## NATIONALS NEWS

### WELCOME HOME

Following a 4-2 road trip and a day off on Thursday, the Washington Nationals return home for a six-game home-stand starting Friday night...Washington squares off against the San Diego Padres this weekend before the Miami Marlins come to D.C. for a three-game series starting Monday.

- The Nationals return to D.C. having won back-to-back series over two of the best teams in Major League Baseball, the Cleveland Guardians (2-1) and the Atlanta Braves (2-1).

### ROSTER MOVE

The Nationals returned from rehab assignment and recalled right-handed pitcher **Cole Henry** from the 15-day Injured List...Left-handed pitcher **PJ Poulin** was optioned to Triple-A Rochester following the game on Wednesday.

### WINNING WAYS

The Nationals have won four of five and six of their last nine games...They are 18-12 (.600) since April 25 and have won seven of their 10 series over this stretch.

- Washington's 29-28 (.509) record is the best mark through the Club's first 57 games since the 2018 Nationals started the season 33-24 (.579).
- The Nationals are 7-4 (.636) in their last 11 home games...This improvement comes after a 3-12 (.200) record at home to start the 2026 season.

### PITCHING IN

Over the last eight games, the Nationals pitching rotation (not including openers) has pitched to a 1.21 ERA (6 ER/44.2 IP) with 43 strikeouts and seven walks.

- Miles Mikolas**: 0-1, 0.00 ERA (8.2 IP), four strikeouts, zero walks
- Cade Cavalli**: 1-1, 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP), 16 strikeouts, three walks
- Zack Littell**: 2-0, 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP), 10 strikeouts, two walks
- Foster Griffin**: 1-0, 0.00 ERA (6.0 IP), six strikeouts, one walk
- Jake Irvin**: 1-0, 0.00 ERA (5.0 IP), seven strikeouts, one walk
- Over this stretch (since May 20), **Simon Mathews'** entire pitching staff is tied for second in Major League Baseball with a 1.86 ERA and 0.37 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings.

### VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE

Since May 6, Washington's offense leads Major League Baseball in home runs (35), extra-base hits (90), doubles (50), slugging percentage (.486), OPS (.821) and runs scored (123).

- Of note, the 90 extra-base hits are 17 more than the next closest club (San Francisco, 73) and the 123 runs are nine more than the Dodgers (114).
- The Nationals have recorded at least one extra-base hit in 27 straight games, the fourth-longest active streak in baseball behind San Francisco (31), Pittsburgh (30) and Chicago White Sox (28).

### A IS FOR ABRAMS AND ALL-STAR

With All-Star voting set to begin next week, **CJ Abrams** is ranked among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See chart to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams' ranks among National League hitters in RBI (2nd, 47), OPS (5th, .937), wOBA (6th, .404), wRC+ (6th, 161), extra-base hits (16th, 26), slugging percentage (7th, .549), hits (T8th, 60) on-base percentage (10th, .388) and home runs (T10th, 12).

### WOOD...YOU LIKE TO VOTE FOR JAMES?

With All-Star voting set to begin next week, **James Wood** is ranked among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See chart to the right for position specific rankings.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball with 50 runs scored and four leadoff home runs...He ranks in the National League in walks (1st, 47), on-base percentage (1st, .414), OPS (1st, .967), wRC+ (1st, 169), wOBA (1st, .416), extra-base hits (3rd, 39), home runs (T2nd, 15), doubles (T3rd, 15) and RBI (T8th, 37).
- Over his last 13 games, Wood is hitting .420 (21-for-50) with a .525 on-base percentage (10 BB, HBP) and a .680 slugging percentage (4 2B, 3 HR).

### BACKSTOP BAT

**Keibert Ruiz** has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games, going 16-for-41 (.390) with seven doubles, three homers, 15 RBI, one walk, one stolen base and nine runs scored.

- On the season, Ruiz is tied for first among Major League catchers with 12 doubles and among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in slugging percentage (5th, .486).
- The 12 doubles are tied for second among all Major League Baseball switch hitters behind **Elly De La Cruz** (13) and his .485 slugging percentage is good for third (min. 100 PA).

### THIS AND THAT

Some notable notes about other Nationals players:

- Daylen Life** leads National League outfielders and is tied for third in the National League with 15 doubles.
- Nasim Nuñez** leads Major League Baseball with 22 stolen bases, ahead of **Jose Ramirez** (20).
- Dylan Crews** has reached safely in all eight games since being recalled on May 19.
