**FLYING HOME:** The St. Louis Cardinals return home from their longest road trip of the season spanning 10-games over 11 days to N.L. Central opponents Pittsburgh (2-2), Cincinnati (2-1) and Milwaukee (1-2), in which they went 5-5.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** Over the next seven days, the Cardinals will host the Los Angeles Dodgers (Sept. 6-9) for four games and the Cincinnati Reds (Sept. 10-12) for three games. The Cardinals enter today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 13.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and 3.0 games behind San Diego for the 2nd Wild Card spot, with Cincinnati and Philadelphia in their path. Of the Cardinals final 27 games of the season, 17 are against teams ahead of them in the division or Wild Card standings (MIL 7, LAD 4, CIN 3, SD 3).

**CARDINALS HONOR FALLEN 13:** For this afternoon's game, the Cardinals will reserve 13 seats for those service members who gave their lives in Afghanistan. Their names will be affixed in honor on each reserved seat in sec. 152.

**CAN'T DODGE THIS:** The Dodgers are visiting Busch Stadium III for the first time since April 8-11, 2019, a span of 879 days, their second-longest stretch between home games against a National League opponent (San Diego will be 894 days come Sept. 17). The Cardinals swept the Dodgers in a four-game series in 2019 and five straight home games overall. This marks their longest home winning streak against the Dodgers since winning six straight home games from May 11, 2005-July 16, 2006 with the first two wins at Busch Stadium II and the next four at Busch Stadium III.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS:** With 27 games remaining on the Cardinals schedule, St. Louis has 16 games remaining at Busch Stadium, tied for the 2nd-most remaining home games in Major League Baseball with Atlanta (16) and Cleveland (16), trailing only Baltimore (18). Since 2006, when the Cardinals opened Busch Stadium III, the 'Birds have the 4th-highest winning percentage at home in the month of September at 121-84 (.590), trailing only the New York Yankees (.643, 133-74), Los Angeles Dodgers (.615, 112-70) and Toronto Blue Jays (.597, 126-85).

**LABORING:** The Cardinals are 91-104-3 all-time on Labor Day, but 52-29-2 in St. Louis (3-4 at Busch Stadium III) ... The only time the Cardinals faced the Dodgers on Labor Day was in 1991 at Dodger Stadium, winning 7-4 in 11 innings on Monday, Sept. 2, 1991 ... After the Dodgers rallied against **Lee Smith** to tie the game in the 9th, **Rich Gedman**, **Todd Zeile**, and **Rod Brewer** knocked in runs off Dodgers pitchers **Jay Howell** and **Dennis Cook** in the 11th.

**MAKING MAX MAD:** The Cardinals are one of four teams that today's opposing starting pitcher, **Max Scherzer**, does not have a career winning record against (3-6 overall, 2-2 at Busch Stadium III). At 2-4, Colorado is the only other team that shares Scherzer's .333 lowest winning percentage against (Milwaukee 2-3; San Francisco 4-5). Scherzer, however, has five of his 103 career double-digit strikeout performances against the Cardinals.

**SAVING THE BEST FOR LAST:** Since arriving in the Major Leagues in 2019, **Tommy Edman** has shown incredible success in the month of September, batting .294 with 11 HR and 31 RBI. His 70 hits are the most in Major League Baseball while his 43 runs and 121 total bases rank 3rd. Edman has socked 11 HR ranking T-12th among N.L. players with teammate **Nolan Arenado** while his 25 extra base hits rank T-9th. Edman has hit safely in each of the first five games of September 2021.

**FLIPPING THE SWITCH:** **Dylan Carlson** added two hits to his season total yesterday, giving him 120 base knocks on the season, five behind current assistant coach **Willie McGee** (125) for 5th place all-time among Cardinals rookie switch-hitters. **Vince Coleman** (170) holds the record in 1985 with Hall of Famer **Red Schoendienst** (157), **Jimmy Brown** (145) and **Lee Magee** (133) remaining atop the list.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** Relievers **Luis Garcia** (21.1-1st) and **T.J. McFarland** (17.0-T2nd) own the top two active scoreless innings streaks in Major League Baseball. Garcia is two outs from passing his career-high in scoreless innings (21.2 IP, June 14-July 29, 2017 w/PHI), while McFarland is currently extending his career-long.

**FROM NOLAN TO ROLAN:** **Nolan Arenado's** next blast will be his 30th of the season as he looks to become only the 4th Cardinals primary third baseman with a 30-homer season and first since **Scott Rolen** (34 in 2004) ... Arenado also seeks to become the first Major Leaguer with six 30-homer seasons since 2015, achieving the feat faster than **Nelson Cruz** (26 HR) and **Manny Machado** (23 HR), who also have five seasons of 30+ homers from 2015-19.

**THERE GO THOSE MEN:** **Paul Goldschmidt** and **Nolan Arenado** have made a career of success against the Los Angeles Dodgers. Goldschmidt (33 HR, 101 RBI) and Arenado (28 HR, 87 RBI) are the current active leaders in home runs and RBI against the Dodgers. The duo is attempting to continue where Cardinals Hall of Famer **Stan "The Man" Musial** left off, the all-time MLB leader against the Dodgers in runs (299), hits (522) RBI (270) and 3rd in home runs (74).

**Jack Flaherty** was born in Burbank Calif...graduated from Harvard-Westlake High School, where he went 23-0 with an 0.63 ERA over his final two seasons and 35-3 overall throughout his high school career...led Harvard-Westlake to the 2013 state title, pitching a complete-game shutout and driving in the lone run in a 1-0 win in the CIF Championship at Dodger Stadium...resides in Sherman Oaks...grew up a Dodgers fan.

**Andrew Knizner** and **Trea Turner** were teammates at North Carolina State University in 2014.

**Paul Goldschmidt** was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 49th round of the 2006 MLB Draft

but did not sign...was teammate of **A.J. Pollock** in Arizona for parts of seven seasons (2012-18).

**Nolan Arenado** graduated from El Toro High School in nearby Lake Forest, Calif. and resides in San Clemente, Calif...grew up a Dodgers fan...one of his favorite players growing up was outfielder **Shawn Green**...singled off **Josh Wall** for his first MLB hit (April 29, 2013 at Dodger Stadium).

**Ron "Pop" Warner** was born in Alhambra, Ca

**Mike Maddux** pitched parts of the 1990 (11 games) and 1999 (49 games) seasons with the Dodgers...his younger brother, Hall of Famer **Greg**

**Maddux**, pitched parts of the 2006 and 2008 seasons with the Dodgers.

**Luis Garcia** signed with the Dodgers as an International free agent in 2004 and pitched parts of four seasons in their minor league organization...traded by Los Angeles with a player to be named later (**Victor Garate**) to the Nationals for **Ronnie Belliard** (August 31, 2009).

**Max Scherzer** is a native of Chesterfield, Mo...graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by St. Louis in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign...pitched at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

**TODAY'S GAME**

- Makes his fifth start of the Major League season and his 4th since returning from the IL on August 20. Was sidelined May 22 until start on Aug. 20 by right forearm injury.
- Today marks his 79th career start (106th app.) and 69th start as a member of the Cardinals organization.
- Was activated from 60-day Injured List on 8/20 after right forearm tightness forced him to exit his first start of the season on 5/22 vs. CHI after four innings. He had begun the 2021 season on the Injured List after the same injury caused him to miss the entire 2020 season.
- Last recorded a win for the Cardinals on Sept. 12, 2019 in a day game at COL as Dexter Fowler and Kolten Wong hit back-to-back home runs to lead-off the game in a 10-3 victory.
- Is 11-3, 3.63 ERA in 25 career starts for the Cardinals (2018-21) during the day and 6-1, 3.12 ERA in 11 September starts since joining St. Louis in 2018.
- Since beginning his career with the Cardinals in 2018 (including missing the entire 2020 season and most of 2021), ranks T8th among Major League pitchers with 52 starts in which he issued one walk or less. Zack Greinke leads with 74 and Kyle Hendricks leads all N.L. pitchers with 67.
- Needs 7.2 innings pitched to reach 500 for his career.
- He made eight minor league starts this season during two rehab stints and posted an overall record of 3-1 with a 3.93 ERA covering 36.2 innings with only six walks.
- He made starts at Memphis-AAA (5), Springfield-AA (2) and Peoria-High A (1).
- Missed the entire 2020 regular season, and the beginning of 2021, as he continued recovery from right arm flexor tendon surgery.

**LAST TIME OUT**

• Started the twinbill opener at Cincinnati last Wednesday, allowing four runs in 3.0 innings. Exited with St. Louis trailing 4-3 before the Cardinals quickly scored on Paul Goldschmidt's 2nd homer of the game, a two-run go-ahead shot in the 4th for a 5-4 win.

- Began the season on the Injured List recovering from right forearm tightness.
- Returned from the Injured List on May 22 to make a start vs. CHI and lasted only 4.0 innings before again returning to the Injured List with right forearm tightness.
- Made a total of eight rehab starts over his two stints on the Injured List and has made four Major League starts.
- Returned from the Injured List a second time and started at Busch Stadium vs. PIT (8/20) throwing a season-high 5.0 IP in a no-decision the Cardinals lost 4-0.
- He pitched in back-to-back starts against the Pirates and Mitch Keller in his first two starts following his second return from the Injured List.
