ROAD WARRIORS

The Washington Nationals open a three-game series against the New York Mets on Friday night...This matchup kicks off a nine-game, 10-day road trip that includes series against the Mets, Texas Rangers and Miami Marlins.

- Washington is in the midst of a stretch of 39 games in 41 days that started on July 24 and runs through Sept. 2.
- The Nationals enter this series having won five of their last eight games since Aug. 5...Washington is outscoring its opponents, 52-37 during this stretch.
- The Nationals are 13-5-1 in road series this season and 33-27 (.550) on the road overall this season...The .550 winning percentage ranks sixth in Major League Baseball.

The combination of **Andrés Chaparro** and **Abimelec Ortiz** have put up impressive numbers over the last month:

- **Andrés Chaparro** ranks third in Major League Baseball in OPS (1.056) and is fourth in slugging percentage (.673) since the All-Star break...He's hitting .288 (15-for-52) with a .383 on-base percentage (5 BB), five doubles, five homers, 21 RBI and 12 runs scored in the 20 games since the break.
- **Abimelec Ortiz** is 7-for-15 (.467) with three homers, seven RBI, just two strikeouts and four runs scored in his last five games...He's hit safely in all five and has recorded at least one RBI in four of the five.

CJ Abrams - the National League Player of the Month in July - is at the top of the Major League and National League leaderboards in several offensive categories...See chart to the right for the list.

- He is hitting .318 with a .636 slugging (7 2B, 3B, 11 HR) and a 1.012 OPS over his last 33 games.
- With 91 RBI this season, Abrams has matched **Ian Desmond** (91 in 2014) for the most RBI by a shortstop in a single season in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...With nine more RBI, he will become the 12th player in Nationals history to record 100 RBI in a season and first since **Anthony Rendon** (126) and **Juan Soto** (110) in 2019.
- With seven more stolen bases, Abrams will become the second player in Nationals history to record a 30 homer/30 stolen base season joining **Alfonso Soriano** (40 HR/41 SB) in 2006.

Other Nationals hitters enjoying hot stretches at the plate:

- **Harry Ford** has scored at least one run in five straight games, the longest active streak in baseball and has at least one extra-base hit in four straight, the third-longest active streak.
- **Daylen Life** is 9-for-24 (.375) with a double, homer, nine RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored in his last six games...He's hit safely in five of the six.
- **Keibert Ruiz** leads the National League in batting average (.436) and is second in on-base percentage (.519) in seven games since Aug. 2 (min. 25 PA)...He's hit safely in six of the seven games while going 10-for-23 with a double, three RBI, four walks, two strikeouts and four runs scored.
- **Jacob Young** is 10-for-22 (.455) with two doubles, one triple, one homer, five RBI, two hit by pitch, two walks, just one strikeout and five runs scored in his last seven games...He's hit safely in six of the seven.

Washington leads Major League Baseball with 177 home runs, eight ahead of the New York Yankees (169).

- The Nationals have clubbed 140 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and 20 more than the New York Mets (120)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB.
- Washington has seven players (Abrams, Crews, Garcia Jr., Lile, Mead, Wood, Young) with at least 10 home runs, the most by a Nationals team (2005-pres.) since the 2019 Nationals had 10 players with at least 10 homers.

The Washington Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 134 stolen bases and 10.0 baserunning runs above average, according to FanGraphs...**Nasim Nuñez** leads MLB with 40 stolen bases.

- He is seven stolen bases shy of tying **CJ Abrams'** Nationals record (2005-pres.) of 47 stolen bases in 2023... He is one of four players in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to steal at least 40 bases joining **Alfonso Soriano** (2006, 41), **Trea Turner** (2017, 43 and 2017, 46) and **CJ Abrams** (2023, 47).

FORGOT ABOUT TREY?

Rochester infielder/outfielder **Trey Lipscomb** has hit safely in 10 straight and in 31 of 35 games since July 1 (.348/.392/.560)...During the 10-game streak, he is 17-for-48 (.354) with two doubles, four homers, 13 RBI and 13 runs scored...Lipscomb ranks among Nationals minor leaguers in extra-base hits (T1st, 44), home runs (T2nd, 22), RBI (2nd, 69), hits (2nd, 108), slugging percentage (2nd, .527) and batting average (4th, .290).

Wilmington infielder **Ronny Cruz** has recorded four straight multi-hit games, going 8-for-17 (.471) with two doubles, two homers, five RBI, one walk, three stolen bases and seven runs scored during the four game streak.
