**SIX NON-PROFITS SURPRISED WITH OVER \$1 MILLION THRU 2026 KEN KENDRICK GRAND SLAM AWARDS:** Six Arizona-based nonprofits - Arizona Educational Foundation, Delivering Dreams Arizona, Foundation for Blind Children, Keys to Change, Phoenix Public Library Foundation and Southwest Human Development - were surprised with a combined \$1 million in grant funding through the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation's 2026 Ken Kendrick Grand Slam Awards...established in 2002, this signature grant program has awarded more than \$13.8 million to organizations across Arizona, supporting transformative, large-scale projects that drive long-term change by improving operations and strengthening communities.

**\$100 MILLION IN GIVING:** The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** In the last 8 meetings between the D-backs (38 R, 59 H, 30 XBH, 13 HR) and Braves (53 R, 75 H, 32 XBH, 13 HR), the teams have combined for a total of 91 runs (11.4 AVG R/G), 134 hits (16.8 AVG H/G), 62 extra-base hits (7.7 AVG XBH/G) and 26 homers (3.3 AVG HR/G).

- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 26 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout since March 27 @ Dodgers (third inning) is the Majors' longest active streak.
  - Last season, he rode a streak of 43 plate appearances without a strikeout from April 3 (fifth inning)-April 14, 2025, the longest by a D-back since Ender Inciarte (44 PA from Aug. 31-Sept. 11, 2015).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 5 of his last 6 games, hitting .333 (6-for-18)/1.292 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 5 walks.
- **Michael Soroka**, who pitched 4 seasons with the Braves from 2018-23, is making his second career start vs. Braves...earned the win in his D-backs debut on March 30 vs. Tigers after recording a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts over 5.0 scoreless innings, which included an immaculate fifth inning.
  - His 10 strikeouts vs. Tigers surpassed Randy Johnson's 9 on April 5, 1999 @ Dodgers for the most by a pitcher in a D-backs debut.
  - Fourth D-back all-time with an immaculate inning (second occurrence @ Chase Field), joining Randy Johnson (Aug. 23, 2001 @ Pirates, sixth inn.), Byung-Hyun Kim (May 11, 2002 @ Phillies, eighth inning) and Wade Miley (Oct. 1, 2012 vs. Rockies, third inn.).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 2-0 vs. Braves last night after entering the top of the ninth tied 0-0.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** tossed 7.0+ shutout innings for the first time since Sept. 24, 2023 @ Athletics while with the Tigers, and recorded his first career back-to-back shutout starts to begin a season...was the first time he recorded back-to-back shutout starts since May 4-10, 2023.
  - Has not allowed an earned run in 16.2 consecutive innings (since Sep. 27, 2025, third inning) [allowed 1 unearned run on March 28]...is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (22.2), Cam Schlichter/NYY (19.0) and Max Fried/NYY (18.1).
  - In his last 8 starts dating back to Aug. 30, 2025, has gone 4-1 with a 2.09 ERA (11 ER in 47.1 IP), opponent .218 AVG and 35 strikeouts.
  - In his last 4 starts vs. NL East opponents, is 1-0 with a 1.52 ERA (4 ER in 23.2 IP), opponent .209 AVG, 11 walks and 24 strikeouts.
- **Ketel Marte** went 1-for-4 with the D-backs' first hit in the sixth inning.
- **Juan Morillo** tossed his third straight scoreless outing (2.1 IP) and fourth in his last 5 appearances (4.0 IP).

**DEFENSE SAVING RUNS:** The D-backs' 17 defensive runs saved (DRS) rank atop the Majors, ahead of the Braves (10), Dodgers (9), Mariners (9) and Giants (8), while **Ketel Marte's** and **Alek Thomas's** 3 DRS rank tied for the second most among players (also: 3 others), behind Cole Young /SEA (4).

**MARTE'S 10 YEARS OF SERVICE:** Yesterday, **Ketel Marte** reached the milestone of 10 years of service time.

- Marte, who debuted with the Mariners in 2015 and made his D-backs debut in 2017, became just the second D-back all-time to play 10 seasons with the club, joining Nick Ahmed (2014-23), and, with 1,062 games, is the third D-back all-time to appear in over 1,000 games with Luis Gonzalez (1,194) and Paul Goldschmidt (1,092).
- In his D-backs tenure, Marte's accolades include Top 5 in NL MVP voting twice (fourth in 2019, third in '24), 3-time NL All-Star (2019, '24, '25), 2-time All MLB First-Team honoree (2024, '25), 2-time Silver Slugger winner (2024, '25), 2023 NLCS MVP and 2-time D-backs Arizona BBWAA Most Valuable Player (2021, '24).

**TRENDING: Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 12 of his last 14 home games since Sept. 15, 2025, with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI and 8 walks.

- On Wednesday, he ended his on-base streak at 22 games...dated back to Sept. 9, 2025 and was the Majors' second longest active on-base streak...marked the longest combined-season on-base streak of his career.
- Has reached base in 23 of his last 25 games with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 14 walks (12 K).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 28 of his last 30 home games since Aug. 6, 2025, including 2+ times in 21 of those games...is batting .324 (35-for-108)/1.102 OPS with 9 doubles, 4 triples, 7 homers, 24 RBI, 20 walks and 12 stolen bases.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 home games since Sep. 19, 2025 with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI, 3 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch.

**VS. BRAVES:** The D-backs are 4-2 in their last 6 games.

- Among active NL players vs. Braves since 2024, **Ketel Marte** ranks in homers (T-2nd, 6), SLG (7th, .708) and OPS (10th, 1.097).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely 2+ times in 5 of his last 6 games, hitting .300 (6-for-20)/1.312 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 5 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 5 of his last 6 games with 1 double, 4 RBI and 1 walk.
