#### We're Going National

With last night's win, the Brewers are now an even 2,261-2,261-1 all time as a member of the National League....the team joined the Senior Circuit in 1998 and was as many as 196 games under .500 on 8/30/16....prior to last night, the team had not been at .500 in the National League since it was 57-57 following play on 8/5/98....the Brewers look to climb above .500 all time in the NL today for the first time since 8/4/98 when they were 57-56.

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), RHP Joel Kuhnel (right shoulder), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy (413g, 246-167, .596) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**IN THE STANDINGS (103 days):** The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 65, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 6.5 games....the team has held first place for the last 49 days.

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 29-18 at home, going 10-4-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are a Major League-best 27-15 on the road, going 9-4-1 in series play....the team is 19-7 in its last 26 road games, including 7-1 in the last 8 contests....had season-high 5-game winning streaks from 5/31-6/8 and 6/21-7/3.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 24 replay challenges this season, going 16-8....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/1 vs. Cincinnati as a no blocking of the plate call was confirmed and an out call involving Garrett Mitchell stood.

**BREWING SUCCESS:** The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 819 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (913), Astros (851) and Yankees (838).

**MISIOROWSKI AT A GLANCE:** All-Star Jacob Misiorowski, 24, will make his 18th start of the season and second against the Cardinals.....he last started last Thursday vs. Cincinnati in a 7-2 loss (5ip, 5h, 5r, 1er, 0bb, 10k, 2hr, 82 pitches).....the team is 10-7 in his starts.....he has 11 quality starts.....opponents are batting .150 (54-for-361, 7hr).....he has 156 strikeouts in 104.0 innings (13.50 K/9IP).....he is 8-2 with a 0.63 ERA in his last 11 starts (71.1ip, 31h, 10r, 5er, 14bb, 105k, 3hr).....he was National League Player of the Week for 5/25-5/31 and 6/8-6/14 (co-winner).....Misiorowski was selected by Milwaukee in the second round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from Crowder (MO) College, where he pitched one season (2022) and became the highest drafted player in school history.....name is pronounced "miz-uh-RAO-skee."

**LAST SEASON:** Misiorowski made his Major League debut and went 5-3 with a 4.36 ERA in 15 games/14 starts.....the team went 9-5 in his starts.....he had 3 quality starts.....opponents batted .213 (51-for-239, 8hr).....he had 87 strikeouts in 66.0 innings (11.86 K/9IP).....Misiorowski was named an All-Star after just five games, the fewest in MLB history.....he was on the 15-day injured list from 8/3-8/14 with a left tibia contusion, retroactive to 7/31.....he went 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA in 2 games in the NLDS against the Cubs, both coming in relief (7ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 7k, 1hr).....he appeared in Game 3 of the NLCS against the Dodgers out of the bullpen and took the loss (5ip, 3h, 2r, 1er, 1bb, 9k).

**CAREER:** Is 14-7 with a 2.59 ERA in 32 games/31 starts with Milwaukee (170ip, 105h, 58r, 49er, 58bb, 243k, 15hr).....made his Major League debut last season.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 8-1 with a 2.27 ERA in 18 games/17 starts (99ip, 25er).....is 5-1 with a 1.59 ERA in 10 starts this season (62.1ip, 11er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 6-6 with a 3.04 ERA in 14 starts (71ip, 24er).....is 4-3 with a 1.30 ERA in 7 starts this season (41.2ip, 6er).

**CAREER vs. CARDINALS:** Is 2-1 with a 3.05 ERA in 4 starts (20.2ip, 14h, 7r, 7er, 9bb, 24k, 2hr), including a 5-1 win this season on 5/25 in Milwaukee (7ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 12k).

**ODDS & ENDS:** Misiorowski graduated from Grain Valley (MO) High School.....he got engaged to his fiancée, Elle, this past January and is scheduled to be married this coming winter.....he is a supporter of the Wisconsin Parkinson Association.....his father, Tom, was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease when Jacob was growing up.....Misiorowski enjoys hunting, fishing and collecting baseball and Pokémon cards.....he is a Kansas City Chiefs fan.

**GASSER AT A GLANCE:** Robert Gasser, 27, will be making his eighth start of the season and first against the Cardinals.....Gasser last started on 6/29 vs. Cincinnati and had no decision in a 5-3 win (5.2ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 96 pitches).....the team is 3-4 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .243 (33-for-136, 7hr).....he is 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA in 7 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (26.2ip, 27h, 12r, 10er, 8bb, 38k, 1hr).....Gasser was acquired from San Diego with three others on 8/1/22 as part of the trade for LHP Josh Hader.....he was selected by the Padres in Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Houston.....he also attended the University of New Mexico in addition to San Joaquin Delta College.

**LAST SEASON:** Gasser spent most of the season on the 60-day injured list as he recovered from "Tommy John" surgery.....he was reinstated on August 30 and optioned to Triple-A Nashville.....he went 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA in 10 games/6 starts with the Sounds (including his rehab assignment).....he was recalled by the Brewers on September 21 and made 2 starts, coming in losses on 9/21 at St. Louis and 9/27 vs. Cincinnati.....he also made 2 postseason appearances, both coming in relief.

**CAREER:** Is 3-5 with a 3.63 ERA in 14 starts, all with the Brewers (69.1ip, 66h, 34r, 28er, 18bb, 57k, 10hr).....he made his Major League debut in 2024.....Gasser underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 6/24/24, performed by Dr. Keith Meister.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 2-3 with a 2.38 ERA in 9 starts (45.1ip, 12er).....is 0-2 with a 3.48 ERA in 4 starts this season (20.2ip, 8er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 1-2 with a 6.00 ERA in 5 starts (24ip, 16er).....is 1-1 with a 6.00 ERA in 3 starts this season (15ip, 10er).
