AT HOME: The Brewers are 5-6 at home, going 1-2-1 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 12-4 on the road, going 4-0-1 in series play.....their 12-4 record ties the best road start in franchise history (also 2014).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager). Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 5-1.....their last challenge came on 4/24 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base involving Edward Olivares in the ninth inning stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #46 - RHP BRYSE WILSON (8g, 2gs, 2-0, 3.50)

<u>WILSON AT A GLANCE</u>: Bryse Wilson, 26, will be making his ninth appearance and third start of the season.....Wilson last pitched last Wednesday in a start at Pittsburgh and received no decision in the Brewers' 3-2 win [4.1ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 75 pitches]....his only other start this season came on 4/17 vs. San Diego as he received no decision in the Brewers' 1-0 win (3.2ip, 2h, 1bb, 2k, 57 pitches)....his last start prior to this season came on 9/28/22 vs. Cincinnati....he made 59 straight relief appearances between starts....Wilson was acquired from Pittsburgh in exchange for cash on 1/4/23.

ARE YOU READY FOR SOME FOOTBALL?!: Bryse's younger brother, Payton, was selected on Friday by the Pittsburgh Steelers in the third round of the 2024 NFL Draft.....the linebacker attended North Carolina State University.

LAST SEASON: Wilson went 6-0 with a 2.58 ERA and 3 saves in 53 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee.....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA.....he pitched as a full-time reliever for the first time in his professional career.....he held opponents to a .211 batting average, marking a career best.

CAREER: Is 17-17 with a 4.73 ERA and 4 saves in 117 games/45 starts (327ip, 172er).....is in his seventh Major League season with Atlanta (2018-21), Pittsburgh (2021-22) and Milwaukee (2023-24).....is 9-16 with a 5.37 ERA as a starter (206ip, 123er) and 8-1 with a 3.64 ERA in relief (121ip, 49er).....Wilson was selected by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Orange (NC) High School.....he committed to the University of North Carolina prior to being drafted.....Wilson was traded by the Braves to the Pirates, along with RHP Ricky DeVito, in exchange for RHP Richard Rodríguez on 7/30/21.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-2 with a 3.30 ERA in 34 games/4 starts (62.2ip, 23er).....is 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 3 games/1 start this season (8ip, 2er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 9-11 with a 4.71 ERA in 56 games/23 starts (154.2ip, 81er).....is 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA in 5 games/1 start this season (10ip, 5er).
