## NATIONALS NEWS

### SERIES BUSINESS

The Washington Nationals square off against the Pittsburgh Pirates in the rubber match of this three-game weekend series on Sunday afternoon...Washington has won five of its last six rubber matches.

- Washington is 35-28 (.556) since April 25, the sixth-best mark in Major League Baseball over this stretch and are 11-3-1 in their last 15 series since May 12.

### ROSTER MOVES

The Nationals announced the following roster moves:

- Selected the contract of right-handed pitcher **Eddy Yean** on Sunday...Yean, 25, leads Washington's system with nine saves...He went 2-1 with a 3.60 ERA, a .189 opponents' average and 45 strikeouts in 39 games (40.0 IP) with Triple-A Rochester.
- Optioned right-handed pitcher **Zak Kent** to Triple-A Rochester.
- Claimed left-handed pitcher **Matt Krook** off outright waivers from the Athletics.
- Designated right-handed pitcher **Andre Granillo** for assignment.
- Designated outfielder **Robert Hassell III** for assignment.

### ALL STARS!

Nationals shortstop **CJ Abrams** and outfielder **James Wood** will represent the organization in the 2026 Major League Baseball All-Star Game in Philadelphia on July 14...Abrams was voted in by the fans and will start at shortstop for the National League, while Wood was selected through player voting...Both players will make their second career All-Star appearance...See boxes to the right for a summary of their rankings this season.

### JIMMY LEADOFF

**James Wood** clubbed his seventh leadoff home run of the season on Saturday, the most in Major League Baseball ahead of **Shohei Ohtani** (6).

- Wood is 10-for-23 (.435) with two doubles, one triple, three homers, seven RBI, six walks and seven runs scored over his last six games...He's reached safely in 12 of his last 17 plate appearances (8 H, 4 BB).
- In addition to his league rankings found in the box to the right, Wood is the only player in the National League (1 of 2 in MLB) with at least 20 home runs and at least 10 stolen bases this season.

### HOMER HAPPY

The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 86 home runs since May 6, ahead of the Phillies (81) and the White Sox (77)...Washington leads in slugging (.462) and is second in OPS (.788) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 123 home runs this season, the second-most in MLB behind the New York Yankees (128) and the fourth-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 90 games behind the 2017 Nationals (130 HR), 2019 Nationals (125 HR) and 2016 Nationals (124 HR).

### LUIS! LUIS!

Reigning National League Player of the Week **Luis Garcia Jr.** ranks in the National League in slugging percentage (3rd, .533) and RBI (T4th, 62).

- He is 12-for-27 (.444) with three doubles, five homers, 13 RBI, two walks, just two strikeouts and seven runs scored in his last seven games.
- He has nine home runs in his last 14 games, the most in the National League (2nd in MLB) since June 19.
- Since May 24, **Garcia Jr.** leads MLB with 40 RBI and a .769 slugging percentage and ranks second with 15 home runs and third with a 1.124 OPS.

### PITCHING IN

Washington's starting rotation (regardless of opener) has pitched to a 2.29 ERA (17 ER/66.2 IP) over the last 13 games...They've combined for 72 strikeouts, just 11 walks and only seven home runs allowed.

- Foster Griffin** - who ranks ninth in the NL with a 2.87 season ERA - has allowed just two earned runs in 19.1 innings (0.93 ERA) with 20 strikeouts and three walks in two starts during this stretch.
- Cade Cavalli** has 20 strikeouts and just one walk to go along with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) in his last two starts.
- Andrew Alvarez** is 1-1 with 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts with four walks during this stretch.
- Zack Littell** has pitched to a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP) with 11 strikeouts and three walks in his last three starts.
- Miles Mikolas** has not issued a walk over his last two starts (10.1 IP).

### LILE'S PILE OF HITS

During his current four-game hitting streak, **Daylen Lile** is 8-for-17 (.471) with two doubles, two homers, four RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored...He's hit safely in five of his last seven (10-for-27, 3 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI).

- Lile ranks second on the club with 89 hits and his 33 extra-base hits are ninth among National League outfielders.

### ROLLIN' RUIZ

**Keibert Ruiz** leads Major League catchers (min. 125 PA) with a .333 batting average, a .924 OPS and is third with a .556 slugging percentage in 33 games since May 7.

- He's hitting .333 with 11 doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 22 runs since that date.
