CORBIN CARROLL STAR WARS BOBBLE: Saturday, August 9th's fan-favorite Star Wars Night @ Chase Field features a Corbin Carroll Rebel Pilot Bobble giveaway, courtesy of Cox, for the first 20,000 fans.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-2 @ Athletics last night to snap a season-high 6-game skid...collected 3+ homers in a game for the first time since July 9 @ Padres (4), 8+ walks since June 9 vs. Mariners (10) and 4+ stolen bases since May 16 vs. Rockies (4)...third time this season with 2+ homers and 8+ walks in a game (also: June 9 vs. Mariners and April 17 @ Marlins).

- **Ketel Marte** hit his first homer (solo in first) since July 23 vs. Astros...has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 games, including 3 multi-hit performances.
- **Corbin Carroll** hit his first homer (solo in ninth) since July 9 @ Padres...has reached base safely in 5 straight games (since July 28), batting .313 (5-for-16) with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 2 RBI, 4 walks and 1 stolen base.
- **Alek Thomas** hit his second homer in 4 games...has reached base safely in 4 straight games, batting .385 (5-for-13) with 2 homers, 2 RBI, 2 walks (2 K).
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has reached safely in 8 of his last 9 games (hits in 6 of those games) with 1 double, 3 RBI, 4 walks (2 K) and 1 stolen base.

FOR A SERIES: The D-backs look to win their third straight series vs. Athletics...last 2 series: won 2-1 from June 28-30, 2024 @ home; won 2-1 from May 15-17, 2023 on the road.

SNAKEBITES: **Connor Kaiser** makes his D-backs debut today and is playing his first MLB game since June 21, 2023 @ Reds while with the Rockies...has yet to collect his first Major League hit (3 G; 0-for-4, 0 BB, 2 K, 0 HBP).

- **Blaze Alexander** marks his 10th career game batting second in the lineup and first time since June 29, 2024 vs. Athletics...has reached base in 7 of those 10 games, including 5 of his last 6.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 4 straight games when batting third in the lineup, hitting .333 (4-for-12) with 1 homer, 3 RBI and 4 walks (0 K).

ON-BASE MACHINE: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 51 times on base since July 1 are the most in the NL and tied for third in MLB with Roman Anthony/BOS, behind Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (53) and Nick Kurtz/ATH (53).

- Has reached base in 24 of his 27 games since July 1, hitting .313 (30-for-96)/.432 OBP/.438 SLG/.870 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 18 walks (10 K).
- Is the third MLB player to have 18+ walks and 10 or fewer strikeouts in a 27-game span this season (also: Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR and Gleyber Torres/DET)...is the first D-back to reach the feat within a season since Conor Jackson from May 26-June 30, 2006 (18 BB, 10 K).

TRENDING BATS: **Corbin Carroll** has reached safely in 8 straight interleague matchups (July 21-23 vs. Astros and July 28-30 @ Tigers, Aug. 1-2 @ Athletics), with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 4 RBI, 4 walks, 2 stolen bases and only 4 strikeouts...since 2023, his 12 triples in interleague matchups are second in the Majors, behind Jarren Duran/BOS (13).

- **Ketel Marte**, since June 1, has reached in 24 of his last 28 road games, hitting .352 (38-for-108)/.440 OBP/.648 SLG/1.088 OPS with 8 doubles, 8 homers, 20 RBI and 17 walks (13 K).

DANGEROUS FROM 1-2 SPOTS: From the 1-2 lineup spots, the D-backs lead the Majors in OPS (.877), SLG (.518), OBP (.359), extra-base hits (108), RBI (135) and triples (15)...are second in homers (51, behind Dodgers/52).

TAKING BASES: This season, **Corbin Carroll** has added 5 extra runs by taking extra bases [bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, balks, defensive indifference], the most in the Majors, ahead of Jarren Duran/BOS (4), Elly De La Cruz/CIN (4) and Zach McKinstry/DET (4).

ALL ABOUT SACRIFICE: The D-backs' 44 sacrifice flies are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Guardians (40), Brewers (37), Yankees (36) and Mets (36), while their 22 sacrifice bunts rank fourth, behind the Padres (32), Blue Jays (27) and Royals (23).

BARRELING IT UP: Since the All-Star break, **Ketel Marte's** 63.2 hard hit pct. (pct. of batted balls with exit velocity of 95 mph+) ranks seventh in the NL, behind Ryan McMahon/COL (85.7), Kyle Schwarber/PHI (75.0), Manny Machado/SD (67.3), Heliot Ramos/SF (65.9), Willson Contreras/STL (64.1) and William Contreras/MIL (64.0).

SLUGGING LEADOFF: Among MLB players in the leadoff spot [min. 150 PA], **Corbin Carroll** ranks in triples (1st, 11), homers (2nd, 21, behind Shohei Ohtani-LAD/34), .SLG (2nd, .606, behind Byron Buxton-MIN/.610, and OPS (5th, .940).

- Among MLB leadoff hitters this season (min. 150 PA), Carroll's 27.0% barrel pct. ranks atop the group:

LEADOFF TRIPLES & HOMERS: **Corbin Carroll's** 5 leadoff triples this season are the most in the Majors, ahead of Xavier Edwards/MIA (2) while his 5 leadoff homers are tied for fifth with C.J. Abrams/WSH.

- Since 1901, Carroll is the only player to collect 5+ leadoff triples and 5+ leadoff homers within their first 100 games of a season...he is 1 of 3 players all-time to do so in an entire season:

ON DECK - SAN DIEGO PADRES: Following today's trip finale @ Athletics, the D-backs take on the Padres for 3 games @ Chase Field for their penultimate series of the year.

- The D-backs are 4-3 vs. Padres this season, splitting their previous 4-game road series from July 7-10 and taking the first series 2-1 @ Chase Field from June 13-15.

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (10-7, 5.11)

- Took the loss in his last start on July 29 @ Tigers (7 ER in 4.2 IP, 0 BB, 3 K).
- In 7 career starts vs. Padres, is 2-2 (team is 4-3) with a 3.24 ERA (15 ER in 41.2 IP), 7 walks and 41 strikeouts.
- Over his last 3 starts vs. Padres, is 2-0 (team is 3-0) with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER in 17.2 IP), 1 walk and 19 strikeouts...tossed a career-high 8.0 innings his last start on July 9 @ Petco Park with 2 earned runs allowed on 4 hits with no walks and 4 strikeouts.

- Signed a 4-year contract in December 2023 (2024-2027) with a conditional option for the fifth year.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- Finished tied for sixth in the 2019 AL Cy Young Award vote after going 19-6 with a 3.81 ERA (86 ER in 203.1 IP) and 213 strikeouts.
- From 2018-23, his 63 wins tied for third most in the AL (also: Justin Verlander), behind Gerrit Cole (86) and Jose Berríos (66).
- Carried a no-hitter into the eighth inning on Sept. 4, 2016 @ Athletics that was broken up by a Marcus Semien 2-out single.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: 19th start (11th road).

- Third straight start vs. an AL opponent...faced the Astros on July 22 and the Tigers on July 28 (0-1, 3.65 ERA).
- In his last 2 starts vs. AL West, is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER in 12.2 IP).
- Celebrated 10 years of MLB service time on July 6.

LAST START: Lost on July 28 @ Tigers (5 ER in 6.0 IP).

VS. ATHLETICS: Is scoreless in 2 of his last 3 starts vs. Athletics, going 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP), 6 walks and 18 strikeouts.

- Earned the win in his last start on Sept. 24, 2023 @ Athletics while with the Tigers (0 ER in 7.0 IP, 5 H, 5 K).

VS. AL WEST: In his last 4 starts (3 quality) vs. AL West opponents, is 2-1 with a 2.28 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 23.2 IP).

RISPY BUSINESS: In his last 5 road starts, is holding runners in scoring position to a .167 AVG (5-for-30)/.242 OBP/.200 SLG/.442 OPS with 3 walks and 11 strikeouts.

- In his last 9 starts, hitters are 10-for-55 (.182 AVG)/.517 OPS with 6 walks and 16 strikeouts.

EARLY RISER: 2 of his 3 wins have come in day games.

- In his last 2 day games, is 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3 ER in 11.2 IP) and 11 strikeouts.
