Zach Eflin** (1.98), **OAK Ross Stripling** (2.01) and **KC Michael Wacha** (2.15)

- ✦ In his career as a starter, Pepiot is 6-0 with a 2.15 ERA (54.1IP, 13ER) when receiving just two or more runs of support (10GS) and 1-3 with a 5.16 ERA (29.2IP, 17ER) with one or zero runs (6GS)...in the three starts in which he received multiple runs of support this season, Pepiot is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, 2ER)...this, compared to 1-2 with an 5.40 ERA (16.2IP, 10ER) in his other three starts.
- ✦ The Rays have not scored more than three runs in any of Pepiot's starts...they are averaging just 2.34 runs per start in his six outings compared to 4.43 runs in their other 28 contests.

**MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE**—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, 2ER) and 0.61 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to a 5.40 ERA (16.2IP, 10ER) and 1.14 WHIP in all other frames...four of the 10 runs he's allowed have come in the 1st inning.
