# Los Angeles Dodgers (98-61) vs. San Francisco Giants (78-81)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants open their final series of the season with the NL West rivals Los Angeles Dodgers.

- ► SF needs a series sweep to earn its second-straight 81-81 season.
- ▶ Since going to the postseason four times from 2010-2016, the Giants have failed to participate in postseason play in six of their last seven seasons with the only postseason appearance coming in 2021.
- ▶ This month, the Giants are 8-17 (.320) which is ahead only of the Nationals (7-17, .292) for the worst September record in the National League.
- ▶ SF has scored two runs or fewer in five consecutive games.
- ▶ The Giants have scored an NL-low 231 runs since July 18 (3.55 runs/game) and have a .223/.301/.358 slash line in that span.

**NEWS RELEASE:** The Giants announced today that the club has dismissed manager **Gabe Kapler**...**Kai Correa** will serve as the interim manager for the remainder of the season.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game:

- ▶ RHP Keaton Winn (#67) reinstated from the Injured List.
- ▶ **RHP Luke Jackson** (#77) reinstated from the Paternity List.
- ▶ IF Casey Schmitt (#6) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **OF Mitch Haniger** placed on the 10-day IL with a low back strain (retroactive to Sept. 26).
- ▶ **IF J.D. Davis** placed on the 10-day IL with a left shoulder strain (retroactive to Sept. 27).
- ▶ **C Joey Bart** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

**SPOIL THEIR FUN:** With the season series between the rivals tied at five wins apiece, two wins would give the Giants their first season-series victory over the Dodgers since taking 10 of 19 regular season games in 2021.

- According to *Stats, LLC*, a series win would make SF the only team to win multiple season series vs. the Dodgers since 2020.
- ▶ SF currently has a +4 run differential on the Dodgers this year, with a 3.79 ERA, which is the second-best ERA against Los Angeles-NL this year (Blue Jays lead with a 3.38 ERA in three games).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** SF is 44-34 (.564) at home this year, the 10th-best home record in the Majors...this is in contrast to its 34-47 (.420) road record, which is 25th in MLB.

► Stats, LLC noted that SF's 15-8 (.652) mark at home vs. NL West teams is tied with MIL for the fifth-best home divisional record in the Majors behind the DET and ATL (16-7, .696), LAD (18-8, .692), ARI (17-9, .654).

**THAT'S SOME GOOD COMPANY:** Since 1993, only four Giants had better slugging percentages than **OF Mike Yastrzemski** over their first five seasons with the team (*Stats, LLC*).

**PAT AND BLAKE:** Rookie backstops, **C Patrick Bailey** and **C/OF Blake Sabol**, have handled the majority of catching duties this season for SF, totaling 127 starts behind the plate.

- According to Stats, LLC, they're just the fourth rookie catching duo since 1901 to have reached base 100 times each in a season (last being 1969 CHW's Gail Hopkins and Ed Herrmann).
- ▶ In addition to Sabol and Bailey, SF has 428 combined games this year started by rookies (403 starts from position players and 25 from pitchers), which is the third-highest in the SF-era (*Stats, LLC*).

**NO WALK ZONE:** With 398 walks allowed this season, *Stats, LLC* notes that Giants pitchers are on pace to have the second-fewest walks since 1969 in franchise history behind the 389 in 2014 (min. 150 games).

- ▶ The team's leaders in walks are **LHP Alex Wood** and **LHP Sean Manaea** (42 walks each)...that would be the fewest walks in a full season by the Giants' team leader in franchise history (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ Only the Dodgers (40, Tony Gonsolin) and Rays (41, Shane McClanahan) have lower marks this season from their team leader (*Stats, LLC*).

**HE CAN DO IT ALL: IF Thairo Estrada** hit his 14th home run of the season while also stealing his 23rd base on Wednesday.

- ▶ Estrada has hit 10 of his career-high tying 14 home runs at home, and 13 of his 14 home runs off right-handers this year.
- ▶ His 23 stolen bases are the most by a Giant since **Ángel Pagán** (29) and **Grégor Blanco** (26) in 2012...his 23 stolen bases are the most by a Giants second baseman since **Joe Morgan** had 24 in 1982.
- According to Stats, LLC, Estrada has accounted for over a third of SF's stolen bases since the start of last season.

## **KEATON WINN RHP**

2023 RECORD: 1-2, 3.89 ERA

Height/Weight: 6-4/238 Born: Ollie, IA

**Age:** 25 (Feb. 20, 1998) **Signed Through:** 2023

Bats/Throws: R/R

WITH THE GIANTS: In his first year at the Major-League level for SF...was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Iowa Western Community College.

**BACK IN THE FOLD:** Winn returns to the rotation after missing nine games with a positive Covid test...today will be Winn's fifth career MLB start, and first since September 16 at Colorado.

**LAST OUTING:** Winn is coming off two straight starts vs. the Rockies, with his first being the better of the two...Winn earned the win and struck out nine while allowing three runs on five hits and no walks in 6.0 innings on September 10...in his more recent start, Winn allowed three runs on three hits and two walks while striking out five in 4.0 innings on September 16.

**VS. LOS ANGELES-NL:** This will be Winn's first career game vs. the Dodgers...he has, however, faced the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers three times this season, posting a 3.75 ERA (5er, 12.0ip) while striking out 17...the lone Dodger he's faced in his Major League career is **IF Kolten Wong**, who went 0-for-2 when Winn faced Seattle on July 4.

**STRIKING IT RICH:** In his last home start for SF, September 10 vs. Colorado, Winn threw 62 of 80 pitches for strikes...he is the only pitcher in the Majors this season to throw that many strikes with fewer than 81 pitches...he is also just one of five Giants to throw at least 60 strikes in a game in which he threw fewer than 81 pitches.

WINN THE DAY: Despite this being Winn's fifth career MLB start, the rookie has pitched at least 3.0 innings in all eight career outings...he is just one of three Giants rookies since 2010 to pitch at least 3.0 innings in each of his first eight career games (others: Andrew Suárez in 2018 and Shaun Anderson in 2019).

**KEEPING IT GROUNDED:** The rookie relies on ground-balls to get outs, with a 56.3% ground ball-rate...Los Angeles offers a unique challenge for the split-finger-throwing Winn, as the Dodgers only hit the ball on the ground at a 37.9% rate, which is the lowest in the Majors...even so, the Dodgers have a .590 OPS against split-fingers with a .310 slugging percentage.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Winn (nine strikeouts on September 3 vs. COL) and **LHP Kyle Harrison** (11 strikeouts on August 28 vs. CIN) are the first Giants rookie duo to each strike out nine or more in a game in the same season since 2003: **Jesse Foppert** (10 strikeouts on June 11 at CWS, 10 strikeouts on July 20 vs. COL) and **Jerome Williams** (nine strikeouts on August 1 at CIN).

**MEET THE ROOK:** One year prior to being drafted and signing with SF, Winn was selected by the Giants in the 20th round of the 2017 MLB Draft...he opted to return to college...Winn missed two years of MiLB action, first with the 2020 season cancellation, and next by missing the entire 2021 season recovering from Tommy John surgery...he is currently the Giants' No. 16 prospect on *MLB.com*.

**SAVE YOUR TEARS:** He became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his MLB debut (*Elias*)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).
