THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game, seven-day homestand, going 2-1 vs. Boston earlier in the week, followed by consecutive losses to Cincinnati on Friday and Saturday...Minnesota will complete the series and homestand today with the three-game series finale against the Reds...Twins will enjoy an off-day tomorrow before beginning a six-game roadtrip with stops at Citi Field (Tuesday-Thursday) to play the Mets and Tropicana Field (next weekend) to play the Rays.
Twins have won four of their last seven, eight of their last 12 and 10 of their last 16.
Twins are looking to snap a three-game losing streak, which ties their season-long, previously done from March 29-April 1 (1 at BAL & 2 at KC).

TWINS CHASED ALL DAY, EVENTUALLY CAUGHT RED HANDED: The Twins lost to the Reds on Saturday afternoon by a score of 5-4...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...the bullpen allowed three runs on six hits in the final 3.0 innings pitched as the Twins lost their first game of the season when leading after seven innings (10-1)...the offense recorded nine hits, walked five times, went 3-for-15 with runners in scoring position and left 11 men on base...Ryan Jeffers drove in the first two runs with his fifth career triple...Luke Keaschall and Josh Bell each had two of the club's nine hits.

REDS ZONE: Minnesota and Cincinnati are playing each other for the 43rd time in their history today...the Twins are 19-23 all-time against the Reds, going 8-12 in Cincinnati (7-7 at Great American Ball Park and 1-5 at Cinergy Field) and 11-11 in Minnesota (4-9 at Target Field and 7-2 at the Metrodome).

Derek Shelton has a career managerial record of 37-43 against the Reds, his most wins vs. any opponent.
Josh Bell has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 vs. Cincinnati, hitting .340 (16-for-47) with four doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI, an .809 slugging percentage and a 1.189 OPS in that span.
Victor Caratini is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with a .994 OPS in his last 11 games vs. the Reds.
Byron Buxton is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with five home runs, six RBI, an .788 slugging percentage and a 1.166 OPS in nine career games vs. the Reds.
Ryan Jeffers is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with three home runs, 11 RBI, six walks, a .396 on-base percentage, a .619 slugging percentage and a 1.015 OPS in 13 career games vs. Cincy.

MASKED SINGER: Since 2020, Brady Singer leads baseball in runs allowed vs. the Twins with 40 (39 earned)...notable individuals lifetime against Singer: Byron Buxton is 7-for-18 (.389) with two doubles, two home runs and four RBI...Trevor Larnach is 6-for-13 (.462) with a home run and three RBI...Josh Bell is 4-for-9 (.444) with two doubles, one home run and two walks...Ryan Jeffers is 3-for-9 (.333)...Victor Caratini is 2-for-4 with a home run.

YOU BE IL-LIN': Twins are playing their first National League opponent of the season this weekend...their next opponent in IL Play will be the Mets at Citi Field, from Tuesday-Thursday...their next opponent after that will be the Nationals in D.C. from May 5-7...last season, they went 20-28 vs. the NL, their last series was September 26-28 at Philadelphia, winning one of three; their last IL win was a 5-0 win on September 27 at the Phillies.

THEY SHOOT, THEY SCORE: Twins have scored 108 runs on the season, third-most in the AL and seventh-most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (118), Washington (118), Houston (116), Los Angeles-NL (115), Los Angeles-AL (114) and Chicago-NL (110).

43 of their 108 runs scored (40%) on the season have come via home run...they have hit 26 home runs this season, tied with Houston for fifth-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (37), Los Angeles-AL (34), New York-AL (29) and Atlanta (28).

BREAK A BROOM: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the first time in 2025...once this season, they entered the finale looking to avoid being swept, that came on April 2 at Kansas City, winning game three by a score of 5-1.

Twins were swept six times in 2025: three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15), three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), three games vs. the Athletics (August 19-21) and four games vs. Chicago-AL (September 1-4).

WARNING BELL: Over his last 11 games, Josh Bell is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with two doubles, one home run, three walks, seven RBI, eight runs scored, a .364 on-base percentage and an .803 OPS.
Bell is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with two home runs off breaking pitches this seasons...his average off breaking pitches ranks fourth among all qualifying players in the AL.
Bell has 196 career home runs, needing four to become the 40th active player in baseball to reach the 200 home run mark...Xander Bogaerts reached the 200-homer mark on Wednesday...Bell's last homer came on April 9 vs. Detroit, off Jack Flaherty.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis (left knee sprain) began his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul yesterday, going 1-for-4 with a two-run homer and a strikeout...Royce has missed the club's last eight games...St. Paul hosts Lehigh Valley today with first pitch at 2:07 pm (CT).

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week, and have named Double-A infielder Ben Ross and St. Paul outfielder Tyler Fedko as Co-Players of the Week.

Prielipp, 25, started for the Saints on Thursday vs. Lehigh Valley, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk while striking out eight of his 19 batters faced.

Ross, 24, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .476 (10-for-21) with two doubles, four home runs, six RBI and five walks, while recording exactly two hits in five of the six games.

Fedko, 26, hit three home runs and recorded 15 total bases for the Saints last Sunday afternoon vs. Toledo...he joined Jose Miranda, Brent Rooker, Spencer Steer and Chris Williams as the only Saints to homer three times in a game.

OH JEEZ, HAPPY BIRTHDAY, THAT'S PRETTY NEAT: Joe Mauer is celebrating his 43rd birthday today...Mauer shares a birthday with former Twins Frank Viola (66), Joe Beimel (48), Dennys Reyes (49) and Zach Duke (43).

- ⚔ Ober is making his fifth start of 2026 (120th career) and 63rd career start at Target Field, the third most in the ballpark's history (2010-).
- ⚔ Is making his fifth career start against Cincinnati; 0-2, 6.23 ERA (21.2 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 16 strikeouts.
- ⚔ In his most recent start on April 13 vs. Boston, Ober earned the win, allowing four runs on seven hits with one walk and seven strikeouts through 6.0 innings pitched.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ober earned his second straight win on April 13 vs. Boston, allowing four runs on seven hits through a season-high 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and a season-high seven strikeouts in a 13-6 Twins victory.

- ⚔ Threw 71.6% of his pitches for strikes, his highest strike percentage in a single start since June 28, 2025 at Detroit (71.9%).
- ⚔ Received a career-high 13 runs of support from his offense, surpassing his previous high of 11 (most recently done on April 28, 2025 at Cleveland).
- ⚔ His seven strikeouts are tied for his most against Boston, with the only other time coming in his first career start against the Red Sox on August 25, 2021 at Fenway Park.
- ⚔ Ober has walked one-or-more batters in each of his last six starts dating back to September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland, his longest such streak since walking a batter in six consecutive from July 10-August 15, 2024.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ober earned his first win of the 2026 campaign on April 8 vs. Detroit, allowing two runs on five hits through 5.2 innings pitched with one walk and two strikeouts, as the Twins defeated the Tigers by a score of 8-6.

- ⚔ His two runs allowed were his fewest in a start this season and fewest runs surrendered to the Tigers since a one-hit, scoreless effort across 8.0 innings pitched on July 28, 2024 at Comerica Park.

**MIDWEST MATCHUP:** Ober is making his fifth career start against Cincinnati; is 0-2, 6.23 ERA (21.2 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks, 16 strikeouts, a 1.43 WHIP and a .279 (24-for-86) BAA...in his most recent start against Cincinnati on June 18, 2025. Ober took the loss, allowing four runs on nine hits (1 HR) with no walks and five strikeouts at Great American Ball Park; the game was called early due to rain.

- ⚔ Has surrendered one home run in all four career starts against Cincinnati (2025- Spencer Steer, 2024- TJ Friedl, 2023- Christian Encarnacion-Strand, 2021- Tucker Barnhart).
- ⚔ His 6.23 ERA is his worst against a single opponent that he has made multiple starts against.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** Ober is making his 23rd career start in Interleague Play; is 5-7, 5.45 ERA (115.2 IP, 70 ER) with 31 walks, 109 strikeouts, a 1.24 WHIP and a .252 (112-for-444) BAA... Ober has just one win in his last eight outings against National league opponents dating back to August 20, 2024 vs. San Diego; is 1-6 with a 8.93 ERA (40.1 IP, 40 ER), nine walks, 42 strikeouts, 11 home runs surrendered and a .304 (51-for-168) BAA during that span.

- ⚔ Has allowed a home run to nine consecutive National League opponents dating back to July 22, 2024 vs Philadelphia, which is the sixth longest such streak by an American League pitcher in Interleague Play since the dawn of Interleague Play in 1997.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In five MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 18-15 with a 4.23 ERA (329.2 IP, 155 ER), 79 walks, 323 strikeouts, a .239 (300-for-1254) BAA and a .728 OPS against in 62 starts at home compared to 15-15 with a 4.01 ERA (307.2 IP, 137 ER), 59 walks, 295 strikeouts, a .240 (280-for-1165) BAA and a .700 OPS against in 57 road starts.

- ⚔ In 2025, went 2-6 at home with a 5.12 ERA (82.2 IP, 47 ER), 18 walks, 70 strikeouts and a .783 OPS against in 15 starts, compared to 4-3 on the road with a 5.09 ERA (63.2 IP, 36 ER), 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and an .837 OPS against in 12 starts.
- ⚔ Has won consecutive home starts dating back to April 13 vs. Boston for the first time since earning the win in back-to-back starts at Target Field from April 15-22, 2025... prior to earning the win vs. Boston on April 8, Ober had gone 13 home starts without a victory dating back to May 8, 2025 vs. Baltimore, which was tied for the second longest such streak in club history (1961-); longest is Mike Pelfrey's 17-gamer from April 23, 2013-April 17, 2015.
- ⚔ Since his debut in 2021, Ober has not earned a loss in any of his first three home starts in any season of his career.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .194/.275/.361 (7-for-36) with three doubles, one home run, three walks and five strikeouts, while righties are slashing .302/.333/.465 (13-for-43) with one home run, four doubles, two walks and nine strikeouts.

- ⚔ Has allowed opponents to hit .353 (6-for-17) with runners in scoring position, tied for the eighth highest such average among all starters in MLB.
- ⚔ Six of Ober's seven strikeouts in his most recent start on April 13 vs. Boston came against right-handed batters.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚔ Bailey is one of eight MLB pitchers to throw at least 100 changeups this season, ranking second in usage (1st: Edward Cabrera, 36.6%).
- ⚔ He is fourth among MLB pitchers with a .172 (5-for-29) opponent batting average against the changeup (min. 100 pitches).
- ⚔ His 7.1 foot extension ranks in the league's 94th percentile, which is the third highest by a starter in the American League; eighth highest among all starters in Major League Baseball.

**CHANGING IT UP:** Since his debut in 2021, Bailey has relied heavily on his four-seamer, with it being his predominant pitch in each of his first five big league seasons...through four starts this season, Ober has slowed opposing hitters down with his changeup, making it the primary pitch in his six-pitch arsenal, throwing it at a 35.2% clip...here are how his changeup numbers in 2026 compare to prior seasons:

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - MICK ABEL (2026: 1-2, 3.98 ERA // CAREER: 4-6, 5.46 ERA)**

Right-hander Mick Abel is set to make his fourth start of the season tomorrow (fifth appearance) and second career start against New York-NL...in his most recent outing on April 14 vs. Boston, Mick fired 7.0 scoreless innings on four hits with zero walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts, helping the Twins claim the series win over the Red Sox with a 6-0 win...Abel became the first Twins starter to record 13.0-or-more scoreless innings over a two-start span since Pablo López blanked his opponents in consecutive outings through 14.2 innings pitched from August 24-30, 2024...the outing marked his fourth career quality start and his first time recording back-to-back quality starts in consecutive outings...took the loss in his lone career outing against the Mets on June 21, 2025 as a member of the Philadelphia Phillies, allowing four runs on six hits (4 HR) in 3.0 innings pitched with no walks and one strikeout; the Phillies lost 11-4.

- Finished 2025 second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1) and strikeouts (120).
- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and third in career.
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeout totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
