Sal Frelick last night made his first career appearance at third base....he played 67.0 innings (9 starts) at the position during Spring Training....his last appearance as an infielder prior to 2024 came at Lexington (MA) HS as a senior in 2018 (shortstop)....he never played third base at any level of baseball prior to this season.....at least that's what he told me.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame [1988-94] and Arizona State University [1995-2009].

CDACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made four replay challenges this season, going 4-0.....their last challenge came on 4/7 vs. Seattle as a caught stealing at second base involving Oliver Dunn was overturned.

TODAY'S STARTER: #46 - RHP BRYSE WILSON (5g, 0gs, 1-0, 5.19)

WILSON AT A GLANCE: Bryse Wilson, 26, will be making his sixth appearance and first start of the season.....Wilson last pitched last Wednesday at Cincinnati and earned the 7-2 win (3ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 1k, 1hr, 42 pitches).....he last started on 9/28/22 vs. Cincinnati as a member of the Pirates and received no decision in a 4-3, 10-inning victory (8ip, 3h, 0r, 1bb, 6k, 1hbp).....Wilson was acquired from Pittsburgh in exchange for cash on 1/4/23.

ARE YOU READY FOR SOME FOOTBALL?!: Bryse's younger brother, Payton, was a linebacker at North Carolina State University and is expected to be selected in the 2024 NFL Draft, which begins on Thursday, April 25 in Detroit, MI.

LAST SEASON: Wilson went 6-0 with a 2.58 ERA and 3 saves in 53 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA.....he pitched as a full-time reliever for the first time in his professional career.....he held opponents to a .211 batting average, marking a career best.

CAREER: Is 16-17 with a 4.82 ERA and 4 saves in 114 games/43 starts (317.2ip, 170er).....is in his seventh Major League season with Atlanta (2018-21), Pittsburgh (2021-22) and Milwaukee (2023-24).....is 9-16 with a 5.50 ERA as a starter (198ip, 121er) and 7-1 with a 3.69 ERA in relief (119.2ip, 49er).....Wilson was selected by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Orange (NC) High School.....he committed to the University of North Carolina prior to being drafted.....Wilson was traded by the Braves to the Pirates, along with RHP Ricky DeVito, in exchange for RHP Richard Rodríguez on 7/30/21.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-2 with a 3.51 ERA in 33 games/3 starts (59ip, 23er)....is 0-0 with a 4.15 ERA in 2 relief appearances this season (4.1ip, 2er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 8-11 with a 4.77 ERA in 54 games/22 starts (149ip, 79er).....is 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA in 3 relief appearances this season (4.1ip, 3er).
