<b>The Gift of a Win</b> Josh Hader celebrated his birthday (27) yesterday with his second win of the season.....he is the first Brewer to win on his birthday since Gio Gonzalez (33) on 9/19/18 vs. Cincinnati.	
<b>No-Hit Stuff</b> Through just 6 games, the Brewers have already had two pitchers carry no-hitters through six innings.... Corbin Burnes tossed 6.1 hitless innings last Saturday vs. Minnesota before a Byron Buxton solo homer.... Brandon Woodruff threw 6.0 hitless innings yesterday at Chicago-NL before allowing a single to Ian Happ to lead off the seventh inning.

**NOTABLE OFFSEASON TRANSACTIONS:** 10/30, declined the mutual option on OF Ryan Braun.....11/4, named Ed Sedar advisor to the Major League coaching staff; named Quintin Berry first base coach.....11/19, promoted Matt Arnold to senior vice president and general manager.....12/2, acquired a player to be named (LHP Leo Crawford) from Los Angeles-NL for RHP Corey Knebel.....1/21, signed INF/OF Daniel Robertson to a 1-year contract.....2/5, signed 2B Kolten Wong to a 2-year contract with a club option for 2023.....2/22, re-signed LHP Brett Anderson to a 1-year contract.....2/23, signed 3B Travis Shaw to a Minor League contract with an invitation to Major League camp.....3/8, signed OF Jackie Bradley Jr. to a 2-year contract with a player opt-out clause after 2021 and mutual option for 2023.

**MANAGER:** Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (437-415) and sixth full season.....Counsell ranks third in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617) and Ned Yost (457-502).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

**COACHES:** Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

TODAY'S STARTER: #39 - RHP CORBIN BURNES (1gs, 0-1, 1.42)

**BURNES AT A GLANCE:** Corbin Burnes, 26, will make his second start of the season.....Burnes made his first start of 2021 last Saturday vs. Minnesota and took a 2-0 loss (6.1ip, 1h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 11k, 1hr, 1hbp).....he threw 6.1 hitless innings before allowing a solo homer to Byron Buxton.....he posted double-digit strikeouts in a game for the fifth time in his career, doing so without a walk for the second time.....Burnes was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

**LAST SEASON:** Burnes was named Brewers Most Valuable Pitcher by the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA as he went 4-1 with a 2.11 ERA in 12 games / 9 starts.....he finished sixth in National League Cy Young Award voting.....the team went 5-4 in his starts.....he made 4 quality starts.....opponents batted .174.....he struck out 88 batters (9th in NL) in just 59.2 innings.....he fell a third of an inning short of qualifying among the NL ERA leaders (would have ranked 4th).....Burnes was placed on the 10-day injured list on 9/25 with a left oblique strain, ending his 2020 season.

**CAREER:** Is 12-7 with a 4.35 ERA in 75 games / 14 starts (153ip, 74er).....is in his fourth season, all with the Brewers (2018-21).

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 6-5 with a 4.56 ERA in 34 games / 7 starts (81ip, 41er).....went 2-0 with a 1.40 ERA in 5 games / 3 starts in 2020 (25.2ip, 4er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 6-2 with a 4.13 ERA in 41 games / 7 starts (72ip, 33er).....went 2-1 with a 2.65 ERA in 7 games / 6 starts in 2020 (34ip, 10er).

**CAREER vs. CARDINALS:** Is 1-2 with a 6.41 ERA in 7 games / 4 starts (19.2ip, 14er), including 0-1 with a 4.32 ERA in 2 starts last season (8.1ip, 4er).....is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in 4 games / 1 start at Busch Stadium (6.2ip, 4er).

RHP Adrian Houser will make his second start of the season.....Houser made his first start of 2021 last Sunday vs. Minnesota and took an 8-2 loss (5ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 77 pitches).....he is 1-2 with a 4.64 ERA in 7 career games / 4 starts against the Cardinals (21.1ip, 11er).....his only appearance against St. Louis last season came in relief on 9/27 at Busch Stadium (1ip, 1h).....he induced a 5-4-3 triple play from Yadier Molina in that outing, the ninth triple play in franchise history.....Houser is 1-2 with a 5.71 ERA as a starter against the St. Louis, Missouri Cardinals (17.1ip, 11er).
