**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles defeated the Tigers, 7-1, securing back-to-back wins for the first time since September 1-3 (3 G)...The O's totaled five home runs last night, their most since September 9, 2023 at Boston (also 5)...**Corbin Burnes** earned his career-high 15<sup>th</sup> win of the season after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings on three hits and three walks with eight strikeouts.

- Colton Cowser and James McCann both went yard twice last night, marking the first game in which two Orioles hit multiple homers since June 19, 2021 vs. Toronto (Ryan Mountcastle and Cedric Mullins).
- Anthony Santander blasted his 43<sup>rd</sup> home run of the season in the first inning...Homered in back-to-back plate appearances after his walk-off home run yesterday.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** Baltimore can clinch a Postseason spot today with a win and a loss by Seattle...The club holds the top AL Wild Card spot ahead of the Royals (+4.0 games) and Twins (+5.0 games)...The Orioles have the head-to-head tiebreaker with Kansas City (4-2) and need to win one of the final three matchups with Minnesota (3-0) to end the season from September 27-29 to clinch that tiebreaker...The O's have lost five of their last eight and eight of 12 to fall 4.0 games behind the Yankees in the AL East...The Birds are 33-37 (.471) since July 1, 28-30 (.483) since the All-Star break, and 21-24 (.467) since August 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 187-129 (.592), the best record in the AL and tied for the second-best winning percentage in MLB with the Braves, behind the Dodgers (.608, 192-124) during that time.

- New York leads the division at 90-64 (.584); an AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since 2015-17; Boston won the division in 2017 and 2016 with a 93-69 (.574) record.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles currently lead MLB with 224 home runs, one ahead of the Yankees (223)...The Dodgers (220) rank third...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 85 home runs since, good for 12<sup>th</sup> in MLB...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13<sup>th</sup> time in team history and this year marks the most by the club since 2017 (232).

- Baltimore has nine players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB this season: **Anthony Santander** (43), **Gunnar Henderson** (37), **Colton Cowser** (22), **Adley Rutschman** (19), **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Cedric Mullins** (15), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (13), and **Ramón Urias** (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (53) and Juan Soto (40); the O's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

- The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (14); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 for the club in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shortstop (11<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1998-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60)...He passed **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004), who held the O's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season...With three more long balls, he would be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with **Brady Anderson** (50 HR, 21 SB) in 1996.

- He was voted the 2024 Most Valuable Oriole by members of the local media.
- He was named the AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; Henderson slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.

Henderson's 115 runs scored are third in the AL and fifth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since **Roberto Alomar** set the club record with 132 in 1996; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

- He's on pace to score 121 times; Alomar, **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.
- He ranks third in the AL and MLB with 8.0 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have ended a season with at least 7.0 fWAR and four O's (six occurrences) have finished with an 8.0 fWAR.

Henderson has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996.

**MASHED TATERS:** **Anthony Santander** is the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

- He's one RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is **Bobby Bonilla** (116) in 1996.
- Santander has hit 34 home runs since the start of June, four behind Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani for the most in MLB during that time; his 43 home runs rank third in MLB behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge (53) and Ohtani (52).

His 104 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and are second in the AL, behind only Judge (152).

- He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

**HOLY COWSER:** **Colton Cowser** leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 22 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (24)...He's the 10<sup>th</sup> rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser is first in the AL and tied for second in MLB with 3.9 fWAR with Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (5.0)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1<sup>st</sup>, 74), total bases (1<sup>st</sup>, 211), extra-base hits (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 48), walks (2<sup>nd</sup>, 50), RBI (3<sup>rd</sup>, 64), doubles (3<sup>rd</sup>, 23), OPS (3<sup>rd</sup>, .774), and slugging percentage (3<sup>rd</sup>, .448).

- His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

**THE FINAL HOMESTAND:** Baltimore's final homestand of the regular season began on Tuesday with the first of three games against the Giants through Thursday...The home schedule concludes with three games against the Tigers, which began last night...The Birds are 44-35 (.557) at Camden Yards this season, but 15-18 (.455) at Oriole Park since the beginning of July...The Orioles are 93-67 (.581) at home since 2023.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** The Orioles and Tigers began their second and final series of the year last night at Oriole Park...The two teams faced off for three games in Detroit last weekend, with the Tigers taking two of three and winning the series...The O's won the season series against Detroit in 2023, going 6-1, including a three-game sweep in Baltimore from April 21-23...The 6-1 record last season marked Baltimore's first time winning more than five games in a single season against Detroit since the 2004 club swept the six-game season series...The Birds went 3-1 at Comerica Park in 2023 after going 5-12 in 17 games from 2017-2022...Detroit currently sits 1.0 game back of the final AL Wild Card spot and 6.0 games behind the Orioles.

**DOCUMENT IT:** A documentary focused on the city of Baltimore and the Orioles to air on a streaming network or digital carrier in Spring of 2025...The story of the city coming back from an economic and human catastrophe (the Key Bridge collapse), while a new ownership group and President usher in the next chapter of Oriole excellence...A team that has long been part of the city's DNA and mirrors its resilience...Interwoven are stories from our neighborhoods, our fans, and our schools (starting with Harlem Park Elementary, which the Orioles have adopted)...All combining to tell the riveting story of a City, State, and Major League team making a run for a Championship.

- The project is being filmed and produced by Mike Tollin Productions; creator of projects such as "The Last Dance", "The Captain", and "Justice USA", Mike Tollin Productions is the nation's premier production house for sports documentaries and storytelling.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The O's selected the contract of outfielder **Daniel Johnson** from Triple-A Norfolk today and optioned infielder **Coby Mayo** to Triple-A Norfolk after yesterday's game...The Orioles' 40-man roster currently has 39 players.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 15<sup>th</sup> career start this afternoon against the Tigers...Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk on August 20 before appearing in a game after Zach Eflin landed on the 15-day IL; marks his third stint with the Orioles this season; also served as the 27<sup>th</sup> man for the doubleheader against Toronto on July 29...Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his Major League debut this season and fourth Oriole overall, joining INF Jackson Holliday, C David Bañuelos, and INF/OF Connor Norby...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL; is the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, joining Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12 vs. Atlanta, he became the 11<sup>th</sup> Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP); at 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23y, 249d) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24y, 144d) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martinez (24y, 81d) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nuñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was dealt his second consecutive loss on September 15 at Detroit after allowing two runs on two hits (1 HR) and two walks with eight strikeouts; allowed a two-run homer to Riley Greene in the third inning... Received zero runs of support for the third time this year; has received two or fewer runs of support in seven of his last nine starts...Since being recalled on August 20, has a 5.68 ERA (16 ER/25.1 IP) and allowed five home runs...Threw 89 pitches, 57 strikes.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS AND THE AL CENTRAL:** Slated to make his second career start against Detroit in as many games...Has gone 1-2 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) in three starts against the AL Central...Notched career highs in innings (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in his September 3 start vs. Chicago-AL.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Is 2-4 with a 3.60 ERA (18 ER/45.0 IP) and six home runs allowed in eight starts at Oriole Park compared to 0-5 with a 9.75 ERA (26 ER/24.0 IP) with six homers in six road starts.

**STEP INTO THE DAYLIGHT:** Making his fifth career day start...Has gone 0-4 with a 10.91 ERA (19 ER/15.2 IP) in four afternoon starts compared to 2-5 with a 4.22 ERA (25 ER/53.1 IP) in his 10 night outings.

**HIGH TIDE:** Has gone 6-1 with a 3.48 ERA (30 ER/77.2 IP), a 1.11 WHIP, and 89 strikeouts against 27 walks across 15 outings (14 GS) for the Tides this year... When Povich was first promoted, he ranked among International League leaders in strikeouts (2<sup>nd</sup>), opponent average (3<sup>rd</sup>, .203), ERA (4<sup>th</sup>), WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>, 1.11), and wins (T-4<sup>th</sup>); only trailed teammate RHP Chayce McDermott (82) in strikeouts...At the time, his 75 strikeouts were tied for fifth among all minor league pitchers.

**FOREVER YOUNG:** At 24 years, 162 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the fourth-youngest player overall behind Livan Soto (24y, 91d), Gunnar Henderson (23y, 84d), and Jackson Holliday (20y, 292d).

**FLOWERS, NOT SHOWERS:** Named the International League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and a league-best 40 strikeouts in five starts...Also named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month after leading O's minor leaguers (min. 20 IP) in ERA, WHIP, and strikeouts... Named International League Pitcher of the Week for April 1-7 after going 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP), three hits, three walks, and 14 strikeouts in two starts at Charlotte during the week.
