RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals wrap up their road slate today with the finale of a three-game series against the Milwaukee Brewers at American Family Field ... The Cardinals are 2-3 on their six-game road trip through San Diego (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-1) ... After today, the Cardinals conclude the regular season by honoring and celebrating the career of **Adam Wainwright** during a three-game weekend series with the Cincinnati Reds at Busch Stadium.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals have clinched last place in the NL Central for the first time in Wild Card Era and first time since finishing 6th in the NL East in 1990 ... St. Louis has spent 142 of 176 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... The Cardinals 69-89 record is their lowest at the 158-game mark since 1978 when they were 68-90 (.430) ... St. Louis needs to end the season undefeated to avoid their first 90-loss season since going 70-92 in 1990.

COMEBACK CARDS: Since 1913, the Cardinals have lost 90+ games only five times (1913, 1916, 1976, 1978, 1990), but finished above .500 the year after all of those seasons.

WINNANSITY: **Masyn Winn** last night joined **David Green** (May 25-26, 1982) as the 2nd Cardinal age 21 or younger in franchise history with a sacrifice fly in consecutive games ... Since 1954 (when sac flies were first tracked officially), Winn is now the 3rd Cardinals rookie with a sac fly in back-to-back games in the same season in which they made their MLB debut, joining **Dal Maxvill** (Aug 5-7, 1962) and **Bill Virdon** (July 27-28, 1955) - *Elias*

WHAT'S BREWING: **Tommy Edman** is hitting .400/.455/.575 (16-40) with a 1.030 OPS in 11 games vs. Brewers in 2023; his 16 hits are the most by any opposing player vs. Milwaukee this season ... **Jordan Walker** (11-31, .355) has hit safely in all nine games vs. the Brewers ... **Ryan Helsley** has hurled 4.2 scoreless IP with three saves and eight strikeouts vs. Milwaukee this year.

HEIR JORDAN: 21-year-old rookie **Jordan Walker** has hit safely in 20-of-23 games played in September, including 12 in a row (.306/.375/.494, 26-85) since September 15 ... Walker is:

- The only Major Leaguer this season with three hitting streaks of 12 games or longer (12, 17, 12) and 1 of 8 MLB players (the only rookie) with three or more double-digit game hit streaks ... Walker owns 3 of the 9 longest rookie hit streaks, with **Josh Jung** being the only other rookie with two (14 and 10). - *Elias*
- 1 of just 5 Cardinals rookies (since 1900) with three or more different double-digit hitting streaks in the same season, joining **Albert Pujols** (3 in 2021); **Bake McBride** (4 in 1974); **Johnny Mize** (3 in 1936); and **Pug Bennett** (3 in 1906) ... Pujols and Walker are the only two to do so at age 21 or younger. - *Elias*
- 1 of 15 Cardinals overall (since 1900) with three distinct hit streaks of 12 games or longer in the same season - *Elias*
- The 8th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 26 or more hits in September/October.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (Sept. 28, 2021): The Cardinals win the 17th and final game of their historic 17-game winning streak while clinching a postseason berth as the 2nd NL Wild Card ... Backed by home runs from **Nolan Arenado**, **Dylan Carlson**, and **Jose Rondon**, **Adam Wainwright** earns his team-leading 17th win of the season in the 6-2 win over the Brewers at Busch Stadium.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley made his MLB debut on April 16, 2019 at Milwaukee...his first strikeout victim was **Ryan Braun** (swinging) that night.

Willson Contreras' younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Dakota Hudson (freshman) and **Brandon Woodruff** (junior) were teammates at Mississippi State University in 2014.

Jacob Barnes was selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons (2016-19) in Milwaukee before being claimed off waivers by Kansas City.

Devin Williams was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Dylan Carlson and **Rowdy Tellez** are both graduates of Elk Grove High School, where Dylan's father Jeff Carlson was the head baseball coach.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 12th start of the season and 18th appearance since his promotion from Memphis (AAA) at the beginning of July. It's his 2nd meeting of the year against Philadelphia.
- Compiled a career-best six game win streak from Sept. 17, 2022-Aug. 20, 2023, which including five-straight this season (July 15-Aug. 20).
- Pitched 6.0 innings at San Diego after not pitching more than 5.0 innings in each of his previous three starts. Has not crossed the 90-pitch threshold since August 26 at PHI (season-high 105).
- St. Louis has won 7 of Hudson's 11 starts this season (.636). The Cardinals were 13-7 in **Jack Flaherty's** starts, the only other Cardinals starting pitcher this season that the team sported a winning record in his starts.
- The Cardinals are 47-31 (.603 win pct.) in his 77 career games started and 29-11 (.725) in his 39 career games started at Busch Stadium.
- Went 4-1 in August, one of six MLB pitchers with four wins during the month.
- Was 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA (16.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in six games as a reliever.
- Since 2018 when Hudson made his MLB debut, leads active MLB pitchers in GIDP/9 (1.23) and 3rd MLB in groundball percentage (55.4%).
- Tied for the 2022 Major League lead in opponent ground into double play with 25.
- Among active pitchers with 50 or more decisions, ranks 5th in career winning percentage (.667, 38-19) with **Walker Buehler** (.742, 46-16) ranking first; ranks 21st all-time in MLB history.
- His .667 career winning pct. ranks 4th among all Cardinals since 1900 (min. 75 starts) behind only **John Tudor** (.705), **Chris Carpenter** (.683) & **Woody Williams** (.672).

LAST TIME OUT

- Exited trailing 2-1 after scattering nine hits, tying his season/career-high, but allowed only two runs in a no decision the Cardinals lost 4-2 in the bottom of the 8th inning after rallying to tie the game.
- 5th start of 11 this year holding opponent to two runs or fewer.

- He's 21-5 (.808 win pct.) in 56 career games (39 starts) at Busch Stadium, and ranks 3rd in ERA (2.74) all-time at Busch III among pitchers with a minimum 200.0 IP.
- Has lost 2 of his last 3 decisions, but still owns a 5-game win streak at Busch Stadium that dates back to his last loss here on 7/14/22 vs. LAD.
- Of pitchers with 25 or more home decisions, his .808 home winning pct. (21-5), ranks 3rd among starting pitchers in MLB history trailing **Jose Fernandez** (29-2, .935) and **Emil Yde** (27-6, .818).

CAREER

- Has appeared in 113 career MLB games (78 starts), going 38-19, 3.83 ERA, including team-leading 16 wins in 2019 when he finished 5th in NL ROY voting.

- Has yet to win at Milwaukee (0-3) and the Cardinals are 0-4 overall in his four previous starts.
- His one career win vs. MIL came at Busch Stadium on Aug. 19, 2019 in which he carried a no-hitter 6.2 innings into the game before he was removed for pitch count at 111, a then career-high, which he would break two starts later vs. CIN (112). The Cardinals won 3-0 although Giovanni Gallegos gave up the lone hit to Yasmani Grandal.
- All seven home runs he's allowed to the Brewers have come in Milwaukee.

- Has not faced the Reds in 2023, but made five scoreless appearances vs. CIN in 2022 totaling 9.2 innings. Last allowed a run to Cincinnati on July 24, 2021 at Great American Ballpark in his only career start vs. the Reds (Lost 5-3).
- The Cardinals have lost 9 of the 11 games he has appeared in against Cincinnati in his career dating back to 2020.
- His 5 consecutive scoreless appearances vs. CIN is the longest active streak by a Cardinal since Russ Springer ran off 16 from 2007-08 (12.1 IP) to end his career.
