RAY REPORT—The Rays continue their post-All-Star-break schedule with a sevengame road trip against the Yankees (1-1, 2 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) this afternoon at Yankee Stadium...Tampa Bay closed the first half of the season winning seven of its last eight series for the first time in franchise history...the Rays 15-10 (.600) mark since June 19 is third best in the AL, trailing the Astros (19-6/.760) and Red Sox (14-9/.609)... they are 4.5 games behind the Red Sox for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot... Tampa Bay has the hardest remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning pct. of .526 (Elias).

Tampa Bay hit a season-high-tying 4 HR in yesterday's win, matching their output from April 14 vs. SF...it marked the first time the Rays hit 4 HR on the road since doing so in the Bronx on July 31, 2023 (Franco/B. Lowe/J. Lowe/Paredes).

The Rays hit 2 HR in the 5th inning (Paredes/Arozarena), marking the fifth time they have homered twice in a frame this season (last: June 30 vs. WSH, 2nd inn., Caballero/Paredes).

Tampa Bay's eight-run margin of victory was its largest on the road since Aug. 29,

Tampa Bay's eight-run margin of victory was its largest on the road since Aug. 29, 2023 at MIA (+9, 11-2)...it was the Rays largest margin of victory over the Yankees on the road since Oct. 2, 2021 (+10, 12-2).

Randy Arozarena (4-for-5, 2B, 2HR, 3RBI) became the first visiting player to register 4+ hits at Yankee Stadium since DET Matt Vierling on Sept. 7, 2023 (also 4H)...he was the seventh Ray to accomplish the feat, including the first since Kevin Kiermaier (4H) on Sept. 8, 2016.

The Rays turned a season-high-tying three doubles plays (3x, last: May 25 vs. KC)... they hadn't turned three double plays vs. NYY since Aug. 15, 2022 (also 3 GIDP). With yesterday's victory, Tampa Bay moved to the .500 mark for a franchise-record-tying 22nd time, matching the 2017 club.

Tampa Bay improved to 17-8 (.680) against left-handed starters, the third-best mark in the majors behind Cleveland (20-6/.769) and Los Angeles-NL (25-10/.714).

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Prior to today's game, Tampa Bay placed RHP Ryan Pepiot (right knee infection) on the 15-day IL and recalled RHP Tyler Zuber from Triple-A Durham...Zuber was signed to a minor league contract on May 14 after pitching for the Long Island Ducks in the independent Atlantic League...added to the major league roster on July 18, Zuber went 3-0 with a 2.49 ERA (21.2IP, 6ER) and four saves in 18 appearances for Durham

TALKIN' TAJ—Taj Bradley (W, 7.0IP, 1H, 0R, 2BB, 5SO) extended his scoreless inning streak to 17.0 in yesterday's win, marking the longest active run in the majors by a starter and tied for the MLB lead with CLE Hunter Gaddis...prior to yesterday, only four pitchers in their age 23 season or younger had ever thrown 7.0+ scoreless innings and allowed one hit or fewer on the road against the Yankees: BAL Jim Palmer (May 12, 1967), BOS Billy Rohr (April 14, 1967), PHA Eddie Smith (Sept. 29, 1937-G2) and PHA Rube Bressler (Aug. 16, 1915).

Bradley's 0.92 ERA (49.0IP, 5ER) over his last eight starts is the second lowest by a Ray over an eight-start span in franchise history, trailing only Chris Archer's 0.84 ERA (53.1IP, 5ER) from Sept. 14, 2014–April 26, 2015.

RANDY LAND—Randy Arozarena tallied his seventh career multi-HR game, including his first since April 29, 2023 at CWS...he became the sixth player in franchise history to tally 11+ total bases in a game vs. the Yankees, including the first since Isaac Paredes (12TB) on June 21, 2022...his four hits matched a career high (7x, last: Aug. 4, 2022 at DET). He has reached base safely in 26 of his last 28 games since June 14, including hits in 24 of those contests, slashing .307/.398/.574 (31-for-101) with 9 2B, 6 HR, 14 RBI, 11 BB and 7 SB during that stretch. Arozarena has hit safely 19 of his last 21 road games since June 1, batting .347 (25-for-72)...his 1.123 road OPS over that timeframe ranks fourth in MLB (min. 75PA) behind HOU Yordan Alvarez (1.303), NYY Aaron Judge (1.268) and NYY Juan Soto (1.178).

NFED FOR MEAD—In his first game after being recalled from Triple-A Durham, Curtis Mead (3-for-5, 2B, RBI, R) snapped Tampa Bay's franchise-record 0-for-35 skid with RISP in the 3rd inning, recording a two-out, run-scoring double to put the Rays ahead, 1-0... Mead has 4 XBH (3 2B, 1 HR) and 5 RBI in his last seven big-league games since April 24... he had 0 XBH and 1 RBI in his first 20 games of the season...he has 1+ XBH and 1+ RBI in back-to-back games and can tie Isaac Paredes (3G: June 30–July 3) for the longest run by a Ray this season in his next appearance.

DAWGS GOTTA EAT—Brandon Lowe registered his 115th career homer on Friday, surpassing Ben Zobrist for fifth on the Rays all-time list...B.J. Upton sits in fourth with 118 HR...Lowe has hit safely in six straight games and nine of 11 since July 4, slashing 359/419/.641 (14-for-39) with 2 2B, 3 HR, 4 RBI and 4 BB...he ranks among AL leaders during that stretch in average (6th) and OPS (7th, 1.060).

He has hit safely in 10 of 12 games against the Yankees since May 13, 2023, slashing 390/435/.634 (16-for-41) with 12B, 3 HR, 12 RBI and 4 BB.

With home runs in back-to-back games, he has the opportunity to homer in three straight contests for the first time since a career-high-tying four-game run from April 8-11, 2023.

RUNNIN RAYS—The Rays have swiped a stolen base in eight straight games, the longest active run in the majors...they have stolen at least one bag in 13 of 14 games this month, going 17-for-20 (85.0%)...with a steal today, Tampa Bay would match their season-long nine-game streak from Opening Day through April 6.

Yesterday, José Caballero snapped a career-long 16-game drought without a steal, pushing his AL-leading total to 25 SB...Caballero joined Carl Crawford (2009, 2004) as the only Rays to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break.

The Rays stole an AL-best 95 bags before the break, besting the Red Sox (88SB)... Tampa Bay paced the AL in steals at the break for the second straight season, accomplishing the feat for the second time in franchise history, joining 2008-09... according to Elias, the Rays are the first AL club to have the most steals before the break in consecutive seasons since the Astros in 2015-16.

AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL—Tampa Bay pitching has not permitted a home run in three straight games for the first time since July 20-22, 2023...the last four-game homerless streak for Rays pitching came from May 31–June 4, 2023 (4G).

RISP, BUT NO REWARD—Since July 5, the Rays are batting an MLB-worst .105 (10-for-95) with runners in scoring position...on the season, Tampa Bay's .221 RISP AVG is second lowest in the majors, ahead of only Chicago-AL (.209).

**Tampa Bay's .221 RISP AVG would signal the lowest single-season mark in franchise history, surpassing the mark held by the 2011 Rays (.224).

**José Caballero is on an 0-for-17 skid with RISP...Josh Lowe is 3-for-22 (.136) with RISP in his last 24 games and Jose Siri is 1-for-29 (.034) in his last 30.

CONCRETE JUNGLE CLASH—The Rays and Yankees continue their 13-game season series this afternoon in the Bronx, with New York holding a 6-5 advantage thus far...the Yankees claimed series victories from April 19-21 and May 10-12 before the Rays took two of three at Tropicana Field from July 9-11...Tampa Bay needs a win today to avoid just their second season series loss to New York since 2020 (11-8 in 2022)...min. 15 games, the Rays 37-31 (.544) mark against the Yankees since Aug. 18, 2020 is second best in MLB

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will take the ball for his third start of the campaign and second on the road...marks his 12th career major league start, four of which will have come against the Yankees...is seeking his first win since July 3, 2022 at Toronto, 748 days ago...underwent Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28, 2022 in Dallas, Texas, performed by Dr. Keith Meister...has a 4.26 ERA (50.2IP, 24ER) in 11 career MLB starts.

LAST TIME OUT—Worked into the 5th inning of a 5-4 home win over the Yankees on July 11 (ND, 4.1IP, 6H, 3ER, BB, 5SO)...allowed at least one baserunner in each inning...yielded solo homers to **Juan Soto** and **Austin Wells**, the third time in his career he has allowed multiple long balls (last: 3HR on July 10, 2022 at CIN)...held the Yankees to 1-for-8 (.125) with 0 XBH and 3 SO on his slider compared to 4-for-8 (.500) with 1 2B, 2 HR and 2 SO against his four-seam fastball.

BRONX BATTLE—Baz has not factored into any of his three career starts opposite the Yankees, posting a 3.86 ERA (11.2IP, 5ER) with 15 strikeouts against five walks and a .239 (11-for-46) opp. average...he has allowed three runs or fewer in each outing, but has not completed 5.0 innings in any of them...this marks his second career start at Yankee Stadium, joining Oct. 2, 2021 (ND, 2.2IP, H, ER, 2BB, 4SO).

Baz is 2-0 with a 2.51 ERA (28.2IP, 8ER) and 1.01 WHIP over six career starts against AL East opponents...this includes a 1.23 ERA (14.2IP, 2ER) and 0.95 WHIP in three road starts.

BACK IN BUSINESS—Through his first two starts, Baz's slider has been his most effective offering...opponents are 1-for-15 (.067) with no extrabase hits in at-bats ending with the pitch...opposing hitters are batting a combined .429 (12-for-28) with 2 2B and 2 HR against his other three pitches (four-seamer, curveball, changeup).

Baz has had the most success against right-handed hitters, holding them to 3-for-19 (.158) with 5 SO and no walks...righties are hitless (0-for-10) against his four-seam fastball.

ALL THE ACCOLADES—Despite missing nearly two years of MLB action, Baz was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 96 overall prospect in the game in its July 3 updated rankings...following the 2023 season, Baz was tabbed by the publication as having the best slider among Rays prospects for the sixth consecutive year...after the 2022 season, he was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 32 overall prospect in baseball and the topranked farmhand in the Rays system...he peaked at No. 8 on the list at the conclusion of the 2021 campaign conclusion of the 2021 campaign.

THE ROAD BACK—Baz began his rehab assignment with Triple-Durham on May 5...in 10 starts with the Bulls, he went 3-3 with a 4.12 ERA (39.1IP, 18ER) and 44 SO against 23 BB...in five June starts, however, he went 3-0 with a 1.57 ERA (23.0IP, 4ER) and 35 SO.

Baz was slowed early in spring due to two bouts with oblique soreness, one coming as the result of picking up a weight, and the other after experiencing soreness following a simulated game appearance.

CAREER RUNDOWN—Baz made six starts in 2022, going 1-2 with a 5.00 ERA (27.0IP, 15ER) with 30 strikeouts and nine walks...in four starts from June 17–July 3, he went 1-0 with a 1.21 ERA (22.1IP, 3ER) and 26 strikeouts... the four-start run was bookended by two outings (June 11 at MIN & July 10 at CIN) in which he went a combined 0-2 with a 23.14 ERA (4.2IP, 12ER).

On June 17 at BAL, he started on his 23rd birthday and yielded two bits across 6.0 searches injures, he became the third Pay to make a

On June 17 at BAL, he started on his 23rd birthday and yielded two hits across 6.0 scoreless innings...he became the third Ray to make a scoreless start on his birthday, joining **Corey Kluber** (4.2 IP) on April 10, 2022 vs. Baltimore and **Jeremy Hellickson** (8.2 IP) on April 8, 2012 vs. New York-AL.

He was on the Rays active roster from June 11–July 12...underwent arthroscopic surgery on March 21 to remove loose bodies from his right elbow...placed on the 15-day IL on July 14 with a right elbow strain...following a rest, treatment and rehab program, continued to feel discomfort and underwent Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28. In **2021**, he made his MLB debut on Sept. 20 vs. TOR (W, 5.0IP, 2H, 2ER, 0BB, 5SO)...went on to make two additional starts, finishing the season 2-0 with a 2.03 ERA (13.1IP, 3ER)...he became the second pitcher in major league history to start a postseason game with

pitcher in major league history to start a postseason game with three or fewer career regular season appearances up to that point, joining TB Matt Moore in Game 1 of the 2011 ALDS at Texas.
