RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their final homestand before the All-Star Break with the second game of a three-game series with the Washington Nationals tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Atlanta Braves visit St. Louis this weekend for a three-game series ... After a 2-hour and 19-minute rain delay last night, the Cardinals enjoyed a comeback 4-2 win over Washington, highlighted by home runs from Brendan Donovan and Lars Nootbaar.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 5.5 games behind first place Chicago and 3.0 games behind Milwaukee ... St. Louis is 1.5 games behind San Francisco for the 3rd Wild Card position.

NATIONAL NEWS: Since relocating from Montreal to the Nation's Capital and re-branding as the Nationals in 2005, the Cardinals .598 win pct. (77-51) against "Natitude" is the 2nd-highest in MLB among annual opponents behind the Dodgers (77-44, .636) ... The Cardinals current fivegame win streak over D.C. (July 28, 2024-present) is the club's longest since winning eight straight from Sept. 30, 2012-April 17, 2014.

GIMME A BREAK: The Cardinals are scheduled to play 97 games this season before the All-Star break, tied for the most in franchise history with the 1969 Cardinals (49-48 record) from April 8-July 19.

RETURN OF THE MACK: In 15 career plate appearances against MacKenzie Gore, Willson Contreras is slashing .615/.667/1.000 (8-13) with a home run and two doubles ... Nolan Arenado is 4-for-9 (.444) with a homer and a double ... Lars Nootbaar (1-for-2) and Masyn Winn (3-for-8) also have homered off Gore in their careers.

NOOT NEWS: Lars Nootbaar belted his team-leading 12th home run of the season last night, matching his total from 2024 and two shy of his single-season highs in both 2022 and 2023.

- · Lars has now homered in three consecutive home games (June 23-present) ... The last Cardinal to homer in four home games in a row was Ryan Ludwick - five consecutive from Aug. 1-6, 2008.
- St. Louis is 11-1 (.917) in games this season when 'Noot goes yard, 5th-best team winning pct. among players with 10+ homers behind Houston's Christian Walker (12-0, 1.000), New York's Francisco Lindor (15-1, .938), Boston's Trevor Story (13-1, .929), and Toronto's George Springer (12-1, .923). - Elias

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals hold the 5th selection in the 2025 MLB Draft, which takes place from the Coca-Cola Roxy in The Battery Atlanta (July 13-14) ... Day One features the first 105 selections (Rounds 1-3) and begins at 5:00 p.m. CT on ESPN and MLB Network ... Day Two on Monday includes Rounds 4-20 and begins at 10:30 a.m. CT.

. St. Louis has 21 overall selections over the two-day period, including four picks on Day One: #5 (1st round), #55 (2nd round), #72 (Competitive Balance Round B), and #89 (3rd round).

TONIGHT'S GAME.

- Making his 18th start of the season tonight (48th career). It's his 156th career appearance. His 18th start is 2 shy of his career-high of 20 in 2024.
- His 1.00 ERA over his last three starts ranks 2nd-lowest in the NL since June 20 behind only Zack Wheeler (0.32) of the Phillies. Enters tonight's game leading all National League pitchers in Ground Balls, Ground Ball Pct. and Ground Ball/Fly Ball ratio,
- trailing only Jose Soriano (LAA) in each category for MLB lead.
- St. Louis is 8-1 in starts in which Pallante has received 2 or more runs of support, with the lone loss coming in his 6/3 start vs. KC, a 10-7 Cardinals defeat.
- The Cardinals are 9-8 in his 17 games started this season.
- Cardinals have been shutout in his last two starts (1-0 at PIT on July 1 & 3-0 vs. CHI on June 26).
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 26, 2024, he leads the starters in ERA (3.81) and ranks 2nd in wins (13) in his 37 starts behind Sonny Gray (15 & 3.90).
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, has the best ground ball percentage (65.7%) in MLB (min. 150 appearances).
- Pallante's 62.3 groundball pct. as a starting pitcher (260.0 IP) is 5th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 250.0 IP as starter).
- Has allowed home runs in 10-of-17 starts this season and his 12 HR's allowed have passed his total (8) for all of last season.
- Has had 27 total chances in the field, ranking 5th in MLB among all pitchers.
- Is 16-14 as a starting pitcher in his 47 career starts (260.0 IP) with a 3.84 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT: Received a no decision in a 1-0 Cardinals loss at Pittsburgh as he exited after 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball, his lowest hit total in a start in his career. Ran his scoreless inning streak vs. PIT to 17.0 innings.

2025 NOTES:

- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-2025). •
- The Cardinals are 9-8 in his games started.
- His 2.28 run support average in April was MLB's 6th-lowest & 2nd among Cards starters to Miles Mikolas (1.90 3rd in MLB) for the month.
- Received a no decision at PIT (7/1) despite firing 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball in a game the Cardinals lost 1-0 on an 8th inning run. Yielded a pair of singles over 6.0+ shutout frames in 6-1 win over the Reds on 6/20; exited with a runner on first in the 7th inning and St. Louis
- leading 1-0. Improved to 6-2 over the Reds in his career. Allowed a pair of runs over a season-high 7.1 innings for 4-2 win over Washington at Nationals Park on 5/10. Also fanned a season-best seven
- while walking none. Yielded 2-run HR to Dylan Crews as his final batter faced in the 7th inning
- Suffered his 1st loss of the season on 4/17 at NYM; threw a season-high 95 pitches over 6.0 IP with all 4 of his runs allowed in the 4-1 defeat coming in the Mets 2nd inning
- Improved his record to 2-0 in a combined 2-0 shutout win over the Philadelphia Phillies 4/11 at Busch Stadium, allowing just 2 hits in his 7.0 IP (93 pitches). After an injury to Masyn Winn, catcher Pedro Pages played 4 innings (2nd thru 5th) of that game at 2nd base.

CAREER NOTES:

- Utilized as a hybrid pitcher during his 2022 rookie season with 47 appearances and 10 starts. Led the Cardinals with 62 relief appearances in 2023. Began the 2024 season in the bullpen, was optioned on April 21, and returned to the rotation on May 26 finishing the season with 20 starts as one of the Cardinals most effective starters.
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii. Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Graduated from San Clemente High School that also produced Cardinals 2021 1st round pick RHP Michael McGreevy and Braves 2015 1st round pick Kolby Allard.

PALLANTE VS. WASHINGTON:

- Is career 2-1 with a 5.40 ERA (18.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in 6 appearances (2 starts) vs. the Nationals.
- Has outstanding start/relief splits going 2-0 with a 1.17 ERA in two starts covering 15.1 innings and 0-1 with a 27.00 ERA in four relief appearances over 3.0 innings.
- His two starts vs. WSH are the two longest starts of his career (8.0 IP 7/31/22 & 7.1 IP 5/10/25).
- Has allowed runs in all four of his relief outings vs. Washington (7.36 ERA).

LAST START VS. NATIONALS: 5/10/25 at WSH (W, 4-2; 7.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 7 K - 91 pitches) Tossed a 2025 season-high 7.1 innings in a 4-2 win at Nationals Park. Matched his season-high with seven strikeouts and vacated after his 15.0-innings scoreless streak was snapped on a Dylan Crews home run..
