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THE TWINS: Have gone 3-5 through eight games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Seattle, 1-2 at Kansas City and 1-1 at Milwaukee...today, they will complete the trip with the three-game series finale against the Brewers...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Orioles (Monday-Wednesday), three against the Phillies (Thursday at Field of Dreams, then Saturday-Sunday at Target Field) and three against the Braves (August 17-19).
⚡ Twins have gone 12-8 in rubber games this season...they are 8-3 in their last 11 rubber game chances...they lost their last rubber match on August 2 at Seattle.

OFF WISCONSIN: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night in Milwaukee by a score of 4-3...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Bradley (7), Travis Adams (3), Kody Funderburk (3) and Jeff Hoffman (1) combined to strike out 14 Brewers...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Royce Lewis, who hit a two-run double in the second inning...Kaelen Culpepper reached three times, walking once and getting hit by two pitches.

THIS ONE IS FOR ALL THE MOLITORS: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the sixth and final time this season...these two teams will meet six times in 2027, three at American Family Field from July 16-18 and three at Target Field from September 10-12 — both over the weekend.

⚡ Since 2020, the Twins have hit 45 home runs in 35 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent.

⚡ Over his last 21 games vs. Milwaukee, Josh Bell is hitting .375 (27-for-72) with three doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .452 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.077 OPS...Bell's 87 career hits vs. the Brewers are his second-most vs. any opponent (Cincinnati - 99)...his 110 career games are his personal most.

⚡ In nine career games at American Family Field, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.050 OPS.

GIMME A BELL YEAH: Josh Bell is hitting .338 (22-for-65) with a .970 OPS in his last 16 road games...below are Bell's overall number comparisons from Opening Day through May 31 and since June 1:

⚡ He has 68 RBI on the season, the 10th-most in the AL.

⚡ He is on pace to record 93 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 - 2019)...the last Twin to drive in 90 in a season was Jorge Polanco with 98 in 2021.

⚡ Twins are 30-13 when Bell drives in at least one run and 13-4 when he drives in at least two.

SERIES ISSUES: With a win today, the Twins will earn their 19th series victory of the season...they have gone 18-17-2 in series play, 11-5-1 at home and 7-12-1 on the road.

⚡ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 10-4-1 their last 15 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.

⚡ Twins have gone 4-3-1 in series play on the road over their last seven chances, but 0-3-1 in their last four...their last road series win was July 3-5 at Yankee Stadium.

⚡ Twins last series win over the Brewers was May 16-18, 2025, taking two of three in Wisconsin...they haven't won a series in Milwaukee in consecutive seasons since 2020 and 2021.

KEAS TO EVERY CITY: Luke Keaschall has hit safely in nine-straight road games and in 16 of his last 17 away games...below are his home and road comparisons this season:

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis has hit safely in a career-long 13-straight games...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Brooks Lee's 19-gamer in 2025...Lewis' streak is the longest active streak in baseball...during the streak, Lewis is hitting .380 (19-for-50) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.104 OPS...in those 13 games (since July 25), among players with a minimum of 30 plate appearances, he leads baseball in average exit velocity (96.0 mph).

⚡ Additionally, he has reached safely via hit or walk in a career-high 19-straight games...Ryan Jeffers' 23-game on-base streak (May 7-August 2) is the longest for Minnesota this season.
⚡ Lewis' OPS by month: March/April - .666 // May - .318 // June - .841 // July - .722 // August - 1.304

⚡ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 25 plate appearances this month, Lewis ranks second in batting average (.464), third in OPS (1.304) and fifth in slugging percentage (.821).

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP: Over their last 15 games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 3.02 ERA (50.2 IP, 17 ER) with 26 walks, 55 strikeouts (9.8 K/9.0 IP) and a .220 opponent batting average. Since the trade deadline on August 3, Twins relievers have struck out 20 of 62 batters faced (32.3%)...in that same span, they have held opponents to a .205 batting average with one home run (Massey off Minter on Wednesday).

⚡ Pen ERA by month: March/April - 5.15 // May - 4.40 // June - 6.94 // July - 2.86 // August - 4.22

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Ryan Gallagher and outfielder Walker Jenkins as their minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week. Gallagher, 23, made the start on Wednesday vs. Louisville, allowing one run on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and a season-high nine strikeouts...Gallagher was acquired by the Twins from Chicago-NL at the 2025 trade deadline, in exchange for Willi Castro.

⚡ Jenkins, 21, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .357 (10-for-28) with one double, one triple, two home runs and two RBI, including his first professional two-homer game on Thursday vs. Louisville...the 2023 fifth overall pick is the club's No. 1 prospect and 14th in baseball (MLB.com).
