- ♦ Arizona is in its 28th Cactus League season and 15th at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick (Tucson from 1998-2010).
 - D-backs rank third in average home attendance this Spring (10,637), behind the Cubs (12,946) and Dodgers (11,065).

D-BACKS EXTEND MARTINEZ

♦On Saturday the D-backs agreed with RHP Justin Martinez to a 5-year contract extension through 2029 (beginning in 2025) with club options for 2030-31 and a conditional club option for 2032.

- ◆Zac Gallen was named the D-backs' Opening Day starter vs. Cubs.
- Will mark his third career (and consecutive) Opening Day start with Arizona.
- The bid will tie him with Madison Bumgarner, Zack Greinke and lan Kennedy for third most Opening Day starts in club history, behind Randy Johnson (6) and Brandon Webb (4).

- ♦ Went 11-10 with a 4.71 ERA (103 R-95 ER in 181.2 IP), opponent .259 AVG (183-for-707), 42 walks and 185 strikeouts over 32 starts in his second season with the D-backs.
- ♦ Set career highs in wins (11), starts (32), innings (181.2) and strikeouts (185).
- ♦ Became the seventh D-back starting pitcher at age 25 or younger all-time to collect 10+ wins in a season and first since Robbie Ray in 2017 (15).
- ♦ Earned his first Major League win on Aug. 25, 2023 vs. Reds (2 ER in 5.1 IP, 5 K).

- ♦ Named the 2024 D-backs' Rookie of the Year by the Arizona Chapter of the BBWAA after going 5-6 with 8 saves, a 2.48 ERA (20 ER in 72.2 IP) and 91 strikeouts over 64 games in his second season with the D-backs.
- ♦ His 100.3 MPH AVG fastball ranked first among NL relievers and third in the Majors, behind Mason Miller/OAK (100.9) and Jhoan Duran/MIN (100.5) [min. 50 G].
- ♦ His 413 pitches of 100.0+ MPH in 2024 led the NL and ranked second in the Majors, behind Mason Miller/OAK (503) and ahead of Emmanuel Clase/CLE (272).
- ♦ Signed by the D-backs as a non-drafted free agent on March 5, 2018.
