METS NOTES



Mets: Swept a doubleheader from Philadelphia for the first time since September 24, 2011 at Citi Field...Authored their first shutout victory of the season and their first shutout of the Phillies since April 23, 2019 at Citi Field.

- Mets starting pitchers have thrown five quality starts through seven games... The rotation has posted a 2.43 ERA (11 earned runs/40.2 innings) this year.

Marcus Stroman (6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 K): Making his second start in three days, earned his second win of the season.

Brandon Nimmo (3-4, 3 RBI): Had his second three-hit game of the season... Lined a two-run single with the bases loaded in the fourth inning to extend the Mets' lead...Added another run with a sixth-inning RBI knock.

- Reached in five of his eight plate appearances in today's doubleheader... Owns a .581 OBP through the Mets' first seven games of the season.

Jonathan Villar (1-3, 2B, RBI): Gave the Mets the lead with an RBI double in the fourth inning...Drove in a go-ahead run in both ends of today's doubleheader.



PHILLIES NOTES



Phillies: Were shut out for the first time this season...Have been swept in each of their last two doubleheaders (also, September 22, 2020 at Washington)... Suffered their first doubleheader sweep at the hands of the Mets since September 24, 2011.

Didi Gregorius (1-3): Extended his season-opening hitting streak to 11 games, the longest of his career to begin a campaign.

Aaron Nola (5.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER, BB, 7 K): Has lost consecutive decisions to New York for the first time in his career...Is 4-3 with a 4.40 ERA (22 earned runs/45.0 innings) in eight starts at Citi Field, compared to a 4-0 record and 2.58 ERA (17 earned runs/59.1 innings) in 10 starts against the Mets at home.
