COLORADO ROCKIES (17-26) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-20)

May 14, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 12:35 EDT - Game #44/Home #23

RHP Chase Dollander (3-2, 3.35 ERA) vs. LHP Mason Montgomery (1-0, 2.87 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have split the first two games of this six-game homestand vs. Colorado (Tuesday-Thursday) and Philadelphia (Friday-Sunday) after beating the Rockies, 3-1, on Tuesday and losing to them, 10-4, on Wednesday...Will embark on a six-game road trip to St. Louis (May 19-21) and Toronto (May 22-24) following this homestand...Have recorded the best stolen base percentage (88.6, 39-for-44) in all of Major League Baseball (the 39 steals rank eighth in all of MLB).

PHILTY NUMBERS: Pittsburgh will continue this six-game homestand with three games vs. Philadelphia during MLB Rivalry Weekend (Friday-Sunday)...The Pirates swept the Phillies in a three-game series last year from June 6-8 at PNC Park, marking their first of seven sweeps last year...They have won seven of their last eight contests vs. Philadelphia here (since July 29, 2023).

ROCK YOUR WORLD: Pittsburgh won four of six games against Colorado last season (the Rockies won two of three games from August 1-3 at Coors Field, while the Pirates swept a three-game series from August 22-24 at PNC Park)...Pittsburgh is 44-27 (.620) against Colorado since the beginning of the 2014 campaign and has won or split 10 of 11 season series during that time.

MASTERFUL MASON: Mason Montgomery will start this afternoon vs. Colorado, marking his third start of 2026 (also 1.0 inning on April 15 vs. Washington and 1.0 inning on April 27 vs. St. Louis)...Montgomery has made 11 straight scoreless appearances (11.0ip), a streak that started on April 10.

32 BUCS: Brandon Bidois made his Major League debut after pitching the eighth inning on Wednesday vs. Colorado...He became the first Pirate (pitcher or player) from Australia to ever appear in a game...Bidois, who was the 32nd different Pirate (pitcher or player) used this season, also became the third Pittsburgh player to make his Major League debut this year, joining Konnor Griffin (April 3 vs. Baltimore) & Wilber Dotel (April 19 vs. Tampa Bay).

HIGH FIVE: Pirates starting pitchers have gone at least 5.0 innings in 13 consecutive games (since April 29 vs. St. Louis)...It marks the staff's longest such streak since doing that in 15 consecutive contests from April 1-17, 2024.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: Konnor Griffin doubled and scored a run on Wednesday vs. Colorado...He is batting .313 (21-for-67) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks, five stolen bases, 10 runs scored and a .910 OPS over his last 18 contests, dating back to April 24 at Milwaukee (his 20th birthday)...Griffin ranks tied for fifth in the National League in hits and total bases (36), as well as ninth in OPS, during that time.

RELIABLE RELIEVER: Evan Sisk had two strikeouts in 1.1 scoreless innings of relief on Wednesday vs. Colorado...He has a 0.73 ERA (12.1ip/1er), 14 strikeouts and a .150 batting average against (6-for-40) in his last 10 games (since April 21 at Texas)...His 0.73 ERA in that stretch ranks third among Major League relievers (minimum 12.0 innings pitched), trailing Milwaukee's Aaron Ashby (0.69) and Detroit's Brant Hurter (0.71)...Sisk's 20 strikeouts since making his season debut on April 13 vs. Washington are tied with three others (including Colorado's Tanner Gordon) for the eighth-most among Major League relievers, trailing Ashby (24), Cleveland's Erik Sabrowski (23), Chicago (AL)'s Grant Taylor (22), Detroit's Drew Anderson (21), Colorado's Chase Dollander (21) and San Diego's Mason Miller (21)/Adrian Morejon (21).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 14, 2023: Mitch Keller struck out a career-high 13 batters and did not allow a walk while tossing 7.0 scoreless innings in Pittsburgh's 4-0 win over Baltimore at Camden Yards. He became the first Pirates pitcher in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have 13 strikeouts, zero walks and zero runs in an outing. Pittsburgh also set a club record by striking out 17 batters without issuing a walk in that day's victory.

HOW ACQUIRED: From Tampa Bay in a six-player trade on December 19, 2025.

AS OF LATE: Montgomery will make his third start today vs. Colorado (also April 15 vs. Washington and April 27 vs. St. Louis)...He has made just three appearances in the last 14 days entering today, coming on April 30 vs. St. Louis (1.0ip), May 7 vs. Arizona (0.2ip) and Sunday at San Francisco (1.2ip)...Montgomery has pitched a career-high 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings, a stretch that dates back to April 10 at Wrigley Field.

FOR STARTERS: Montgomery pitched 1.0 inning in his first Major League start on April 15 vs. Washington (his 75th Major League game)...It was his first start at any level since August 4, 2024 with Durham (Rays' Triple-A) vs. Memphis (made 74 minor league starts from 2021-24)...Montgomery also pitched in relief in Pittsburgh's game on April 14 vs. Washington...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he was one of six Pirates in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to pitch in relief one game & start the team's next game, joining Bob Friend (July 9-13, 1961), Billy O'Dell (Sept. 26-28, 1966), Bruce Kison (June 2-3, 1979), Pat Mahomes (August 24-26, 2003) & Kevin Correia (August 19-20, 2012).

RISPY BUSINESS: Montgomery is holding opposing hitters to a .100 average (2-for-20) with 12 strikeouts with runners in scoring position...Opponents are also batting just .194 (6-for-31) with 10 strikeouts against Montgomery when hitting with runners on.

PESKY LEFTY: Montgomery's 21 strikeouts as a reliever rank ninth among left-handed relief pitchers in the National League, behind Milwaukee's Aaron Ashby (39), New York's Sean Manaea (26), San Diego's Adrian Morejon (26), teammate Gregory Soto (26), Atlanta's Dylan Lee (25), Cincinnati's Brock Burke (23), Philadelphia's Tanner Banks (22) & Los Angeles' Jack Dreyer (22)...He has two strikeouts as a starting pitcher.

WELCOME TO TOWN: Montgomery was acquired from Tampa Bay, along with infielder Brandon Lowe and outfielder Jake Mangum, in a three-team, six-player trade last year on December 19...The Pirates sent right-handed pitcher Mike Burrows, who had a 3.94 ERA (96.0ip/42er) in 23 games (19 starts) last year, to Houston in the deal.

K COLLECTOR: Montgomery struck out 63 batters over 46.0 innings in 2025...The 63 strikeouts were the fourth-most among all left-handed rookie relief pitchers in Major League Baseball (they also ranked 11th among all rookie relief pitchers in the league).

2025 IN REVIEW: Montgomery went 1-3 with a 5.67 ERA (46.0ip/29er) in 57 appearances with Tampa Bay last year (his first full season in Major League Baseball)... He secured his first Major League save on May 13 at Toronto, while also earning his first Major League win on June 18 vs. Baltimore...Montgomery also went 1-0 with two saves, a 2.00 ERA (9.0ip/2er) and 15 strikeouts over nine games with Triple-A Durham.

INSTANT IMPACT: Montgomery struck out all six batters he faced on September 24, 2024 at Detroit (his eighth Major League game)...He joined Jorge Sosa (June 22, 2004 at Toronto) as the only relievers in Rays history (since 1998) to record at least six strikeouts in 2.0 innings or fewer (he was the only one to not allow a baserunner).

PRIZED PROSPECT: Montgomery had a 3.75 ERA (355.2ip/148er) and 455 strikeouts in 101 minor league appearances (74 starts) in Tampa Bay's system from 2021-25...He was twice recognized as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star, coming in 2022 & 2023.

MEET MASON: Montgomery was originally selected by Chicago (AL) out of Leander (TX) High School in the 39th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, but he did not sign...He attended Texas Tech University (he had 128 strikeouts during his time there from 2019-21) before being selected by Tampa Bay in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft...His father, Bobby, played collegiately at Howard Payne (TX) College.

 ✖ Is a 2017 graduate of Lewis-Palmer (CO) High School (approx. 50 miles south of Coors Field)...His parents were athletes at the U.S. Air Force Academy.

 ✖ His 10 home runs as a center fielder lead the National League and rank second in Major League Baseball, behind only Minnesota's Byron Buxton (15).
 ✖ Is 17-for-52 (.327) with four home runs, 11 RBI and a .960 OPS against left-handed pitchers this season (he went 11-for-108 vs. southpaws last year).

 ✖ Is 21-for-67 (.313) with eight extra-base hits, 11 RBI, seven walks, five steals and 10 runs scored across his last 18 games (since 4/24 at Milwaukee).
