Jackson Chourio is currently leading the National League with 12 doubles..... only the Red Sox' Alex Bregman (13) has more two-baggers....the Royals' **Bobby Witt Jr.** also has 12 doubles.

#### All American

The Brewers will begin a stretch tomorrow during which they play 15 straight games vs. American League opponents.....the team is 82-45 (.646) since 2022 in Interleague Play, trailing only the Dodgers (80-38, .678).....this includes 8-7 this season.

TDDAY'S GAME: Is game 3 (0-2) of a 6-game homestand against Chicago-NL (0-2) and Houston (3g)....following an off day this coming Thursday, the team takes a 6-game trip to Tampa Bay (3g) and Cleveland (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS [47 days]: The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10\*, SECOND: 16, THIRD: 15, FOURTH: 3, FIFTH: 3....the Brewers are currently in third place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 5.0 games and second-place Reds by 2.0 games (\*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing their first game of the season).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 6-5-0 in series play, including this series. Game 1: 5-6, Game 2: 6-5, Game 3: 4-6, Game 4: 1-1 Sweep Wins [-]: None.....Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The Brewers are 9-6 at home, going 4-1-0 in series play, including this series.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 7-12 on the road, going 2-4-0 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

CDACHES: Returning from 2024 is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made four replay challenges this season, going 4-0.....their last challenge came on 4/30 at Chicago-AL as an out call on a force play at second base involving William Contreras was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 682 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons, missing out by a game in both 2017 and 2022.

SUMMARY: Are 224-221 all time, including 0-2 this season.....went 8-5 last season.....have not been swept by the Cubs since 8/2-8/4, 2019 at Wrigley Field (3g) and not at home since 10/2-10/4, 2015 (3a).

at MIL: Are 117-106 all time, going 106-99 at American Family Field and 11-7 at County Stadium....are 0-2 this season.....went 5-2 last season and are 33-19 over the last 52 games.

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 28, is going to be making his eighth start of the season.....Peralta last started on Tuesday at Chicago-AL and picked up a 7-2 victory (6ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 3bb, 5k, 2hr, 93 pitches).....the team is 4-3 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .196 (28-for-143, 5hr).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

FREDDY K-RUEGER: Peralta has 990 career strikeouts, trailing only Yovani Gallardo (1,226), Ben Sheets (1,206) and Teddy Higuera (1,081) on the all-time franchise list.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 11-9 with a 3.68 ERA in a career-high 32 starts last season.....the team went 19-13 in his starts.....he made 11 quality starts.....his 173.2 innings pitched marked a career high.....he was among National League leaders in K/9IP (5th, 10.36), H/9IP (5th, 7.41), strikeouts (6th, 200) and AVG (6th, .224).....he produced 200+ strikeouts (200) for the second time in his career and for the second straight season (210 in 2023), joining **Teddy Higuera** (2x), **Corbin Burnes** (3x) and **Yovani Gallardo** (4x) as the only pitchers in franchise history with multiple 200+ strikeout seasons.

CAREER: Is 56-38 with a 3.73 ERA and 1 save in 185 games/136 starts (793.2ip, 329er).....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-25).....has gone 48-36 with a 3.72 ERA as a starter (709.2ip, 293er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021.....was the Opening Day starter in 2024 and 2025.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 32-19 with a 3.43 ERA in 97 games/69 starts (420ip, 160er).....is 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA in 2 starts this season (13ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 24-19 with a 4.07 ERA in 88 games/67 starts (373.2ip, 169er)....is 2-2 with a 3.42 ERA in 5 starts this season (26.1ip, 10er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Peralta has gone 6-2 with a 3.16 ERA in 18 games/13 starts against the Cubs (77ip, 45h, 27r, 27er, 41bb, 109k, 8hr), including 1-1 with a 2.55 ERA in 3 starts last season (17.2ip, 8h, 5r, 5er, 10bb, 24k, 2hr).
