TODAY'S GAME: The Giants will need a victory this afternoon to secure a series win over the visiting Blue Jays after dropping last night's game 10-6.

- ▶ The Giants are 9-6 in their last 15 games dating to June 24, taking series from the Cubs (3-1), Dodgers (2-1) and Braves (2-1) while dropping their last series at Cleveland (1-2).
- ▶ SF has won three of its last four home series, and seven of its last 10 games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ In rubber games this year the Giants are 8-3...they went 1-1 in rubber games on their last road trip, winning the finale in Atlanta on July 4 but losing in Cleveland on Sunday.
- ▶ Against the American League this year, the Giants are 9-14 and have lost five of their seven series against AL teams... SF's only series wins against AL opponents this year were at Texas (June 7-9) and vs. Houston (June 10-12).

BIRTHDAY SPRINKLE DONUT!: Four time World Series Champion and current Giants broadcaster **Javier López** turns 47 today...he'll be part of the **Core Four Wall of Fame** ceremony on Saturday.

WE NEED A REFRESHING SLURPEE: SF has scuffled in day games recently after starting off the year playing quite well under the sun.

- ▶ The Giants have lost seven of their last eight day games dating to June 19 with the lone win coming against the Dodgers here on June 30 (a 10-4 victory).
- ▶ SF went 18-10 through its first 28 day games this year (through June 8)...since June 9 they are 3-9 in day games.

OPEN 24 HOURS: The Giants scored two more ninth innings runs last night in a losing effort...they have scored 114 runs this year from the 8th inning on, second-most in the Majors only to the Mets 115 runs from the eighth inning onward.

- ▶ SF's .762 OPS from the 8th inning on is third-best in the Majors behind the Orioles (.786) and Mets (.779).

MEET UP SPOT: The Giants are facing off against former RHP Kevin Gausman in today's series finale...today's outing is Gausman's first back at Oracle Park since signing with the Jays after the 2021 season following a two-year run with SF.

- ▶ In 23 career games here (21 w/SF), Gausman has averaged 11.9 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...that's the best K/9ip ratio in the ballpark's history (since 2000) for a pitcher who's made at least 20 starts here (*Stats, LLC*).

7-NOW: C Patrick Bailey clubbed his seventh homer of the year last night, matching his total from last year's rookie campaign.

- ▶ Through 65 games, Bailey is slashing .280/.356/.430 for a .786 OPS...he's tallied 11 doubles, seven homers, 30 RBI and 31 runs scored.
- ▶ Entering play today, Bailey's 2.6 fWAR is best on the team and fourth-best among Major League catchers, trailing only LAD's Will Smith (3.4), BAL's Adley Rutschman (2.8) and MIL's William Contreras (2.8).
- ▶ Defensively, his 11 defensive runs saved are second-most in the Majors behind SEA's Cal Raleigh (12)...in terms of pitch framing, Bailey's seven catcher framing runs are second-most behind NYY's Jose Trevino (eight)...his 52.1% strike rate is second-best behind CLE's Austin Hedges (53%).

MORE THAN JUST GAS: RHP Jordan Hicks starts this afternoon, his first start in over a week with the off day and the team slotting **LHP Blake Snell** back into the rotation.

- ▶ The former Blue Jay pitched last Wednesday (July 3) in Atlanta, allowing three runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings while striking out six...he's pitched 5.0 innings in three of his last six starts after logging at least 5.0 innings in 11 of his first 12 starts.
- ▶ He's thrown a career-high 90.2 innings and is making his 19th start of the season this afternoon.
- ▶ In nine starts at Oracle Park this year he's posted a 3.12 ERA (17er, 49.0ip) but the Giants have gone only 3-6 in the nine starts.

BIG GULP: OF Heliot Ramos, who was born in Humacao, PR but raised in Maunabo, PR, is the first Giants homegrown outfielder to be selected to an All-Star Game since **OF Chili Davis** in 1986.

- ▶ Ramos enters today slashing .301/.372/.530 for a .902 OPS with 11 doubles, 13 homers, 43 RBI and 27 runs scored in 56 games.
- ▶ His 13 homers and 43 RBI are tied for most on the team with **IF Matt Chapman**...his 2.3 fWAR is third-most on the team behind **C Patrick Bailey** (2.6) and Chapman (2.4).
- ▶ Since May 8, the 24-year-old ranks among the NL leaders in RBI (43, T-1st), home runs (13, T-4th), OPS (.902, 7th) and SLG% (.530, 8th).

SNACK RUN: OF Michael Conforto drove in two more runs yesterday and has driven in 15 runs in his last 16 games dating to June 22...Conforto is slashing .302/.392/.651 with 10 extra-base hits (seven doubles, one triple, two homers) in those 16 games since June 22.

COBBER DOBBER: RHP Alex Cobb made his third rehab start for Single-A San Jose yesterday, going 4.0 innings and allowing three runs on five hits...he walked one and struck out four while throwing 55 pitches (38 for strikes).

ORANGE AND BLACK: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million... he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

PUSH TO START: Has transitioned from a relief role into a traditional starting role this year...has made 26 career starts entering today, 18 of which have come this season...prior to this year, he had pitched 204 games out of the bullpen over parts of five Major League seasons...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

LAST OUTING: Suffered the loss in his last start on July 3 in Atlanta...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits and two walks with seven strikeouts in the Giants 3-1 loss to the Braves.

VS. TORONTO: Will face his former team for the first time since playing for them last season...posted a 2-3 record and was 4-for-4 in save opportunities in 25 games for the Blue Jays after being traded from the Cardinals at the deadline in 2023...has faced the Blue Jays four times in his career (one start), going 0-2 with a 16.50 ERA (11er, 6.0ip), allowing 10 hits and 11 walks...his only start against Toronto came on May 24, 2022 when he threw 3.0 innings and allowed four runs.

EARLY BIRD GETS THE WORM: Has pitched better in day games this year, posting a 3-1 record with a 2.96 ERA (15er, 45.2ip) in nine day game starts, compared to a 1-4 record with a 4.00 ERA (20er, 45.0ip) in nine night starts.

TRYING NOT TO SINK: Opponents have hit .438 (21-for-48) with just four strikeouts off his sinker in June and July...in April and May opponents combined to hit .277 (36-for-130) with 15 strikeouts off his sinker.

SPLIT SECOND: Opponents are hitting just .165 (14-for-85) with 33 strikeouts off his splitter...he's been using the pitch 21.9% of the time this year and it has been his best pitch at producing whiffs (40.3% rate)...last season he used his splitter just 1.6% of the time.

VIA THE LONGBALL: Has allowed eight home runs over his last 10 outings (1.51 HR/9.0)...prior to that, Hicks had allowed just one home run over his first eight starts (0.21 HR/9.0).

GET A GOOD REST: Has posted a 3.12 ERA over 10 games this year when pitching on five days of rest, compared to a 4.54 ERA over seven games when he pitches on four days of rest...Hicks will be pitching on seven days rest today...he's pitched on 6+ days of rest once this year and earned the win as he threw 5.0-scoreless innings, allowing three hits with six strikeouts.

PITCH COUNT: Has already thrown 1,576 pitches in a career-high 90.2 innings of work overall this season, which is more than 200 more pitches than his previous highest pitch total for the year of 1,274 in 2018 with St. Louis (77.2ip).

HIGH-FIVE: Hicks has pitched 5.0+ innings in 14 of his 18 starts this season...however, he hasn't reached the 5th inning in three of his last six outings.

FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league...he has thrown 5,676 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 clocked at over 100 mph (29.6%)...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

DIABETIC PHENOM: Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself...Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.

- ▶ Is 17-for-20 in save opportunities.
- ▶ Over his past eight outings, he's 1-0-5 with a 1.13 ERA (1er, 8.0ip), five hits (.185 avg), two walks and 12 strikeouts.
