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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game homestand tonight against Los Angeles-AL (1-0, 2 to play) after losing two of three to Philadelphia over the weekend...The Orioles have won 16 of 26 games since the beginning of July and are 1.5 games back in the AL Wild Card.

🦅 **Christian Franklin** made his MLB debut yesterday, going 0-for-2 with a walk, a run scored, and a stolen base...He's the fifth Oriole in team history (since 1954) to steal a base in his major league debut, joining Bernie Castro (9/1/05 at TOR), Luis Matos (6/19/00 at OAK), Curtis Goodwin (6/2/95 vs. OAK), and Jim Marshall (4/15/58 vs. WSH)...Franklin is the first position player to make his debut with the Orioles since **Samuel Basallo** on August 17, 2025 and the fourth Oriole to make his MLB debut this season, joining right-handed pitchers **Cameron Foster** (4/16 at CLE), **Trey Gibson** (5/3 at NYY), and **Anthony Nunez** (3/28 vs. MIN).

🦅 **Tyler O'Neill** hit a pinch-hit home run in the eighth inning last night, his third such homer of the year...The three pinch-hit homers tie the franchise record (since 1954), matching Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962)...O'Neill is the fifth player in the majors this year with at least three pinch-hit home runs, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and CWS/PHI's Derek Hill (all 3).

🦅 **Cade Povich** tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with a season-high seven strikeouts yesterday in his first MLB start since May 7...He picked off two baserunners, the first Oriole hurler to do so since Brian Matusz on April 8, 2010 at Tampa Bay.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles activated right-handed pitcher **Alex Hoppe** and optioned righty **Anthony Nunez** to Triple-A Norfolk after yesterday's game...Hoppe was one of three pitchers acquired from the Mariners for outfielder **Taylor Ward** on Monday.

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 26 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (21) and Braves and Mets (both 20)...The O's are one of nine teams in the majors this year with at least four pinch-hit home runs, led by the Marlins, Nationals, Tigers, and White Sox (all 6).

🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season while **Samuel Basallo**, **Colton Cowser**, **Christian Encarnacion-Strand**, **Jackson Holliday**, and **Tyler O'Neill**, are all tied for second with two pinch-hit RBI each.

🦅 The 26 pinch-hit RBI are the most by the Orioles since 1991 (30)...The team record is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

HONEST TO PETE: Pete Alonso ranks fourth in the AL and tied for 11th in the majors with 71 RBI...He drove in two runs last night and has four RBI in the last four games after knocking in three runs in 13 games from July 12-29.

🦅 He's slashing .276/.371/.496 (70-for-254) with 11 doubles, 15 homers, 41 runs, 48 RBI, and 35 walks in 68 games since May 16...During that time, he is tied for third in the AL in RBI and is tied for sixth in the AL in home runs.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 104 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Tigers (39 G).

🦅 Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025...The current 104-game stretch is tied for the second-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954) with 1975, trailing a 112-game run in 1995.

🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 437 walks.

MAKING A CASE FOR GOLD: **Colton Cowser** leads all Orioles defenders with eight outs above average (OAA) and is tied for the team lead with five defensive runs saved (DRS).

🦅 His eight OAA are tied for third among all AL outfielders with TEX's Evan Carter and TB's Cedric Mullins, behind BOS' Ceddanne Rafaela (13) and CWS' Tristan Peters (9)...Cowser accrued 0 OAA in 2025 after having a career-high 11 OAA in 2024.

🦅 **Pete Alonso** owns a career-high five OAA after posting -9 OAA in each of his last two seasons...The five OAA are tied for second among MLB first basemen with COL's TJ Rumfield, trailing SD's Ty France (6).

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.65 ERA in 62 games since May 24, the fifth-lowest mark in MLB behind the Tigers (3.22), Red Sox (3.36), Yankees (3.36), and Brewers (3.63)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

🦅 The rotation has posted a 3.74 ERA since May 24, the third-best starter ERA in the AL during that time behind the Tigers (2.90) and Red Sox (3.71)...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

🦅 Orioles relievers have a 3.20 ERA since June 16, sixth lowest in the majors behind the Red Sox (2.62), Astros (2.68), Yankees (2.81), Rays (2.99), and White Sox (3.16)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 21st start of the season and 123rd of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on July 29 at Detroit after tossing 6.0 innings, allowing seven runs (4 ER) on eight hits with zero walks and six strikeouts...Threw 94 pitches, 69 strikes.
⚡ Has not permitted a walk in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.
⚡ Has stuck out 6+ batters in three straight starts for the first time since September 6-19, 2025...He last did so in four straight during a five-start stretch from August 1-24, 2025.

LA LA LAND: Rogers is set to make his second career start against the Angels...Took the loss on July 6, 2022 after tossing 4.2 innings, allowing three runs on four hits, two walks, and two hit batters with five strikeouts.
⚡ Over his last nine starts against AL West opponents since June 21, 2024, Rogers is 3-0 with a 2.21 ERA (14 ER/57.0 IP).

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT: Over his last eight starts since June 14, Rogers is 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA (11 ER/49.2 IP), .214 (39-for-182) opponent average, and 1.03 WHIP.
⚡ Among all MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 45.0 innings since June 14, his 1.99 ERA is fifth lowest behind DET's Troy Melton (0.93), SD's Robbie Ray (1.09), CWS' Sean Burke (1.42), and TOR's Dylan Cease (1.75).
⚡ He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

SUPPORT WELCOMED: Rogers has received three runs of support or fewer in eight of his last nine outings (20 runs total), including one run in four of the outings.
⚡ He received 32 runs of support over his first 11 starts of 2026, including a season-high-tying eight runs on April 1 vs. Texas and June 4 at Boston.

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In seven starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 23.7 percent strikeout rate and 26.1 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.
⚡ During his most recent seven-start stretch, he owns a 26.6 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 28.3 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past seven starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .146 (7-for-48) clip with three doubles and 17 strikeouts.
⚡ Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.
⚡ Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.

PINPOINT: On July 24 vs. Atlanta, Rogers' 81.8 percent strike rate (72-of-88) marked the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of MIL's Jacob Misiorowski on August 2 at Los Angeles-AL (79.5%, 66-of-83).
⚡ Under the same parameter, it was the highest strike rate by an Oriole pitcher in the pitch tracking era (since 2008), ahead of Kevin Gausman's 80.4 percent clip (86-of-107) on May 11, 2018 vs. Tampa Bay.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .293/.353/.400 (41-for-140) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 29 RBI off Rogers with two outs.
⚡ Over his last 10 starts since June 4, however, he has limited the opposition to a .200/.263/.271 (14-for-70) line with two outs after they slashed .386/.442/.529 (27-for-70) over his first 10 outings.
⚡ Overall, opponents are slashing .408/.482/.612 (20-for-49) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.
