TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Astros will square off for the first time this season tonight in the opener of a three-game series.

- ▶ Despite dropping each of their last two home games, the Giants have still won seven of their last 11 games at Oracle Park dating to July 11 and are 14-9 (.609) in their last 23 home games dating to June 14, outscoring their opponents 102-82 (+20) in that stretch.
- ▶ SF's 14-9 record at home since June 14 is eighth-best in the Majors and sixth-best in the National League...the Giants are currently in a stretch where they play 13 of 19 games here on the Shores of McCovey Cove (Aug. 7-29).
- ▶ The Giants enter this series at 49-69 (.415), a season-low 20 games below .500 and the fifth-worst mark in MLB...their 69 losses through the first 118 games this season are the Giants' most since losing 71 of 118 in 2017.

ASTRO-NOMICAL: The Giants swept the three-game season series against the Astros last season and have won seven of the last nine meetings (.778) going back to 2023...it marks San Francisco's best record against a single opponent since the start of 2023.

- ▶ SF has also won each of its last two home series against the Asrtros (2024 and 2021).

SHARP AS A BLADE: **RHP Blade Tidwell** is slated to make his second career start with the Giants after being recalled after the trade deadline and will mark his 10th appearance overall with SF this season...he has a 3.18 ERA (6er, 17.0ip) in nine games.

- ▶ Did not factor into the decision in his last start against the Rangers on August 4...threw a career-high 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits and one walk with three strikeouts on 100 pitches...it marked his first Major League start since June 20, 2025 at PHI with the New York Mets.
- ▶ In his last start, his most used pitch was his sweeper (threw 31% of the time), and it was effective, as hitters were just 2-for-9 against it (SIS).
- ▶ Tidwell has been much better in his limited sample against righties than lefties this year...righties are just 5-for-31 (.161 BA) with nine Ks, while lefties are 11-for-33 with just four Ks, including 6-for-15 against his 4-seamer (SIS).

THE LONGBALL: San Francisco's pitching staff has not allowed a home run in six straight home games, one game away from tying MLB's longest stretch this season, set by the Giants in April...the last time the Giants had two streaks of seven or more games in the same season was 1980 (STATS, LLC).

ON THE PRECIPICE: **IF Willy Adames** is on milestone watch after hitting his 199th career home run Friday night and his 19th this season...his next homer would make him the first Giant to reach the 20-homer mark as a shortstop in multiple seasons since **Brandon Crawford** (24 in 2021 and 21 in 2015), and the first to do it in two straight seasons since **Rich Aurilia** (37 homers in 2001, 20 homers in 2000).

- ▶ His next home run would mark his sixth straight 20-homer season in the Majors overall (2021-present)...only four shortstops in MLB history have recorded six-or-more straight 20-HR seasons: Cal Ripken Jr., BAL, 10 from 1982-1991; Miguel Tejada, OAK-BAL, 8 from 1999-2006; Alex Rodriguez, SEA-TEX, 8 from 1996-2003 and Ernie Banks, CHC, 7 from 1955-1961 (STATS, LLC).
- ▶ Throughout his career, the infielder has found a lot of success playing in the month of August, his best single month by a wide margin...in 216 career games in August, Adames has a .828 OPS with 48 homers, 122 RBI and 32 doubles.

NEW GIANT FACES: The Giants' have had nine players make their Major League debuts this season; **RHP Trent Harris**, **IF Nate Furman** and **IF/OF Eddys Leonard** all made their debuts following the trade deadline...**OF Victor Bericoto**, **C Drew Cavanaugh**, **OF Jonah Cox**, **RHP Wilkin Ramos**, **C/IF/OF Jesús Rodríguez** and **C Daniel Susac** all made their debuts earlier this year.

- ▶ SF's nine debuts are tied for most in the National League with Colorado.

BALL ME BLADE: Tidwell is in his second season in the Majors, first with the Giants after being acquired from New York-NL at last year's trade deadline as part of the return for reliever **Tyler Rogers**...the Giants also acquired **OF Drew Gilbert** and **RHP José Buttó**...Tidwell ranks as the Giants' No. 13 prospect per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Was recalled for the second time this year on August 3 and made his first start of the year the following day...did not factor into the decision in the Giants 5-4 loss to the Rangers in Texas on August 4...threw a career-high 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits and one walk with three strikeouts...it marked his first Major League start since June 20, 2025 at PHI with the New York Mets.

100 PITCHES: Threw 100 pitches in his first start with the Giants on August 4...Tidwell became the first Giant with 100 pitches in his debut start with the team since **RHP Chris Stratton** in 2017...the last Giant to do it in their first two starts with the team was **LHP Matt Moore** in 2016...the only other MLB pitcher with 100 pitches in their debut start for a team this season was Chris Bassitt with the Orioles (*STATS, LLC*).

VS. HOUSTON: Is facing the Astros for the first time in his career.

WITH THE GIANTS: Pitched eight games for the Giants out of the bullpen in April, logging a 3.00 ERA (4er, 12.0ip), 10 strikeouts and a 1.08 WHIP before being optioned back to Triple-A to get stretched out as a starter.

WITH THE RIVER CATS: Tidwell went 2-3 with a 4.38 ERA (35er, 72.0ip), 78 strikeouts and a 1.46 WHIP in 16 starts (15 games) with Triple-A Sacramento this season...his 78 strikeouts are second-most on the River Cats this season behind 90 by **LHP Carson Whisenhunt**.

SWEEP THE LEG: His sweeper has been his most used pitch in the Majors (37.2%)...opponents are hitting .321 (9x28) with six strikeouts vs. his sweeper in the Majors, yet hit .208 (16x77) with 33 strikeouts in the Minors.

HEY BUDDY: Tidwell, **OF Drew Gilbert**, Manager **Tony Vitello**, Director of ML Pitching **Frank Anderson** and Director of Performance **Quentin Eberhardt** were all together at the University of Tennessee...Tidwell is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.

RIGHT ON: Has held righties to just five hits in 31 at-bats (.161 average) compared to a .333 mark (11x33) against lefties...left-handers were 5-for-12 off him in his last start and are 8-for-their-last-18 off him dating back to April.

HOME SWEET HOME: In eight home starts for the River Cats, Tidwell went 2-2 with a 2.82 ERA (12er, 38.1ip) compared to a 6.11 ERA (19er, 28.0ip) in seven road games (six starts)...in the Majors, Tidwell did not allow a run in 7.0 innings at home while allowing six runs in 10.0 innings on the road.
